STEERING COMMITTEE AND THE NORMATIVE FRAMEWORK FOR IDM

The SteerCo advises AED PD on IDM related matters, which then helps inform the evolving normative framework for how WFP manages the information of the people it serves

ITEMS ON THE STEERING COMMITTEE'S AGENDA

- Does WFP need to know each individual direct recipient (tier 1) of assistance?
- How to appropriately manage exchange of data with partners and stakeholders?
- Which principles should govern WFP's use of biometrics?
- How to best align the systems used for IDM with programme objectives in operational context?
