

Humanitarian convoys ambushed




Humanitarian personnel abducted/kidnapped

CPA is still the "bed rock" of peace in Sudan


However the CPA remains fragile

Lack of tangible peace dividends for average people

Rate of return lower than expected – lack of critical basic services

North/South border dispute remains

Disarmament, Demobilisation and Reintegration (DDR) process incomplete





SOUTHERN SUDAN

ACHIEVEMENTS

750,000 beneficiaries assisted in August 2007

- 166,500 returnees
- 94,000 IDPs and vulnerable residents
- 170,000 school children
- 300,000 people through Food for Recovery/Work

WFP continues to rehabilitate priority roads and airstrips with the Government's commitment of US\$55 million to the Special Operation

2008 PRIORITIES

SUDAN

DARFUR:

Support local peace efforts and voluntary returns of IDPs through early recovery activities

Incorporate conflict causalities and livelihood into food security analysis

Correct inclusion errors in camps

Reduce need for food sales by beneficiaries

Increase integrated nutritional activities with UNICEF and partners

SUDAN


GENERAL:

Strengthen market studies and increase local purchase opportunities

Expand outreach through school feeding

Continue to advocate with communities and local authorities on the shift from relief to recovery in Southern Sudan

Preposition food and improve access and cost efficiency of operation
