Context

WFP membership repeatedly expressed interest in knowing more about how WFP ensures transparency and accountability in its operations. As a custodian of the “performance management cycle” at corporate level, the Performance Management and Monitoring Division (RMP) has the duty to ensure adequate communication and visibility of all the activities related to project planning, monitoring and reporting. This event will be an occasion to interact with WFP membership and demonstrate that independent and rigorous monitoring is a cornerstone of WFP’s mission.

This thematic event organized by RMP is intended as an interactive display of WFP activities related to the performance management cycle or “cycle of accountability”. The main topics covered will be: project/country strategic plan design, planning and implementation in COMET (country office tool for managing effectively), annual performance planning and key performance indicators, monitoring activities, guidelines and trainings, performance reporting (corporate and country level annual reports). The event will also see the participation of the Vulnerability Analysis and Mapping, Information Technology and Operational Information Management units to present their activities related to data collection tools and reporting.

Objectives

The event will give the opportunity to members of the Executive Board to engage in these activities and gain a deeper understanding of how WFP ensures transparency, accountability and independent monitoring of all its operations. The space will be organized in booths following the performance management cycle (planning, monitoring and reporting) but the visitors will be able to move freely across the different stations. RMP staff will be available to give a brief introduction on each of the thematic areas and guide through the main practical steps to produce concrete deliverables (e.g. logical frameworks, monitoring surveys, project reports, etc.).
