## **Statistical report on international professional staff and higher categories at 31 December 2022**

### **Introduction**

1. This document provides information on the composition of WFP's international professional and higher staff holding continuing, indefinite or fixed-term (one year or more) appointments. Statistics on junior professional officers (JPOs) participating in WFP activities are also provided, in table 4. The information reflects the situation as at 31 December 2022 except where otherwise indicated.

### **Staffing statistics for international professional staff and higher**

#### **Gender and geographical representation by grade**

2. The total number of international professional staff excluding JPOs increased by 20.4 percentage points, from 1,882 at 31 December 2021 to 2,265 at 31 December 2022.

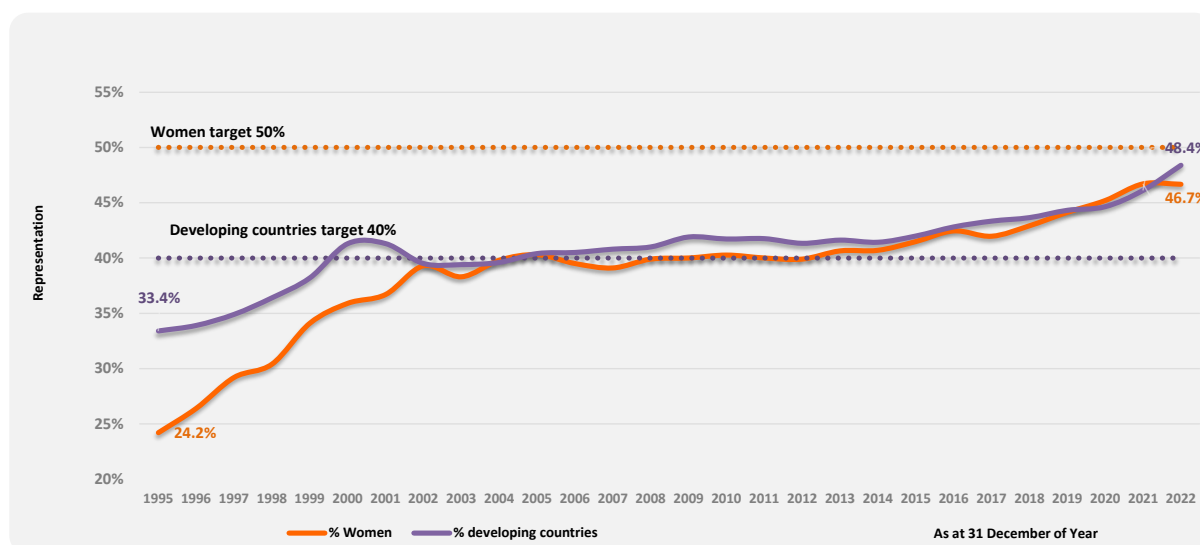

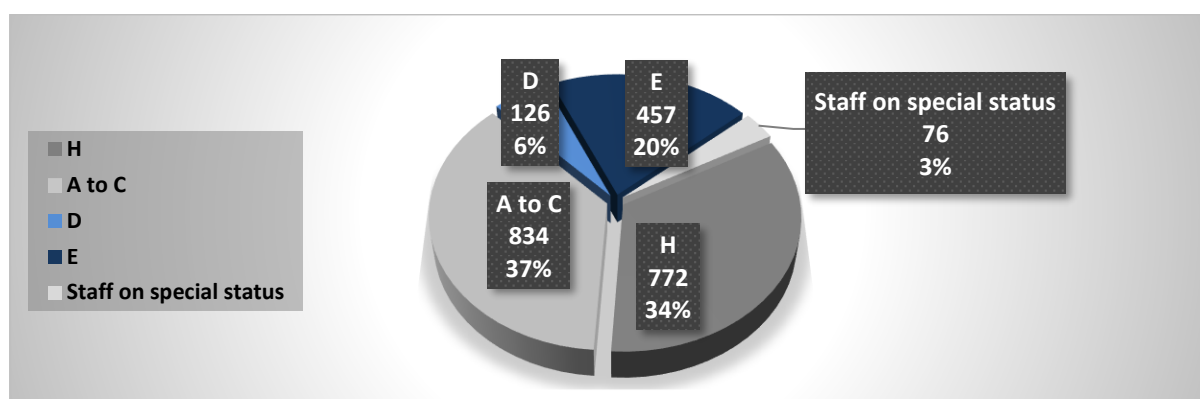

#### Staff distribution by hardship classification and duty station

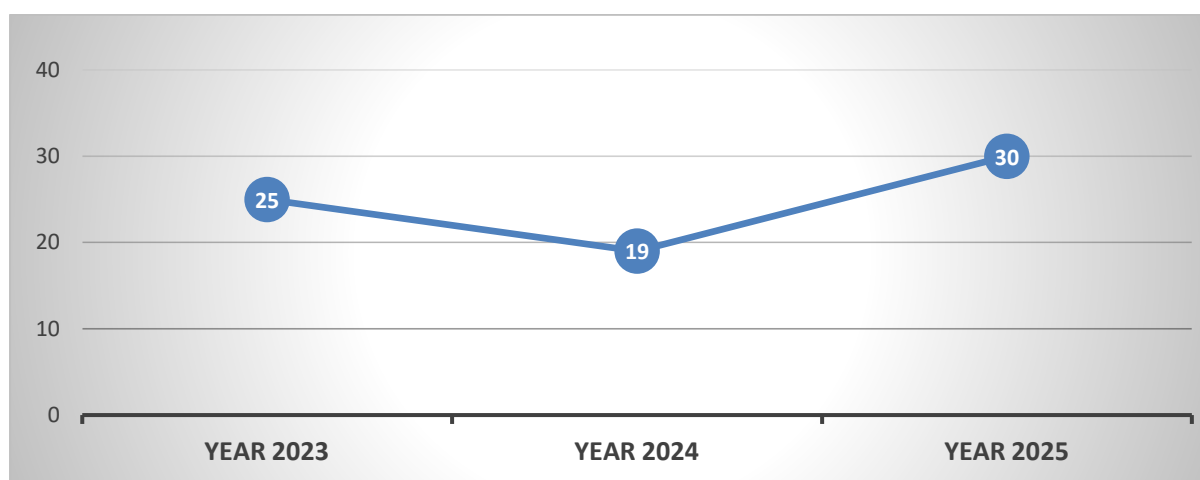
- Of 2,265 international professional staff, 583 (25.7 percent) were located in D or E hardship duty stations (figure 2).

- Duty station hardship classification is set by the International Civil Service Commission. H duty stations are headquarters or similarly designated locations. Duty stations are categorized from A to E with A being duty stations that pose the least hardship. In determining the degree of hardship, consideration is given to safety and security, healthcare, housing, climate, isolation and the availability of basic amenities of life.
- Staff on special status includes staff on leave without pay or on loan or secondment to other agencies.

**Staff retirement forecast**

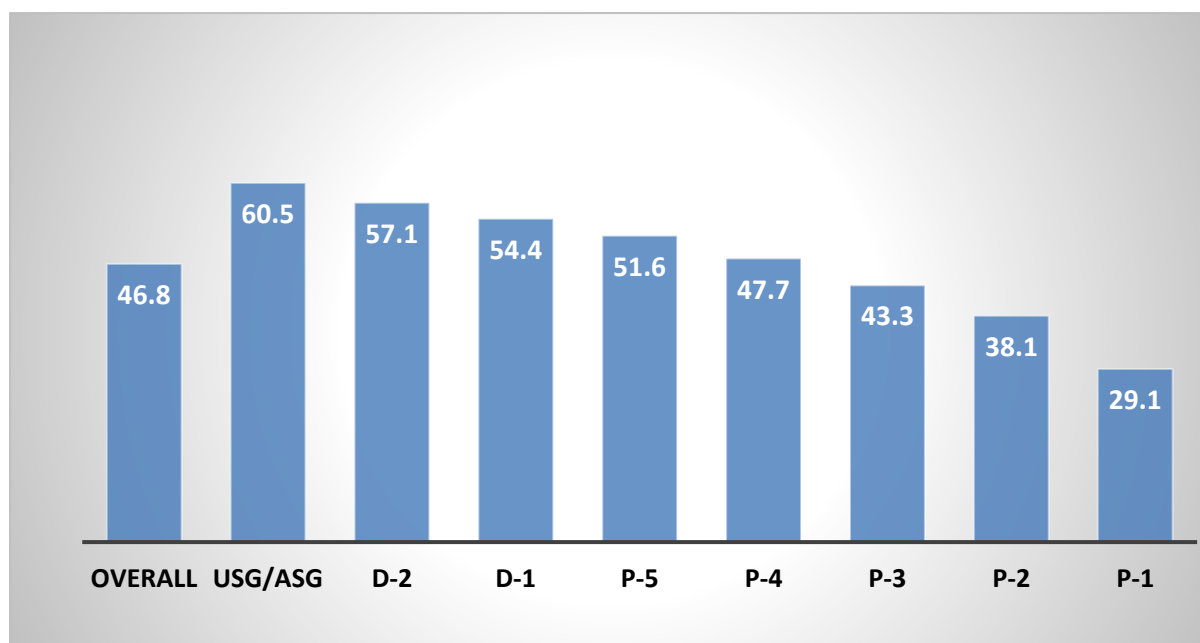
5. In 2022, 36 international professional staff retired. Between 2023 and 2025, 74 (3.3 percent) of 2,265 staff will be reaching the mandatory retirement age of 65 (figure 3).
