Operational Objectives

The operation mitigates the impacts of access and movement restrictions by:

- Using a **protection lens** to focus and increase our activities on vulnerable areas: Area C and Seam Zone
- Support with food assistance destitute families under the PA Social safety net using a new targeting system developed by the Ministry of Social Affairs, the World Bank and the European Union
- Assisting new poor through voucher transfers (food-insecure and vulnerable groups in urban areas)
- Supporting the economy with tools such as vouchers for local foods, local milling and local purchase.
