# Background

- 2016 CSP Policy states all CSPs to be evaluated in penultimate year
- CSP Policy evaluation recommends revising the evaluation requirements to ensure:
- Selective, strategic, timely and costefficient evaluation coverage while ensuring principle of evidence based programming

## Key principles and operationalisation



#### **Proposed Coverage Norm**

Minimum 10 CSPE in any given year, to cover at least 70% of all the CSPs that are in the penultimate year of implementation

### Projection from 2025 to 2027 based proposed coverage norm



#### **Criteria for selection: First screening**

All CSPs meeting at least one of the criteria below

- CSP not evaluated in the previous cycle
- Country classified as "high risk"
- Corporate attention



### Criteria for selection: Additional CSP to meet coverage requirements

- 1. Major contextual and/or strategic shifts
- 2. Learning opportunity
- 3. Strategic priority for the region
- 4. Stakeholder demand



### **Selection process**

- Proposal by OEV
- Consultation with SMG and EB
- Final decision by Director of Evaluation



### Planning and budgeting

- All CO budget for evaluation in the penultimate year of CSP cycle
- OEV confirms selection of CSPE during year 2 of CSP implementation
- When CSP is waived CO to reallocate resources to decentralized evaluation in year three or four

As of second half of 2024 to select CSPE for 2026
