# Chad has not been making significant progress and will likely face even more shocks

Food Insecurity on the rise



Worsening human development indicators



Increasing insecurity and climate shocks



**50%** area is desert, posing challenges in domestic food production

**117<sup>th</sup>** out of 121 countries on food deficit index

**2.1M** people in food insecurity phase 3 to 5, and **2.9M projected for June – August 2024.** More than doubled in the last 5 years.


**190<sup>th</sup>** out of 191 countries on the Human Development Index

**187<sup>th</sup>** out of 189 countries in gender inequality ranking

**1.074 M** refugees and asylum seekers, 451,894 have arrived since April 2023

**182<sup>nd</sup>** countries out of 182 on climate vulnerability index


