Why Sierra Leone?



- **11 years of civil war**
- **Ebola outbreak in 2014 - 2016**
- **mudslides in 2017**
- **nearly half the population food insecure**
- **30% of children stunted**
- **highest maternal mortality in the world**
- **third most disaster-prone country globally**

The Sierra Leone CSP is aligned with:

- **UNDAF (currently under formulation; WFP is co-leading with FAO the first Pillar on Sustainable Agriculture, Food and Nutrition Security)**
- **National Zero Hunger Strategic Review (ZHSR); currently being finalized**
- **Newly launched National Development Plan 2019-2023 inspired by the *New Direction Agenda* of the new Government**
- **Consultations done with several bilateral partners, donors and NGO partners**

Working together in Partnerships

Strategic Shifts:

- **On Access:** using the integrated model for school feeding
- **Nutrition:** Shifting from treatment of malnutrition to prevention of stunting
- **Smallholder farmers:** support the agricultural objectives of the new Government
- **Capacity strengthening:** Building Government capacities.
