

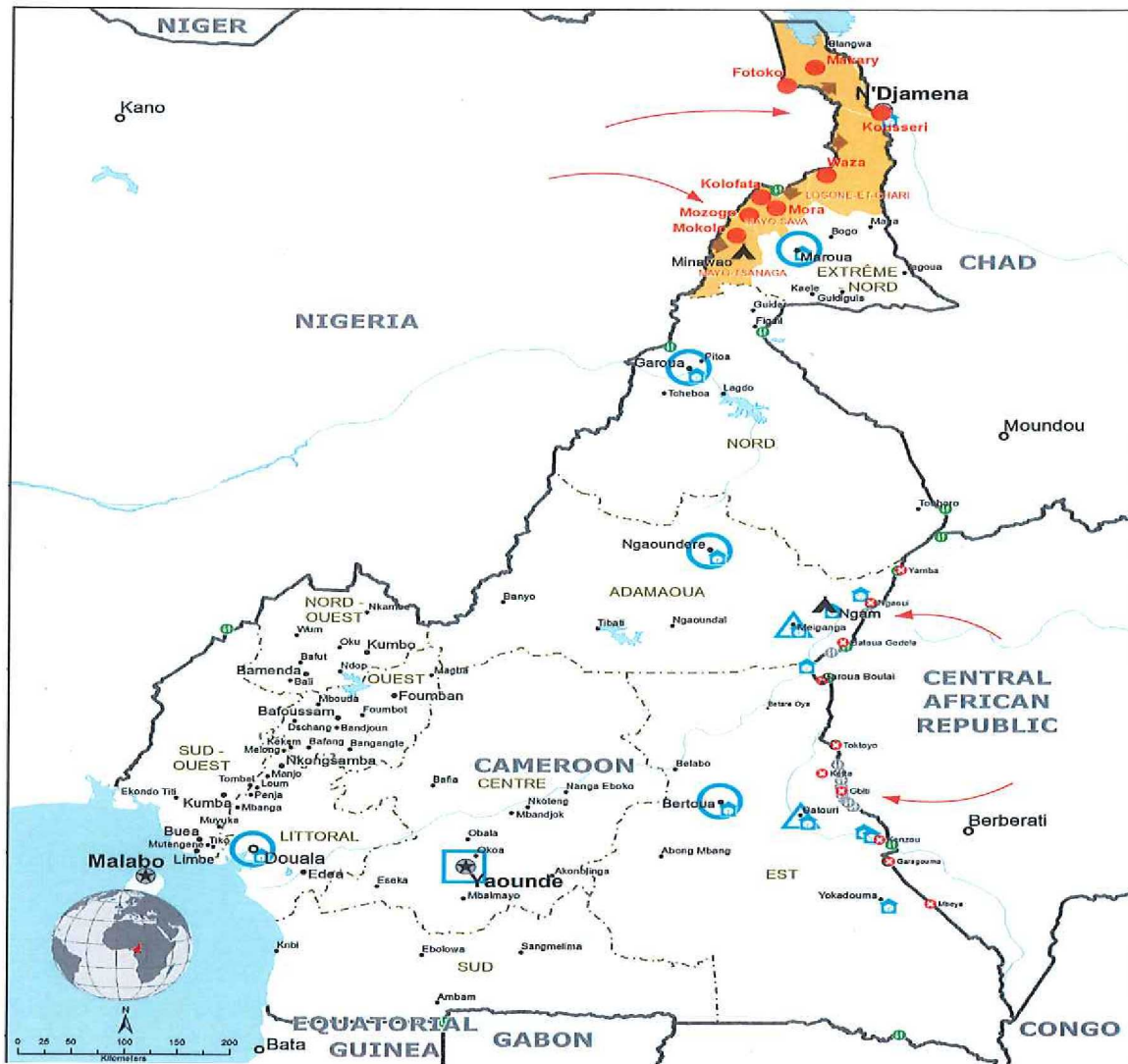

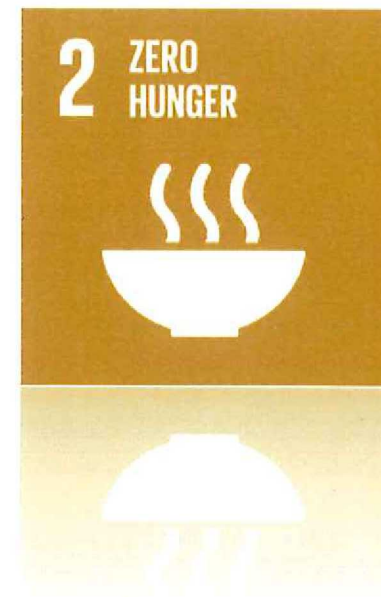

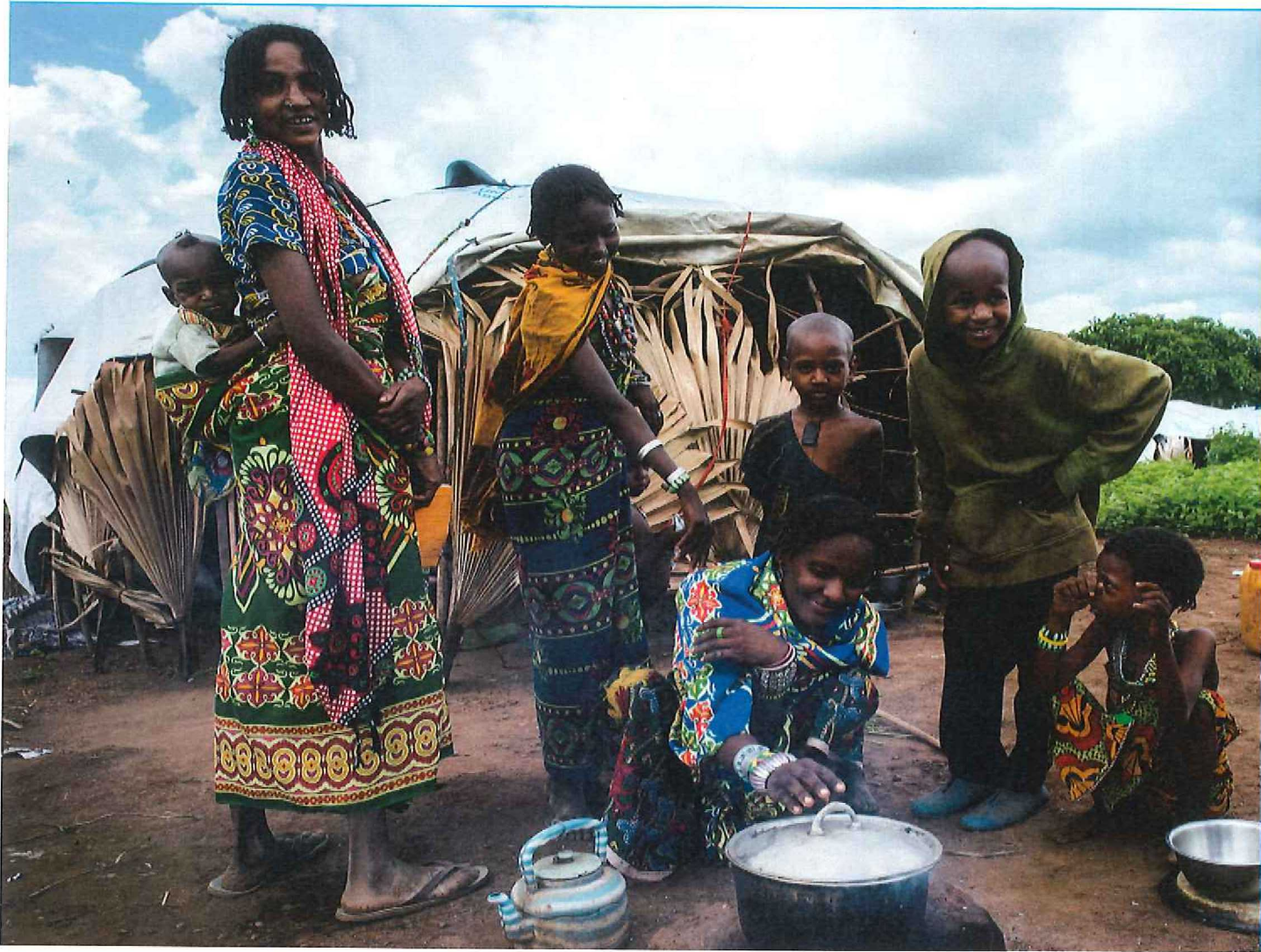

Conclusion



1. Shift from emergency response to early recovery and longer term resilience building
2. Provide a platform for the Government to better prevent, respond and mitigate future humanitarian crises
3. Budget: US\$ 183 million to support 500,000 people over three years
