

DRAFT DECISION*



The Board takes note of the information in "Report on the Use of the Immediate Response Account (1 January–31 December 2008)" (WFP/EB.A/2009/11-D).

INTRODUCTION

1. The Immediate Response Account (IRA) was established in December 1991 by the Committee on Food Aid Policies and Programmes (CFA). Its original target level of US\$30 million was increased to US\$35 million in 1995 by the CFA, and to US\$70 million in 2004 at the Board's Second Regular Session. The IRA is a multilateral fund facility that enables WFP to provide immediate food assistance, including logistics and other non-food costs, in emergency situations. Since its inception, the IRA has repeatedly proved to be one of the most effective relief response mechanisms.

- 2. In 2004, when considering the document "Review of the Immediate Response Account (IRA)" (WFP/EB.3/2004/12-A), the Board requested the Secretariat to submit a formal annual information paper on use of the IRA.
- 3. This document provides information on the use of the IRA during 2008.
- 4. The Secretariat will continue to update Board members on the use of the IRA through *WFP's Operational Requirements, Shortfalls and Priorities*, a document issued three times a year concurrently with Board sessions.

Facts about the Immediate Response Account

Allocations from the IRA are made as loans to eligible operations in anticipation of receiving donor contributions. If no such donations are received, the loan is deemed to be a permanent, non-reimbursable grant from the IRA.

The IRA serves as both a replenishable and a revolving fund. "Revolving" means that funds allocated from the IRA to an operation may subsequently be reimbursed to the IRA account with donor contributions received for that operation. Contributions that are used to revolve the IRA are accounted for and reported under the operation to which the donor pledged them.

Donor contributions made directly to the IRA replenish it. In-kind contributions and contributions with donor conditions such as bag markings restrict the possibility of revolving the IRA.

USE OF THE IMMEDIATE RESPONSE ACCOUNT, 1 JANUARY-31 DECEMBER 2008

5. The value of the IRA as a mechanism for WFP's swift response to emerging and rapidly increasing humanitarian needs continued to be demonstrated in 2008. The unprecedented level of allocations reached in 2007 (US\$150.7 million) was almost maintained in 2008, with US\$140.6 million allocated (and a further US\$28.1 million transferred from closed projects) to start and support 56 relief operations: 12 protracted relief and recovery operations (PRROs), 6 Special Operations (SOs), and 38 emergency operations (EMOPs) of which 17 were immediate-response EMOPs approved under the delegated authority of country directors and Regional Directors.



6. Through the IRA, WFP was able to respond swiftly to such emergencies as the drought affecting the Horn of Africa, civil strife in the Democratic Republic of the Congo, and cyclones in Haiti and Myanmar. The IRA also provided much-needed upfront funding to pre-position food in Darfur and to avoid major pipeline breaks in life-saving operations in Afghanistan, Mozambique, Tajikistan and Zimbabwe.

- 7. Following the Executive Board decision to broaden the use of this facility, IRA funds now support several WFP emergency preparedness efforts. In 2008, emergency preparedness and needs assessments for new emerging situations in 13 countries were funded through the IRA.
- 8. The IRA collaborates with the Central Emergency Response Fund (CERF) of the United Nations in ensuring WFP's response to life-threatening situations and underfunded emergencies. The CERF remained an important source of funds for WFP in 2008; in-house procedures have been developed to ensure that IRA and CERF applications are complementary rather than overlapping.

- 9. To secure the replenishment of the IRA, WFP concentrates on advocacy, revolving the account quickly and securing new contributions. The year 2008 saw the largest amount of contributions received in any given year (US\$60.7 million), as well as the largest amount of allocations revolved (US\$97.6 million), together with US\$15.8 million transferred from closed projects.
- 10. The IRA balance stood at US\$44.6 million at the end of 2008.

IMMEDIATE RESPONSE ACCOUNT TARGET LEVEL

- 11. As a flexible funding mechanism, the IRA is critical in allowing WFP to respond proactively to emerging humanitarian situations.
- 12. The IRA's current target level of US\$70 million was increased from US\$35 million in 2004 to reflect the existing level of WFP's operations and cash flow.






