- 8. Joint Inspection Unit (JIU)
 - a) <u>Report on the development of a system of follow-up to Joint Inspection Unit (JIU)</u> recommendations

The Executive Board, at its Second Regular Session in May 2000, encouraged the Secretariat and the Joint Inspection Unit to continue discussions with a view to developing a more effective system of follow-up to the JIU recommendations. The proposed follow-up system is outlined in the document which the Board will have before it, **for approval.**

b) <u>Reports by the Joint Inspection Unit (JIU) for 2001</u>

The Executive Board, by its decision 1998/EB.A/7, recommended that the Bureau review future JIU reports and present its observations for the Board's consideration. The Secretariat presented to the Bureau a summary report containing the recommendations of, and follow-up action on, those JIU reports issued in 2001 that are of direct relevance to the work of WFP. The Bureau will present this summary to the Board, **for consideration**.

- 9. Summary of the Work of the First Regular Session of the Executive Board, 2002. In accordance with the Executive Board's decision at its Second Regular Session in 1996 on its methods of work, the Summary of the Work of the First Regular Session of 2002 will be submitted for endorsement.
- 10. *Other business*. Representatives and the Executive Director may wish to raise further matters of interest to the Executive Board.
- 11. *Verification of adopted decisions and recommendations.* The Executive Board will have before it a draft document containing all decisions and recommendations taken at its current session, for verification of their accuracy.
