## SNAPSHOT OF CBT IN JAN–DEC 2023

Overall WFP food assistance - including cash, value vouchers, commodity vouchers, in-kind and capacity strengthening dropped in 2023 due to a 40% decline in confirmed contributions from the previous year.

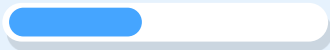

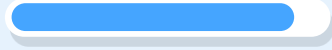
