### **Latin America's Paradox**




#### Results...

- Active public sector
- High potential in agriculture

### Policy's contribution to regional food systems



LRFPP added value: Development of local food value chains in support of sustainable food systems

### Implementation challenges


- Limited knowledge of informal markets
- Mobilization of technical capacities
- Timing of funds availability
- Lack of digital traceability systems





### **Achievements**

- Full engagement in 4 COs (El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Nicaragua)
- 8 Value Chain Assessments concluded
- 46% volume increase of local and regional procurement in 2022
- Implementation of new contract modalities

Support government public procurement (Guatemala and Honduras)


Promote connections with the **private sector** including
