Before covid-19, 3.4 million people were severely food insecure

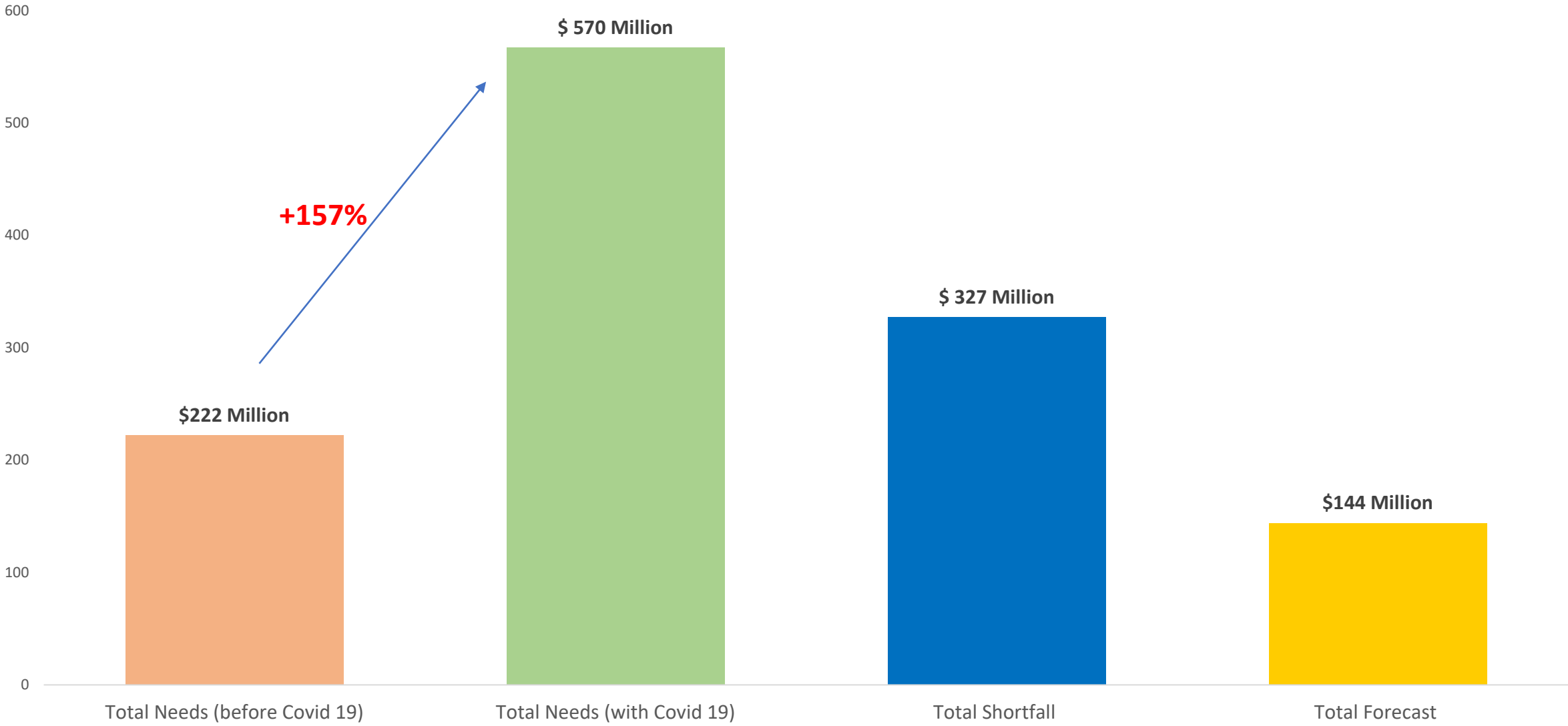
Now, due to the impact of covid-19, this figure has increase up to 14.7 million in LAC

-  Countries where WFP has presence

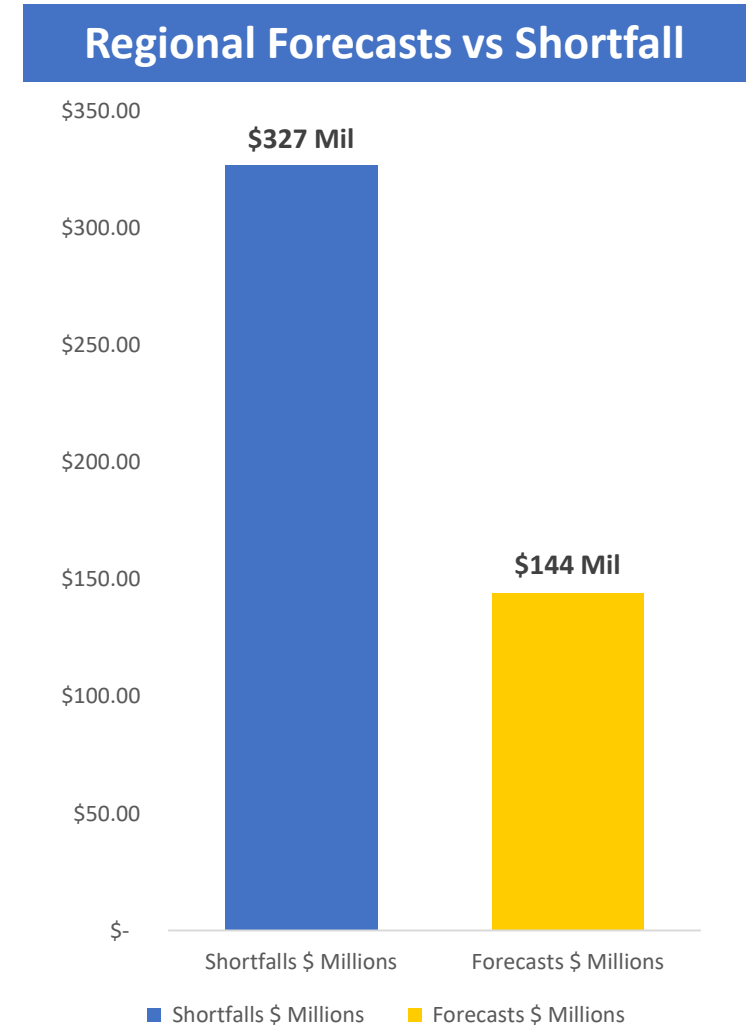
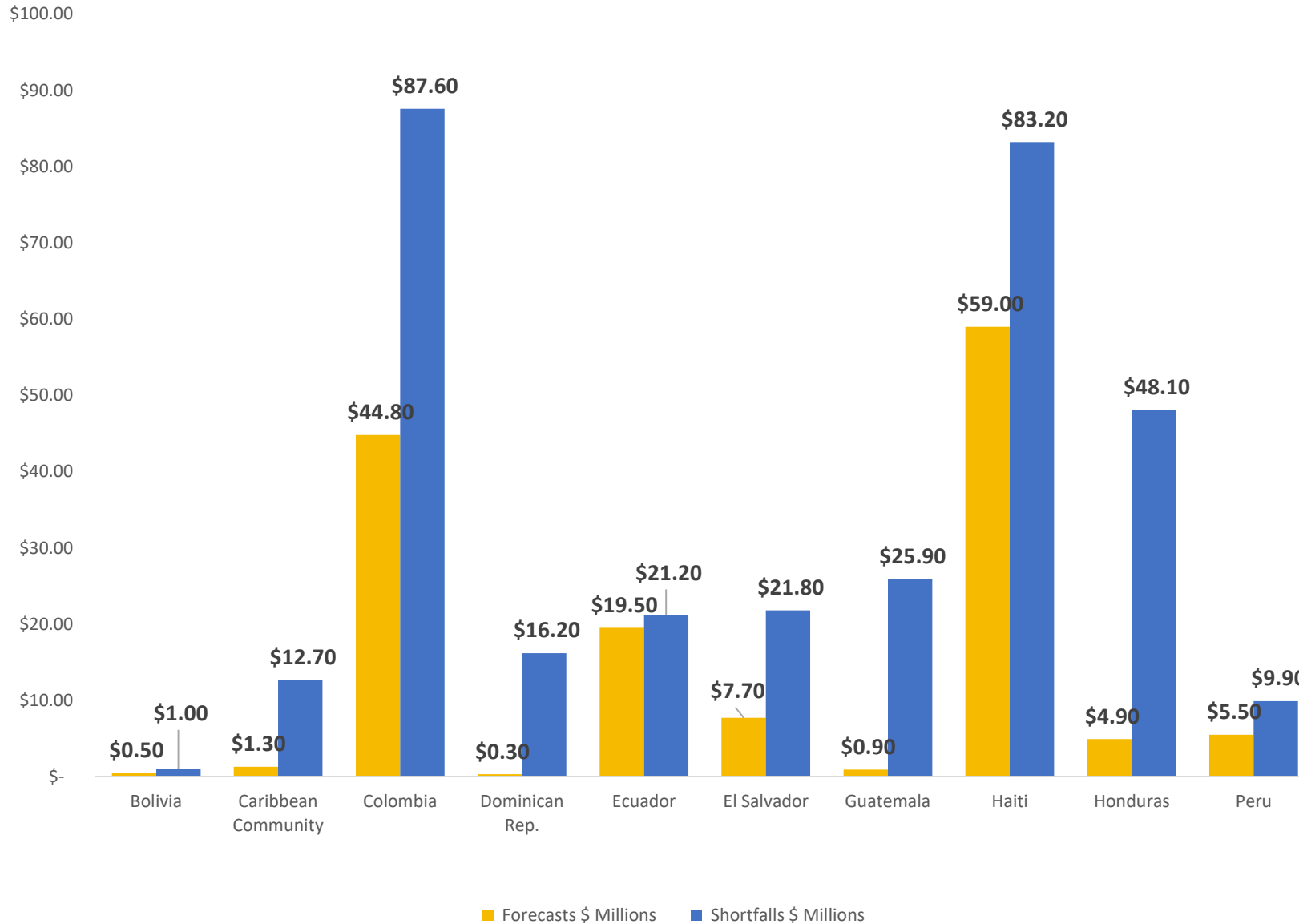
WFP LAC: Needs Overview 2020
