



Ongoing and planned decentralized evaluations by Start Year and by Region/HQ















EVOLUTION OF REGIONAL EVALUATION BUDGETS 2017 -2024


TOTAL CONTRIBUTIONS BY YEAR

TOTAL FUNDS ALLOCATED 2019-2023 BY DONOR AND ACTIVITY






OVERALL FUNDING SOURCES FOR THE EVALUATION FUNCTION 2022-24




HUMAN RESOURCE REQUIREMENTS 2024
