Main objectives of the 2011 DRR Policy

1. Provide WFP with clear policy guidance anchored in our mandate and mission and built on our comparative advantages.
2. Clarify the link between disasters, risk management, and food security
3. Provide principles for WFP activities in DRR, strengthen partnerships, and ensure support to government-led processes.

Priorities for DRR Policy Implementation

1. Emergency preparedness and response
2. Capacity development in and policy support to food security-related DRR
3. Analytical capacity to link food security, disaster risk, climate change, and conflict
4. Programme quality enhancement
5. Partnerships
6. Monitoring and evaluation and cost effectiveness
