PART I: FINDINGS Confirmation

- **Relevance** and **effectiveness** of WFP's emergency response
- Increased efforts towards **flexible** & **locally responsive** programming
- Application of food assistance to longer term needs
- **FFA/T** contribution: livelihoods, women empowerment, social cohesion
- Gender-sensitive country based programming
- **Innovative** programming

Challenges

- **Rigidities** of in-kind humanitarian funding and programme categories
- Chronic **under-funding** of longer term perspective programming
- Limited
 - Use of M&E
 - Outcome measurement
 - Mainstreaming gender
 - Technical capacity

Conclusions

- Longer term strategic positioning; funding diversification; CO strategic planning
- WFP's work is relevant in **MICS** but **operating models** not conducive to long term engagement:
 - Scope for common services and more technical guidance/support in small COs
- Stronger **M&E** systems

Recommendations

- Set clear and systematic requirements for CO Strategic Planning
- Define (and meet) essential capacity requirements for small CO's
