#### 1. UNHAS USER ELIGIBILITY AND PRIORITIZATION

#### System for exceptional allocation of empty non-reserved seats:

Civilian personnel of United Nations peacekeeping and political missions are now excluded from the list of
categories of passengers who could exceptionally be allocated empty non-reserved seats on UNHAS aircraft.

#### **UNHAS Prioritization System:**

Programme Criticality P1, P2 and P3 is referenced

## 2. OBJECTIVES AVIATION SERVICES

• The objectives are now more extensively described in the introductory section of the policy document.

#### 3. PROCESS TO START/END SERVICES

Re-enforcement of the required donor consultation at the very onset of a potential response.

#### 4. SUPPORT TO THE AVIATION SECTOR

 Inclusion of the capacity building of Civil Aviation Authorities' capabilities, airports management and infrastructure, support to the in-country Aviation Industry.

#### 5. GOVERNANCE FRAMEWORK

Detailing of the frequency/composition of key meetings: Aviation Safety Board, Air Transport Committee,
 United Nations Aviation Technical Advisory Group, Steering Committee.

#### 6. METRICS/KPIS

• Re-enforcement of evidence on efficiency & effectiveness of services and on environmental improvement and reduction of the carbon footprint, Sustainable Aviation Fuel and reporting requirements.

#### 7. COST RECOVERY

- Highlighting the importance of not using funding from Humanitarian Donors for passengers requiring a fullcost recovery fee;
- UNHAS operations move into cost recovery mode
- Different fees for different types of organizations (local NGO's, International NGO's, UN Agencies/Funds/Programmes and Diplomatic Community).

#### 8. LOG CLUSTER ROLE IN WFP AVIATION

 Logistics Cluster coordination and facilitation - as per humanitarian priorities established by the UN Country Team/Humanitarian Coordinator.

#### 9. DISABILITY INCLUSION

Referenced the disability inclusion implementation process.

#### 10. ABUSE/TRAFFICKING/EXPLOITATION

• Detailing of the safeguards against abuse/trafficking/exploitation.

#### 11. INNOVATIVE AIR TRANSPORT SOLUTIONS

- Detailing the development of Remotely Piloted Aircraft System (RPAS) and Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS)
   Cargo Delivery solutions. Establishment of a framework for the safe and secure operation of UAS by WFP personnel.
- Introduction to other alternative innovative and environmentally efficient transport solutions such as airships and electric vehicles.

#### 12. CIVIL-MILITARY COORDINATION

Coordination mechanisms between different military, civil, security and humanitarian stakeholders.

### 13. COORDINATION WITH LOCAL SERVICE PROVIDERS

Local coordination between Humanitarian Air Services providers and service providers.

#### 14. CARRIAGE OF WEAPONS ABOARD AN AIRCRAFT

Following the internal consultations with aviation field staff, the clause of the Policy under the "Humanitarian
Principles" section: "Carriage of uniformed personnel and individuals wearing military uniforms and transportation
of firearms or weapons are not permitted." It will be proposed for amendment strictly specifying permission for
close protection personnel only.
