## **Opening remarks by the Executive Director**

In the Caribbean, where we are working around the clock with governments to help the islands who were smashed by Hurricane Melissa. In the Philippines, where we have handed out cash payments and food parcels to families caught up in Typhoon Tino. In every corner of the globe WFP brings life-saving food, hope and dignity to people who need the most.

I followed all of these achievements with such pride and admiration. Whatever the risks, whatever the challenges, WFP's dedicated global team never, ever give up. So, I am more determined than ever to meet our duty of care to them and to give them the support, protection and resources they need..

And inspired by their humanitarian spirit, I want you to know that I am not giving up either. I am still committed to leading this amazing organization and working with all of you to deliver for the hungry people we serve everywhere. I look forward to seeing you again in Rome early in the new year.
