UN DEVELOPMENT SYSTEM REFORM OPERATIONALIZATION

 Global guidance on Cooperation Frameworks in exceptional circumstances developed by the inter-agency Programme Working Group and approved by the UNSDG Principals in April.

• Advanced draft guidance on Joint Programmes developed to replace the 2014 guidelines and make joint programmes more effective, easier to use, with fewer transaction costs.

• WFP internal guidance on the Cooperation Framework is being updated (Q3, 2022).

• **Second Generation CSP Working Group** continues to coordinate internally programmatic implications of UN Development System Reform.

CSP ALIGNMENT WITH COOPERATION FRAMEWORKS

 Cooperation Frameworks and Common Country Analysis are progressing at country level. 55% of UN Country Teams are now operating with a new Cooperation Framework.

- Alignment status of second generation CSPs with Cooperation Frameworks:
 - WFP's development interventions are directly derived from Cooperation Frameworks outcomes.

 WFP is taking part of an inter-agency desk review to assess the quality of Common Country Analyses (CCAs) and Cooperation Frameworks (UNSDCF).
