#### **Context**

This exhibition is held alongside the 2025 annual session of the WFP Executive Board to spotlight WFP's ongoing commitment to preventing and responding to sexual exploitation and abuse (SEA). This work is not peripheral, it is central to WFP's mandate. Ensuring that communities, especially the most vulnerable, can access assistance safely and with dignity lies at the heart of our mission. This exhibition illustrates WFP's progress in embedding protection from sexual exploitation and abuse (PSEA) across our systems, operations and organizational culture, guided by the 2023 PSEA strategic evaluation. With the Executive Director currently serving as the Inter-Agency Standing Committee Champion on Protection from Sexual Exploitation and Abuse and Harassment (2024–2025), this moment also provides a timely opportunity to reflect on WFP's leadership in driving system-wide change and accountability on this agenda. The exhibition features visuals from the field, compelling front-line staff testimonies and practical examples of how WFP is operationalizing its commitment to protect those we serve.

- > **Underscore that PSEA is integral** to WFP's mission and essential for delivering assistance safely and with dignity.
- Demonstrate progress in how WFP prevents and responds to SEA.
- > Showcase field-level testimonies and good practices that exemplify WFP's leadership.
- ➤ **Foster informal engagement** among Executive Board members and WFP on PSEA priorities, challenges and opportunities to further strengthen PSEA efforts.
- > Reaffirm the importance of sustained leadership, oversight and employees' engagement to ensure PSEA remains fully embedded in WFP's operations, values and culture.
