



Horn of Africa

Somalia, Kenya, Ethiopia, Uganda



Situation

- **13 million** people food insecure (IPC 3+), **17 million** projected by August
- Soaring malnutrition rates: over **870,000 children** in need of treatment for acute malnutrition

Response

- **FAO: USD 202 million** needed to assist **1.86 million** people
- **WFP: USD 562.3 million** to scale up to assist **4.7 million** people

Horn of Africa

Major concerns

- **3-4** bad cropping seasons out of **7** since 2016
- Early depletion of food stocks, high food prices, low herd sizes
- First season harvests – already delayed – expected to be **50%** below average
- Pastoralists at particular risk
- **8.1m** refugees and **5m** IDPs in the Horn

Horn of Africa – Drought, Displacement, Conflict

Ethiopia



8.1 million people are food insecure and in need of humanitarian food assistance



600,000 children under 5 are in need of treatment for acute malnutrition



7.3 million people are in need of water

Funding gap:

FAO: \$27.2 million, WFP: \$195 million

Kenya



2 million people are food insecure and in need of humanitarian food assistance



113,000 children under 5 are in need of treatment for acute malnutrition



3.5 million people are in need of water

Funding gap:

FAO: \$11.5 million, WFP: \$17 million

Somalia



2.2 million people are food insecure and in need of humanitarian food assistance



138,000 children under 5 are in need of treatment for acute malnutrition



2.9 million people are in need of water

Funding gap:

FAO: \$60 million, WFP: \$264 million

Uganda



600,000 people are food insecure and in need of humanitarian food assistance



22,000 children under 5 are in need of treatment for acute malnutrition



700,000 people are in need of water

Funding gap:

FAO: \$9 million, WFP: \$6 million

Dry Corridor

Guatemala, Honduras, El Salvador, Nicaragua

Situation

- **One of the regions most at risk of food insecurity: 2.2 million people** in Guatemala, Honduras and El Salvador affected by drought. **1.5m** people food insecure (IPC 3+)


Response

- **FAO:** released early action funds to kickstart activities: **USD 50m** needed.
- **WFP:** **700,000 people** targeted. **USD 27.6m** funding requirements (six months)



Sahel

Conflict, Drought



Situation

- **20 million** people in conflict affected areas
- **9.7 million** in acute hunger (wider Sahel)

Response

- **WFP**: scaling up to **1.7m** people. **USD 192m** required
- **FAO**: **USD 167m** required for 3years

Southern Africa

Drought

Situation

- **41 million** food insecure (peak lean season). **9 million** require immediate assistance

Zimbabwe

- Economic Recession + Drought
- **WFP**: to assist **2m** (out of **5.5m** food insecure)
- **FAO Drought Response Plan: USD 15m** for **250,000** drought-affected people



Haiti

Drought, Cyclone Season

Situation

- **2.6 million** people food insecure (IPC 3)
- Hurricane season

Response

- Major scale-up required to avert the crisis
- Humanitarian response critically underfunded
