





ODC Strategic Priorities



May 2012 CFSS Findings: 44.5 percent of the population in YEMEN is food insecure, i.e. 10 million people. Nearly double the number since the last CFSS survey in 2009. Chronic malnutrition – as defined by stunting - among children is also alarmingly high at 47 percent.


School Feeding Programmes in oPt
