

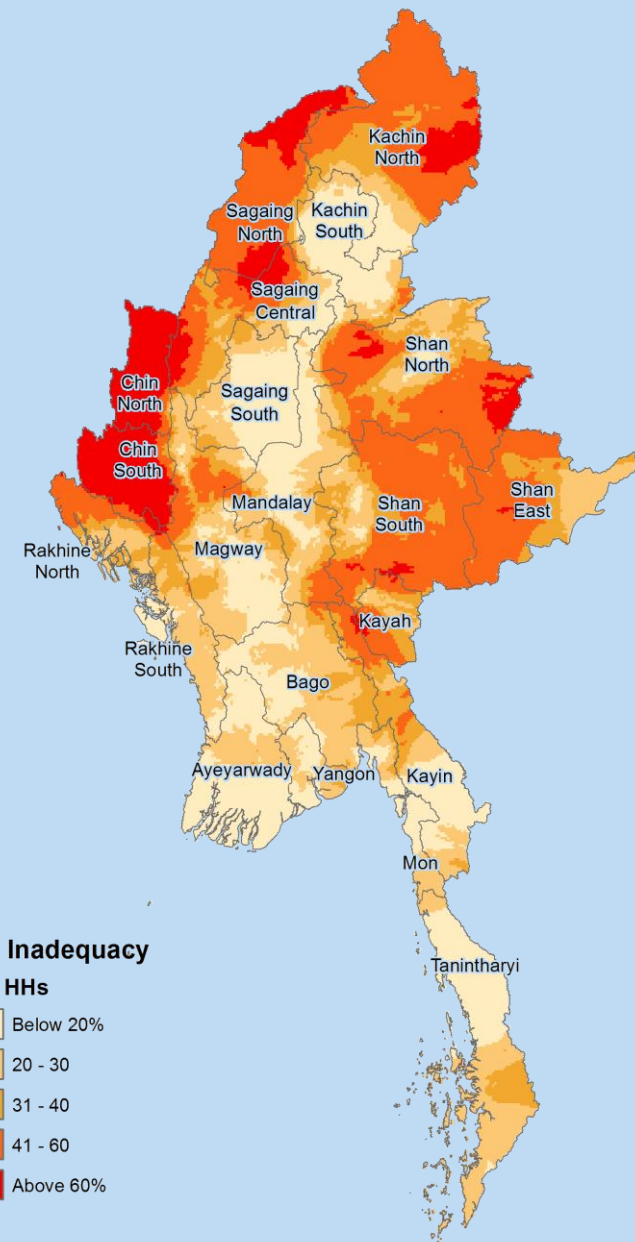


WFP Myanmar Country Strategic Plan (2018 – 2022)

13-16 November 2017, Rome, Italy*

Country Overview

- HDI: 145th out of 188 countries
- 26% below poverty line
- Global Huger Index: 77th out of 119 countries (serious)
- 2.1 million households food insecure (25%)
- Nutrition indicators improving but remain an issue (stunting: 29%; wasting: 7%; anemia: >40%)
- 2016 Global Climate Risk Index: 2nd out of 187 countries. 6.3m living in flood-affected areas.
- Complex humanitarian situation with ethnic conflict and inter-communal violence (7.9m people living in crisis-affected areas and 241,000 IDPs)
- 74% primary school completion rate
- Gender Inequality Index: 80th out of 159 countries



Strategic Outcomes

SO 1: Crisis-affected people in food-insecure areas meet their food and nutrition needs all year round

USD 127m

SO 2: Vulnerable people in states and regions with high food insecurity and/or malnutrition have access to food all year round

USD 137m

SO 3: Children under 5 in Myanmar have improved nutrition in line with national targets by 2022

USD 47m

Total (2018–2022): **USD 311 million**
