Specific areas for CSP improvement

- Further integration across outcomes at design stage

- **Customization** of technical assistance
- Longer term perspective and different approaches to transformational changes for women
- **M&E systems** used for learning and advocacy
- Strengthen and diversify resource mobilisation

Systemic issues for consideration

1 Funding challenges and earmarking affects medium and long-term planning

Evidence gaps, particularly related to capacity strengthening, influence programme implementation
