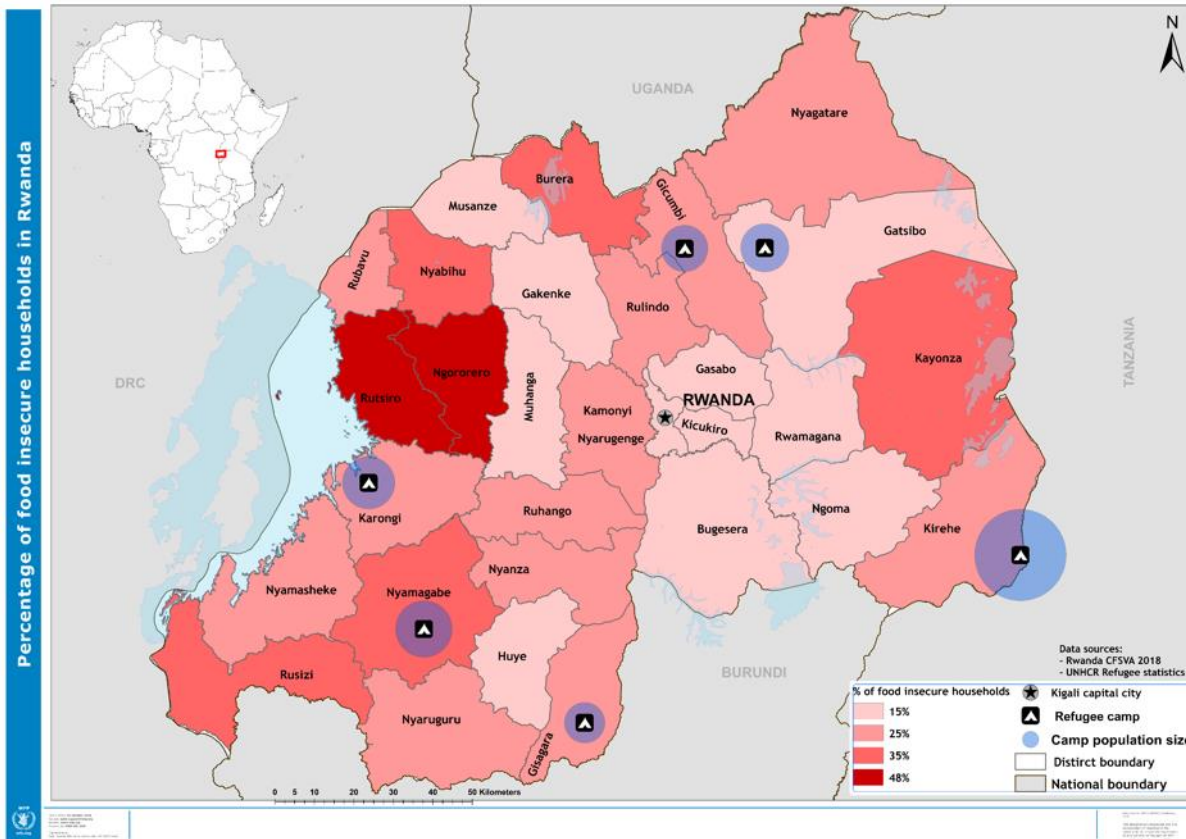

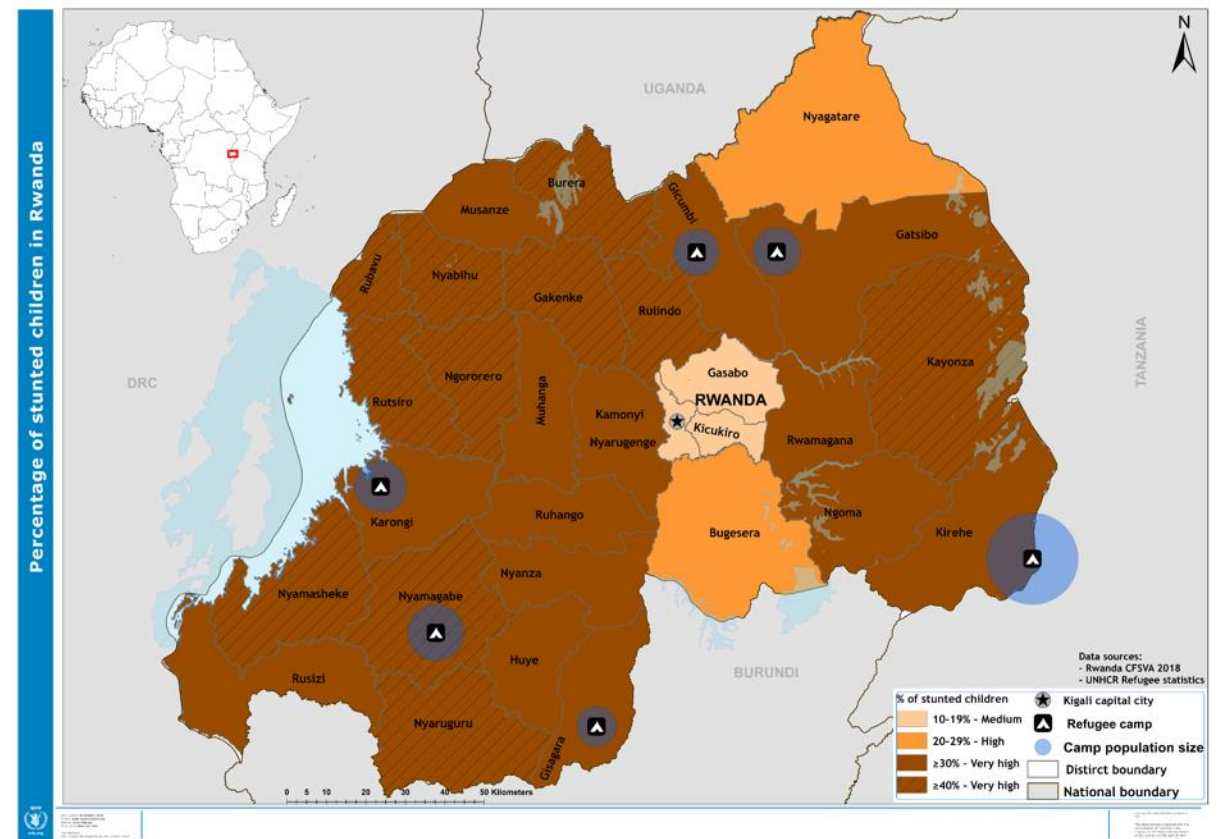


Food Insecurity



- One in five Rwandans is food insecure (2.2 million people)

Stunting



- Undernourishment affects 41 percent of the population (4.6 million people)
- National prevalence of stunting is very high, at 38 percent

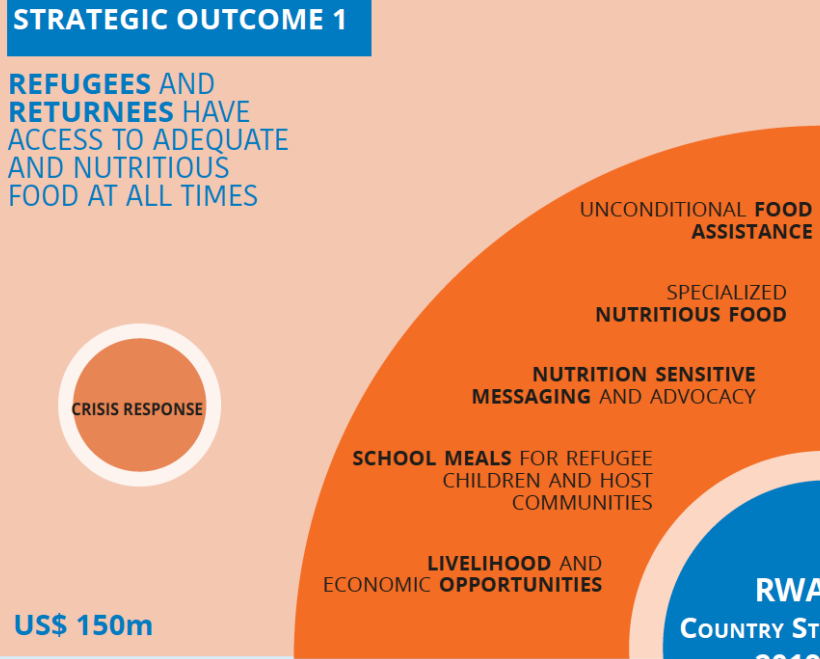

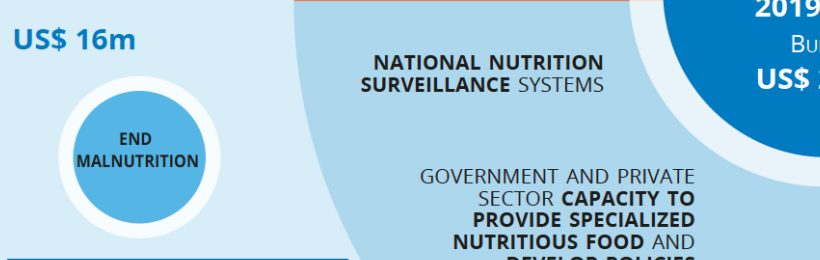

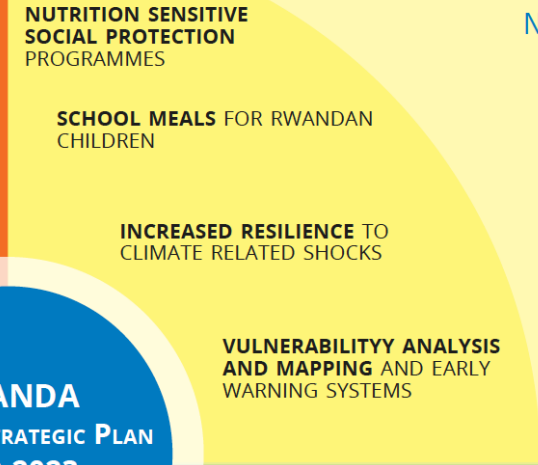
