- Provides an overview of actions taken to strengthen ERM in the organization and way forward

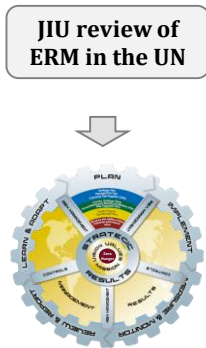

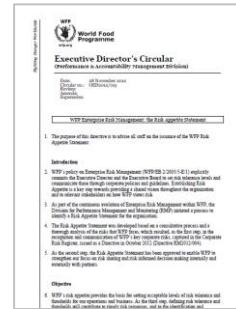

Continuous implementation of ERM in WFP

2015 ERM Policy: Reflecting progress in ERM development since 2005

- ERM policy 2005 contained basic structure of risk management, but did not provide information on how to operationalise risk management in WFP.



new

- The **2015 policy** brings:
 - ✓ Link between ERM and **Internal Controls**;
 - ✓ Outline of Staff **responsibilities and functions** (incl. Escalation process);
 - ✓ Outline of all **components** of the ERM framework (incl. Risk Registers, the CRR);
 - ✓ Reference to **risk appetite** statement and **risk tolerance**;
 - ✓ Clarification on **risk sharing** with partners;
 - ✓ Emphasis on embedding Enterprise Risk Management within the organization;
 - ✓ Outline of internal and external **risk reporting**.

Action taken following Informal Consultations w/EB

- ✓ Clarifying/Strengthening EB role in ERM



- ✓ Clarification of role of risk appetite in the ERM policy

- ✓ Emphasis on mainstreaming/integration of ERM in WFP (cost-neutrality)



- ✓ Clarification of WFPs role in strengthening ERM within the humanitarian community
