# Country Context

- Libya is classified as an **upper-middle-income country**;
- Heavily dependent on **food imports**;
- **COVID 19 and economic instability** exhausted the social safety nets;
- **A hub** for people seeking better opportunities;
- Highly vulnerable to the effects of climate change, with the **highest levels of water scarcity**.



# Theory of Change

- If WFP supports the most vulnerable and conflict-affected people in Libya;
- and contributes to the strengthening of national systems that enable the Government to better support vulnerable people in Libya;
- then no one will be “left behind” on Libya’s road to recovery, citizen–state linkages will be empowered, and the Government will have the capacity to respond to shocks, contributing to further stability and peace in Libya.
