2. Methodology

- Both teams have been working closely with government technicians to ensure the total appropriation by Government of Haiti of the Medium and Long Term Recovery Plan

Food Security and Nutrition Plan



1. Short-term humanitarian aid intervention

- Food distribution 2.5-3 million people and Rapid nutrition survey

2. National Nutrition Program for malnutrition prevention

- Improved breast feeding and complementary food consumption among children
- Improved hygiene and deworming
- Micronutrients for vulnerable groups and treatment of acute malnutrition

3. Improved household food security

- Food security safety net (self-targeted 60% cash 40% food)—linked to watershed management and reforestation
- Conditional cash transfers to poor women in urban slums
- School feeding with local purchase where possible
- Supplementary feeding for malnourished pregnant women

4. Risk reduction and management

- Early warning, decentralized stocks and warehouse facility

5. Enhanced national policies and institutions

- Legal framework for food quality and capacity building
- micronutrient fortification of staple foods
- support local production of high nutrition value foods

Agricultural Recovery Plan



Three Pillars

1. Rural Infrastructure and Local Development

- Watershed Management and Reforestation
- Irrigation and Feeder Roads
- Land tenure

2. Production and Value Chain Development

- Livestock
- Fisheries and Aquaculture
- Urban and Peri-Urban Horticulture
- Agricultural Inputs (seeds, fertilizers, tools)
- Local Purchases (with WFP)
- Value Chains and Trade

3. Agricultural Services

- Research and Extension
- Rural Credit (with IICA)
- Institutional Reinforcement
