



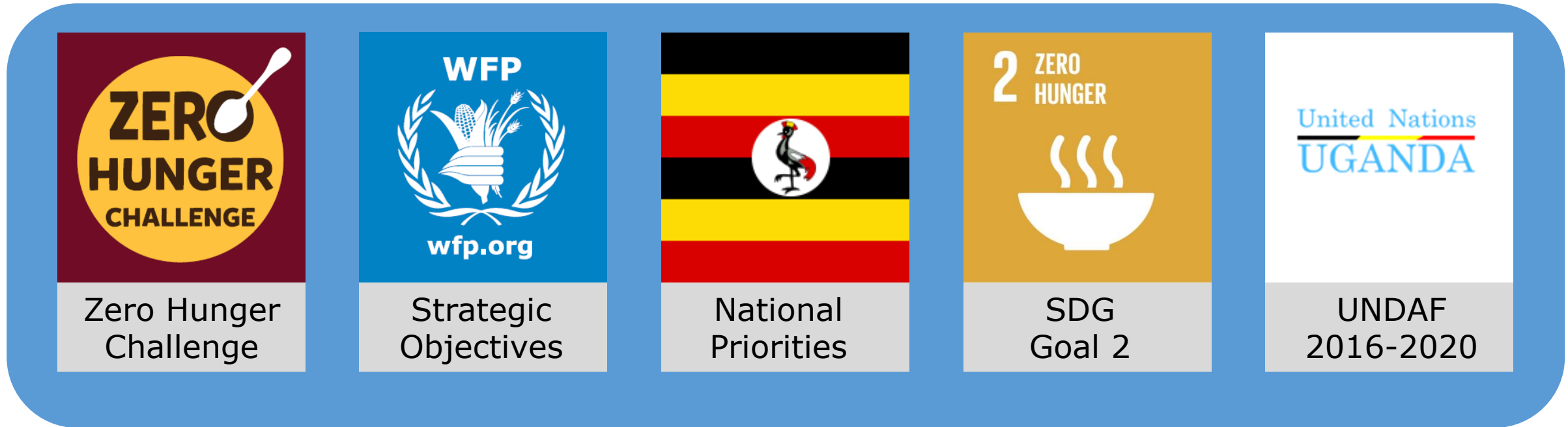

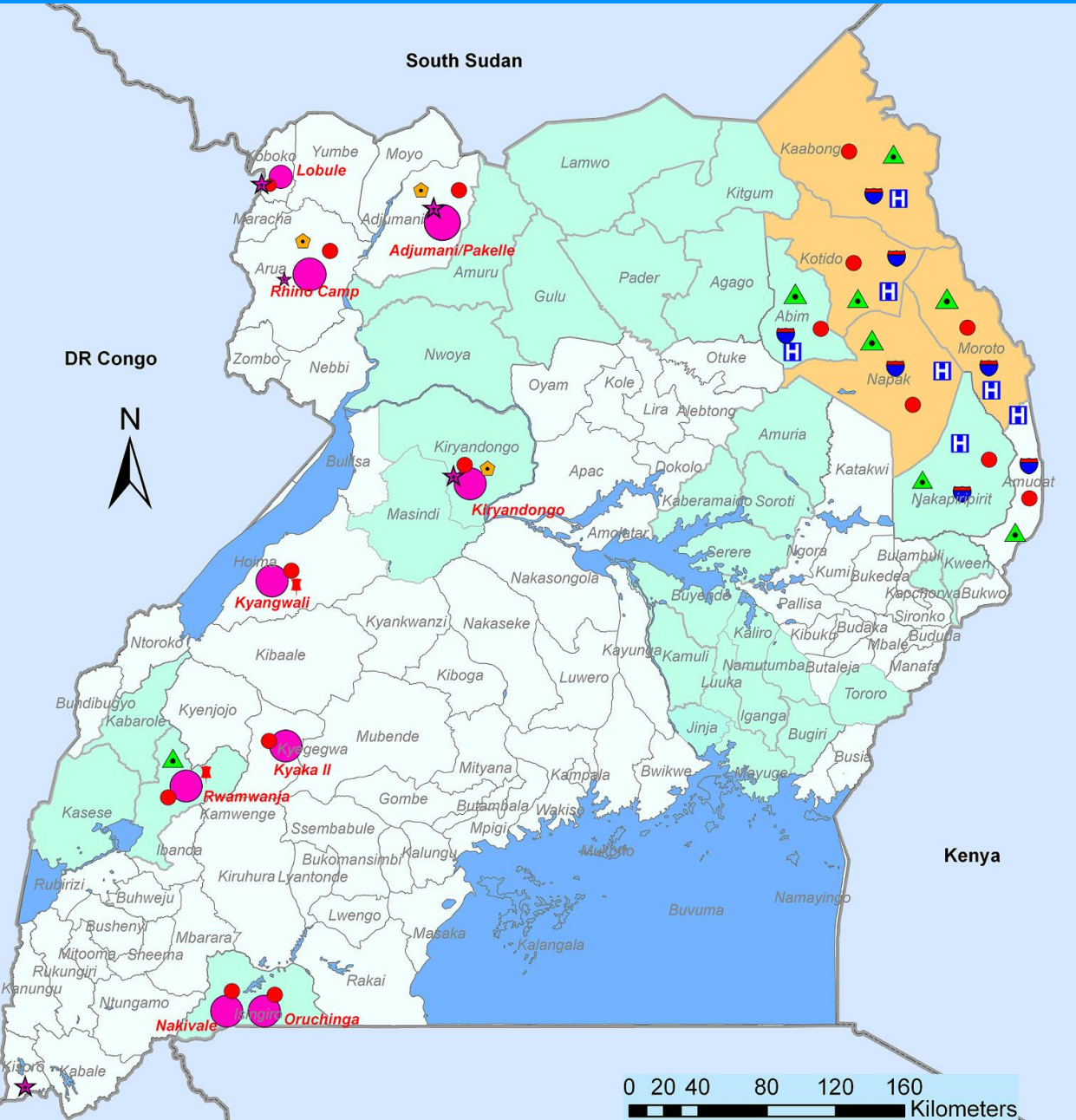
# WFP Uganda Response Framework


# Map of WFP Intervention

*Agriculture and Market Support*



**125,000 smallholder farmers** over five years  
**USD 38 million** required over five years

*Strengthened Nutrition Services*



**204,000 people**, including mothers, children and extremely vulnerable people  
**USD 40 million** required over five years

3

*Home-Grown School Feeding*



**123,440 children** in **282 primary schools** per year  
**USD 25 million** required over five years

**USD 103 million for 377,440 beneficiaries by 2020**
