


- Ranked among the top ten countries in the world for highest rates of food insecurity and malnutrition.
- 2.7 million are severely food insecure
- WFP's strategy for 2010 and 2011
 for a twin-track approach to
 address both transitory and
 chronic food insecurity and
 malnutrition.
- Dramatic funding shortfalls –One million out of 1.3 million planned beneficiaries will be deprived of assistance.
