



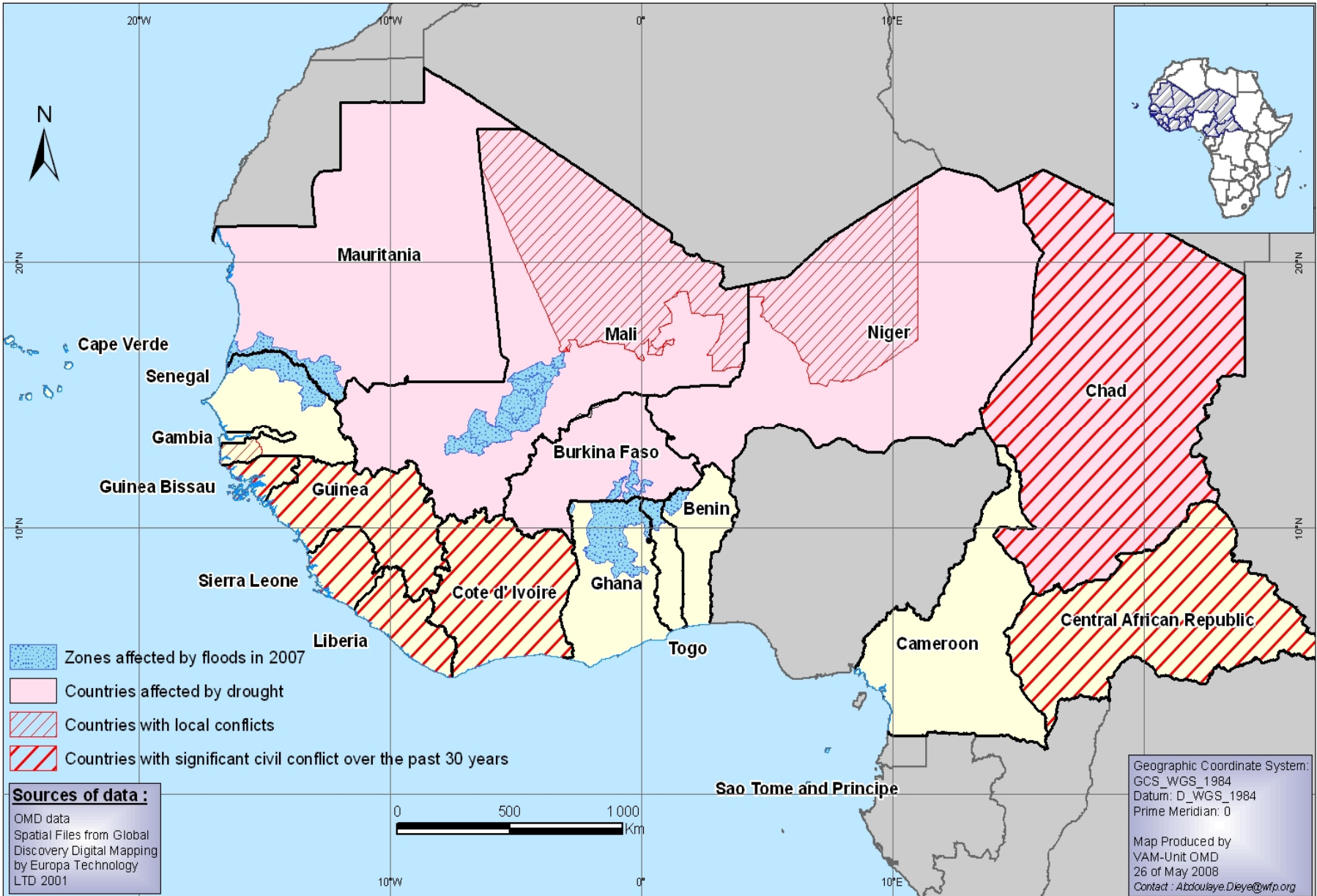

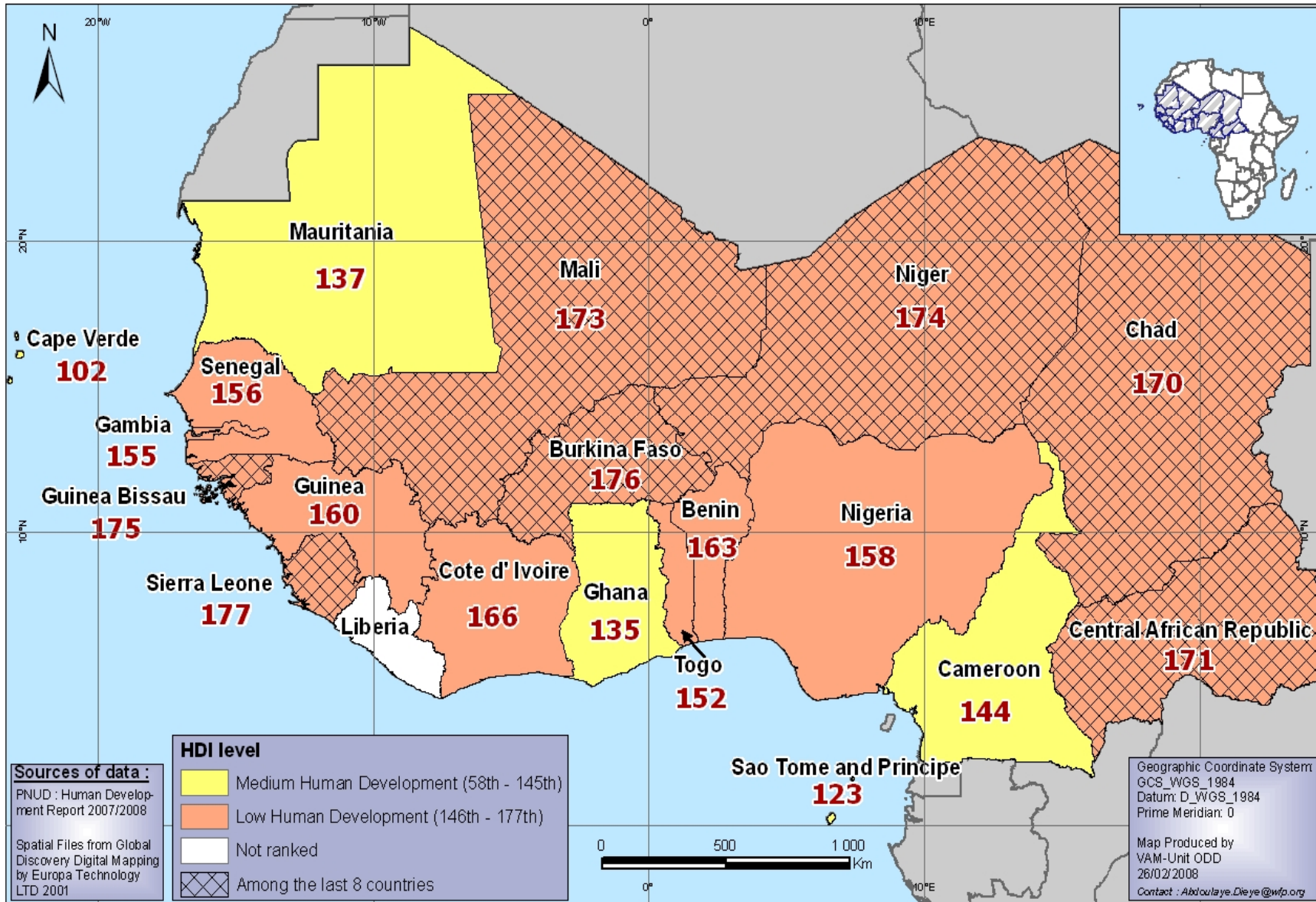

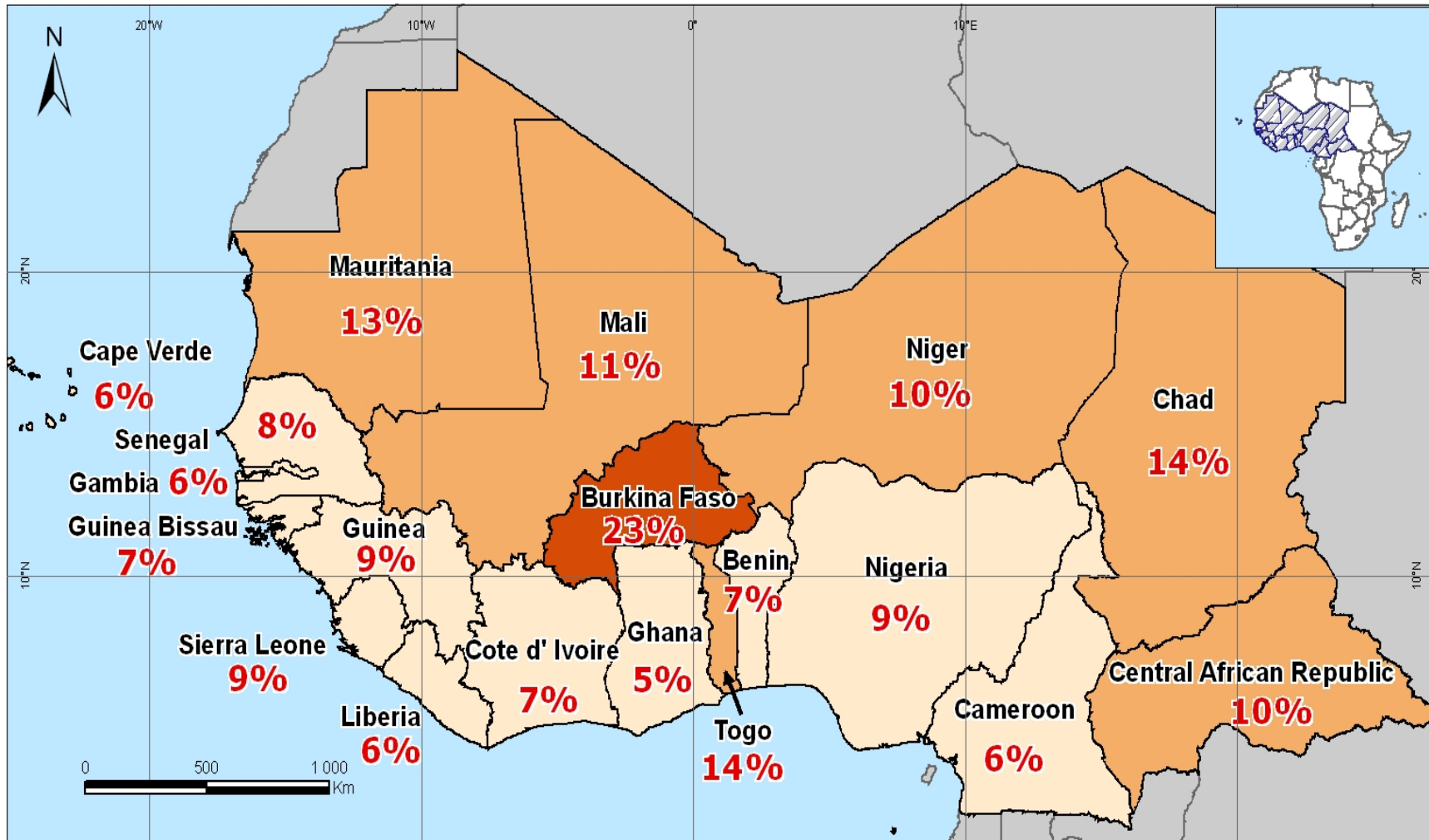

- ≥ 15% (critical)

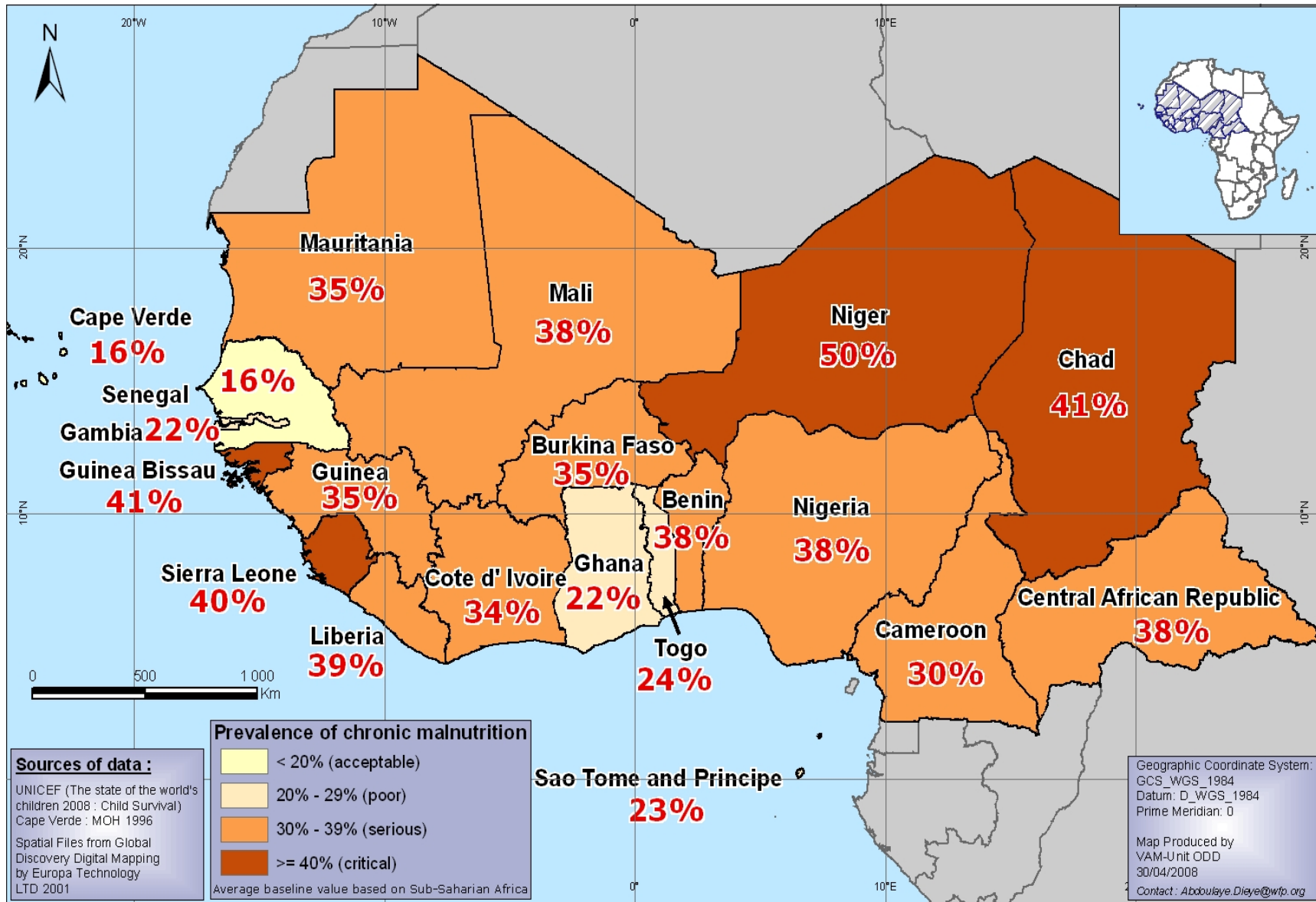

**Prevalence of chronic malnutrition**

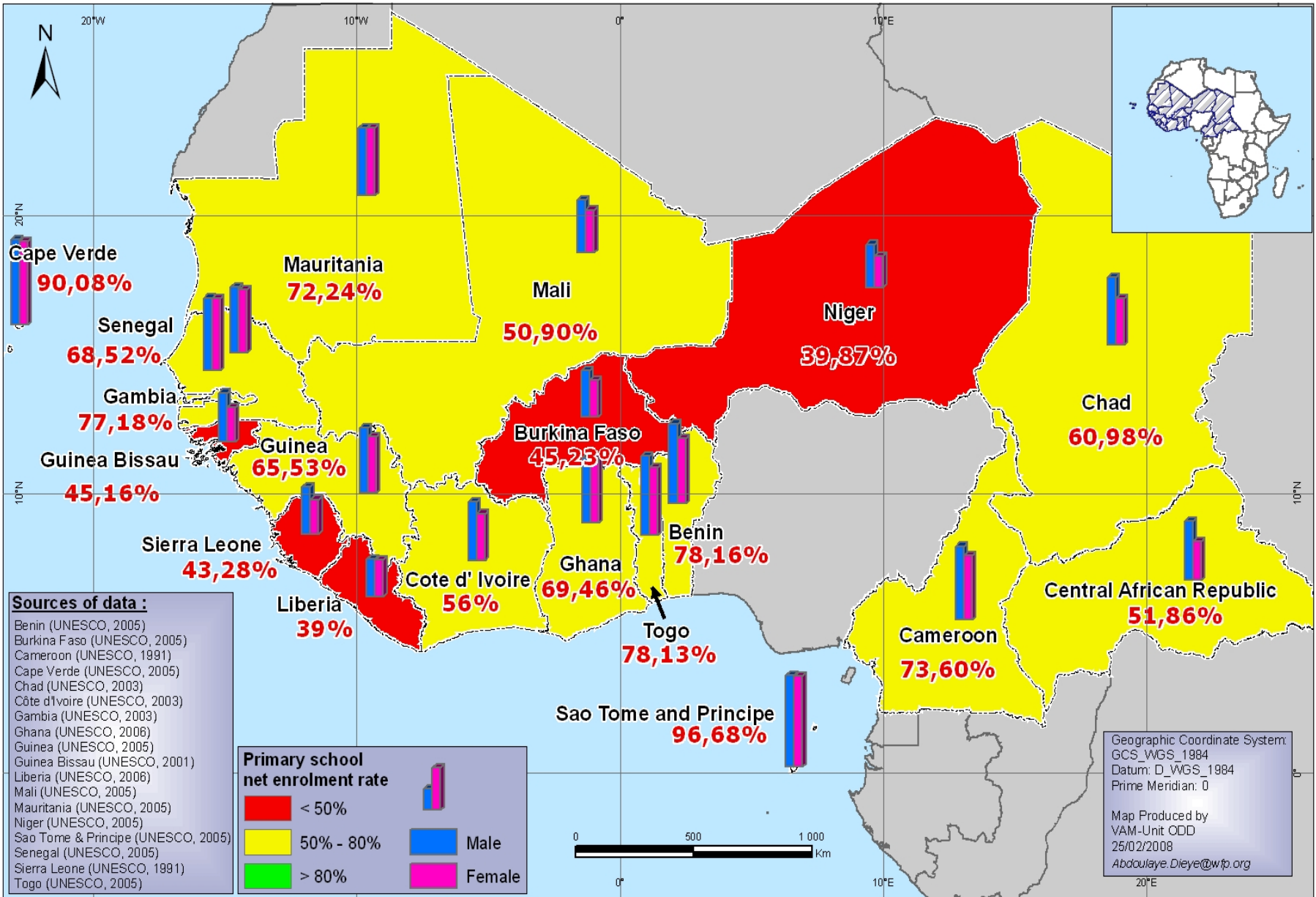

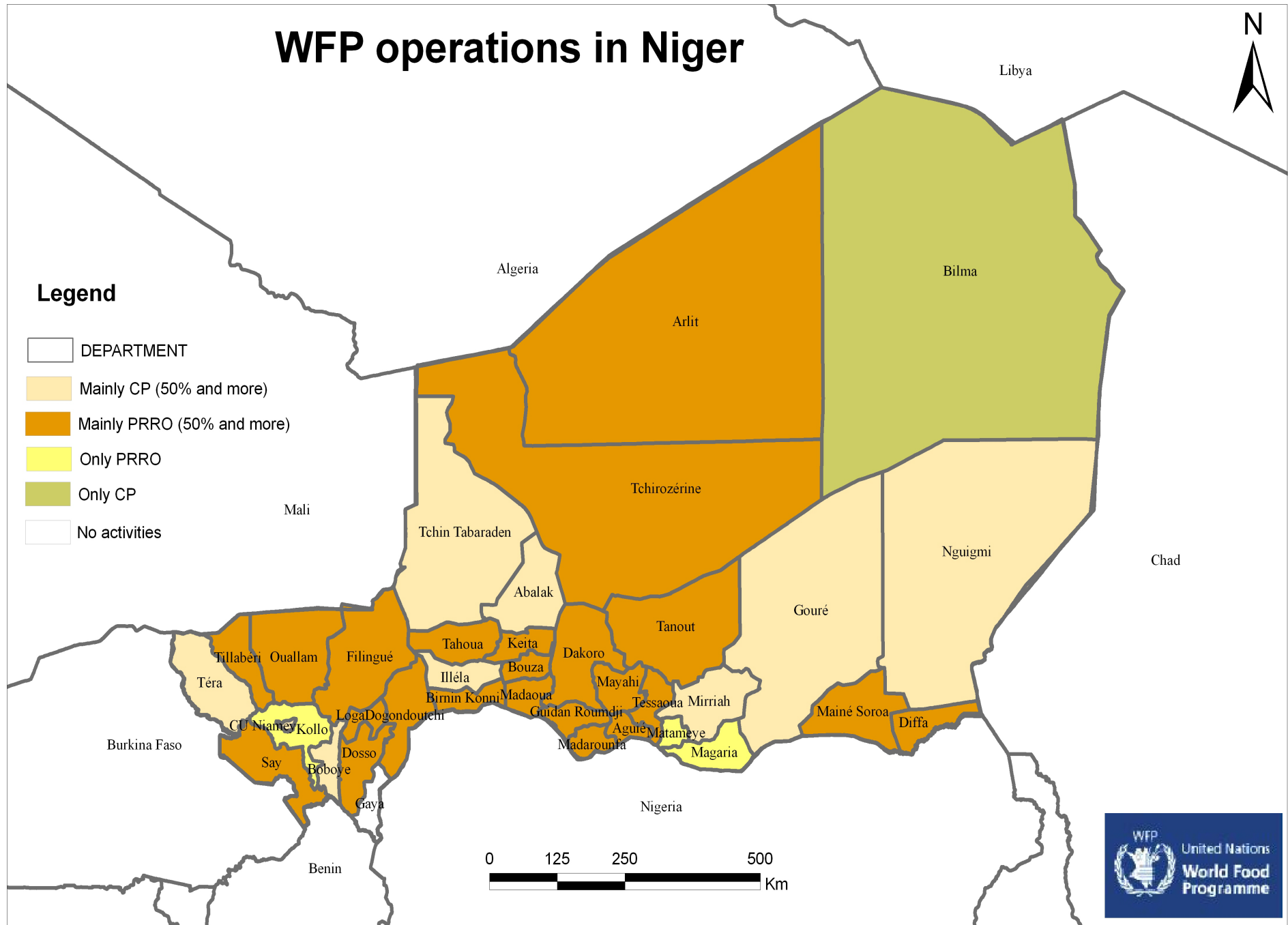


# WFP operations in Niger
