INTRODUCTION

1. The Immediate Response Account (IRA) was established in December 1991 by the Committee on Food Aid Policies and Programmes (CFA). Its original target level of US\$30 million was increased to US\$35 million in 1995 by CFA, and to US\$70 million in 2004 at the Board's Second Regular Session. The IRA is a multilateral fund facility that enables WFP to provide immediate food assistance, including logistics and other non-food costs, in emergency situations. Since its inception, the IRA has repeatedly proved to be one of the most effective relief response mechanisms.

- 2. In 2004, when considering the document "Review of the Immediate Response Account (IRA)" (WFP/EB.3/2004/12-A), the Board requested the Secretariat to submit a formal annual information paper on use of the IRA.
- 3. This document provides information on the use of the IRA during 2007.
- 4. The Secretariat will continue to update Board members on the use of the IRA through WFP's Operational Requirements, Shortfalls and Priorities, a document issued three times a year concurrently with Board sessions.

Facts about the Immediate Response Account

Allocations from the IRA are made as loans to eligible operations in anticipation of receiving donor contributions. If no such donations are received, the loan is deemed to be a permanent, non-reimbursable grant from the IRA.

The IRA serves as both a replenishable and a revolving fund. "Revolving" means that funds allocated from the IRA to an operation may subsequently be reimbursed to the IRA account with donor contributions received for that operation. Contributions that are used to revolve the IRA are accounted for and reported under the operation to which the donor pledged them.

Donor contributions made directly to the IRA replenish it. In-kind contributions and contributions with donor conditions such as bag markings restrict the possibility of revolving the IRA.

USE OF THE IMMEDIATE RESPONSE ACCOUNT, 1 JANUARY – 31 DECEMBER 2007

5. The value of the IRA as a mechanism for WFP's swift response to emerging and rapidly increasing humanitarian needs continued to be demonstrated in 2007. An unprecedented US\$150.7 million was allocated to start and support 57 relief operations: 19 protracted relief and recovery operations (PRROs), 7 special operations (SOs), and 31 emergency operations (EMOPs) of which 16 were immediate-response EMOPs approved under the delegated authority of country and regional directors.



6. Through the IRA, WFP was able to respond swiftly to such emergencies as cyclones and floods in Bangladesh, Madagascar and Mozambique, the hurricane and storms in Central America, civil strife in Chad and the Central African Republic and drought impacts in eastern Africa. The IRA also provided much-needed upfront funding for the prepositioning of food in Darfur and Chad and to avoid major pipeline breaks in life-saving operations in Afghanistan, Ethiopia, Nepal and Somalia.

- 7. Following the Executive Board decision to broaden the use of this facility, IRA funds now support several WFP emergency preparedness efforts. In 2007, emergency preparedness and needs assessments for new emerging situations in eight countries were funded through the IRA.
- 8. The IRA collaborates with the United Nations Central Emergency Response Fund (CERF) in ensuring WFP's response to life-threatening situations and underfunded emergencies. The CERF became an increasingly important source of funds for WFP in 2007; in-house procedures have been developed to ensure that IRA and CERF applications are complementary rather than overlapping.

- 9. Donor contributions of US\$26.9 million were made to the IRA in 2007, a reduction of 16 percent from 2006. To secure the replenishment of the IRA, WFP concentrates on advocacy, faster revolving of the account and securing new contributions. In 2007, US\$85.3 million was revolved. This high level of revolvement was partly the result of easing restrictions on repayment, for example through relaxing bag-marking conditions and allowing revolvement with contributions confirmed within a certain time following the original IRA allocation.
- 10. The IRA balance stood at US\$27.3 million at the end of 2007, well below the target level of US\$70 million endorsed by the Executive Board, and one of the lowest levels in recent IRA history.

IMMEDIATE RESPONSE ACCOUNT TARGET LEVEL

- 11. As a flexible funding mechanism, the IRA is critical in allowing WFP to respond proactively to emerging humanitarian situations.
- 12. The IRA's current target level of US\$70 million was increased from US\$35 million in 2004 to reflect the existing level of WFP's operations and cash flow. The Secretariat is reviewing the adequacy of this target level in the context of soaring food and fuel prices and increasing operational demands on WFP in responding to the new face of hunger.




