Luís Fernando de Carvalho was born in São Paulo, Brazil, in 1969.

Graduated in Law at the University of São Paulo (USP) in 1992 and International Relations at the School of Sociology and Politics of São Paulo (FESPSP) in 1994.

Joined the Brazilian Foreign Service in 1996. As a diplomat, he has been posted to the Brazilian Consulate in Los Angeles (2001-2004), and to the Brazilian Embassies in Beijing (2004-2006), Tokyo (2007-2009) and Madrid (2011-2014), where he was the head of the political section. He has also been posted to the Brazilian Representative Office in Ramallah, Palestine, as Minister-Counselor.

In Brasília, at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, he worked at the Protocol (1999-2001) at the Press Office (2009-2011) and was also as an adviser to the Minister of External Relations for issues regarding the Middle East and Africa (2016-2018).

Currently working as the Deputy Chief of Mission at the Brazilian Delegation to FAO, WFP, and IFAD.

In 2013, presented a thesis for the High Studies Course at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, later published as the book "The resurgence of the Catalan nationalism".
