YEMEN

The original caseload in January of 1.2 million severely food insecure people was increased to 1.8 million in June, then 3.9 million in September. Expanding from eight to 13 of Yemen's poorest governates.

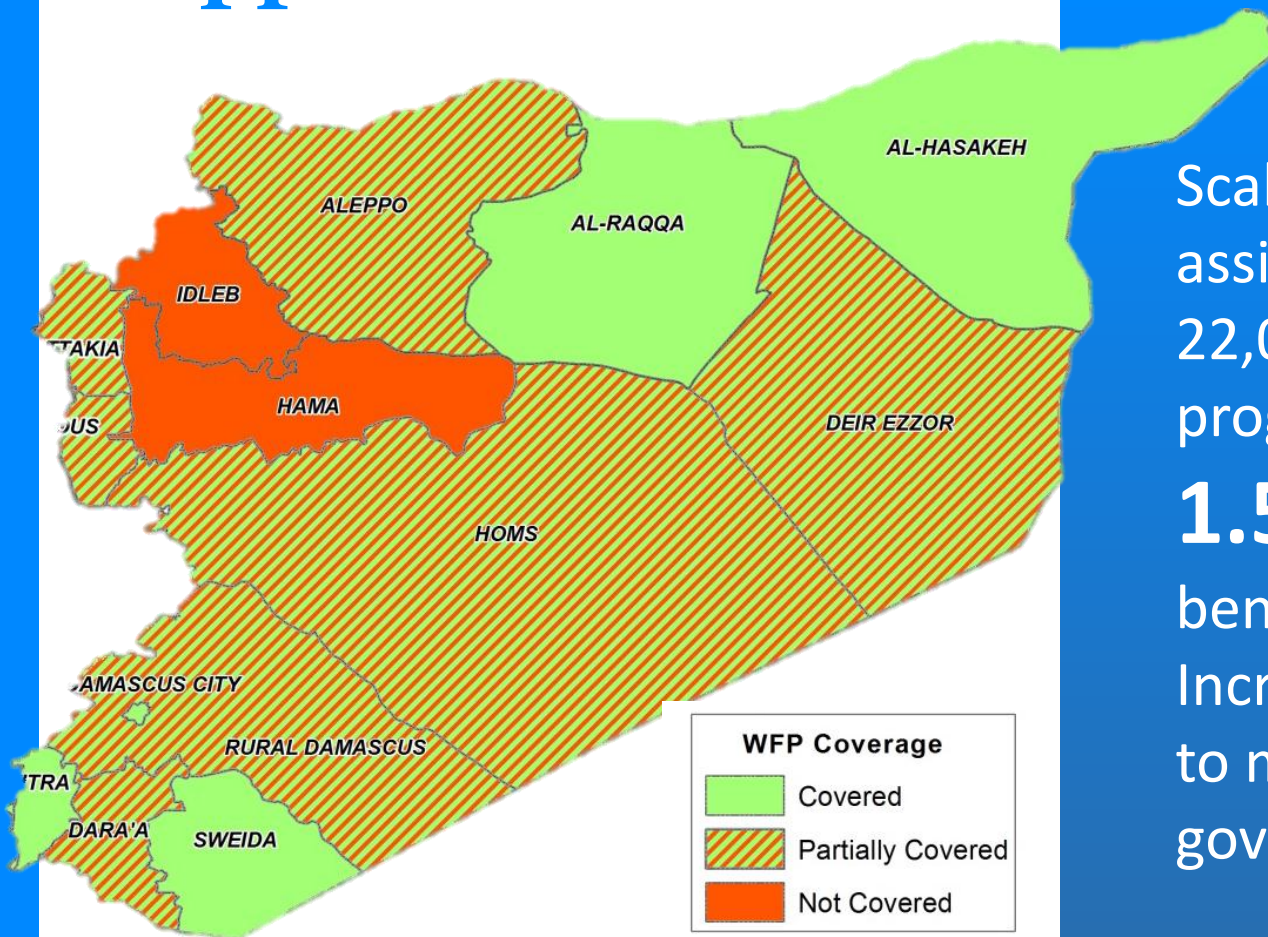

The scale up also aims to accelerate treatment of moderate acute malnutrition in health facilities in cooperation with UNICEF and NGO partners.

SYRIA



Scaling up food assistance from 22,000 beneficiaries progressively to **1.5 million** beneficiaries. Increasing coverage to more governorates.




SYRIA

While food prices have increased, purchasing power decreased.

In May, based on monitoring interviews, 47% of interviewed households fell under the category of “poor food consumption”.
