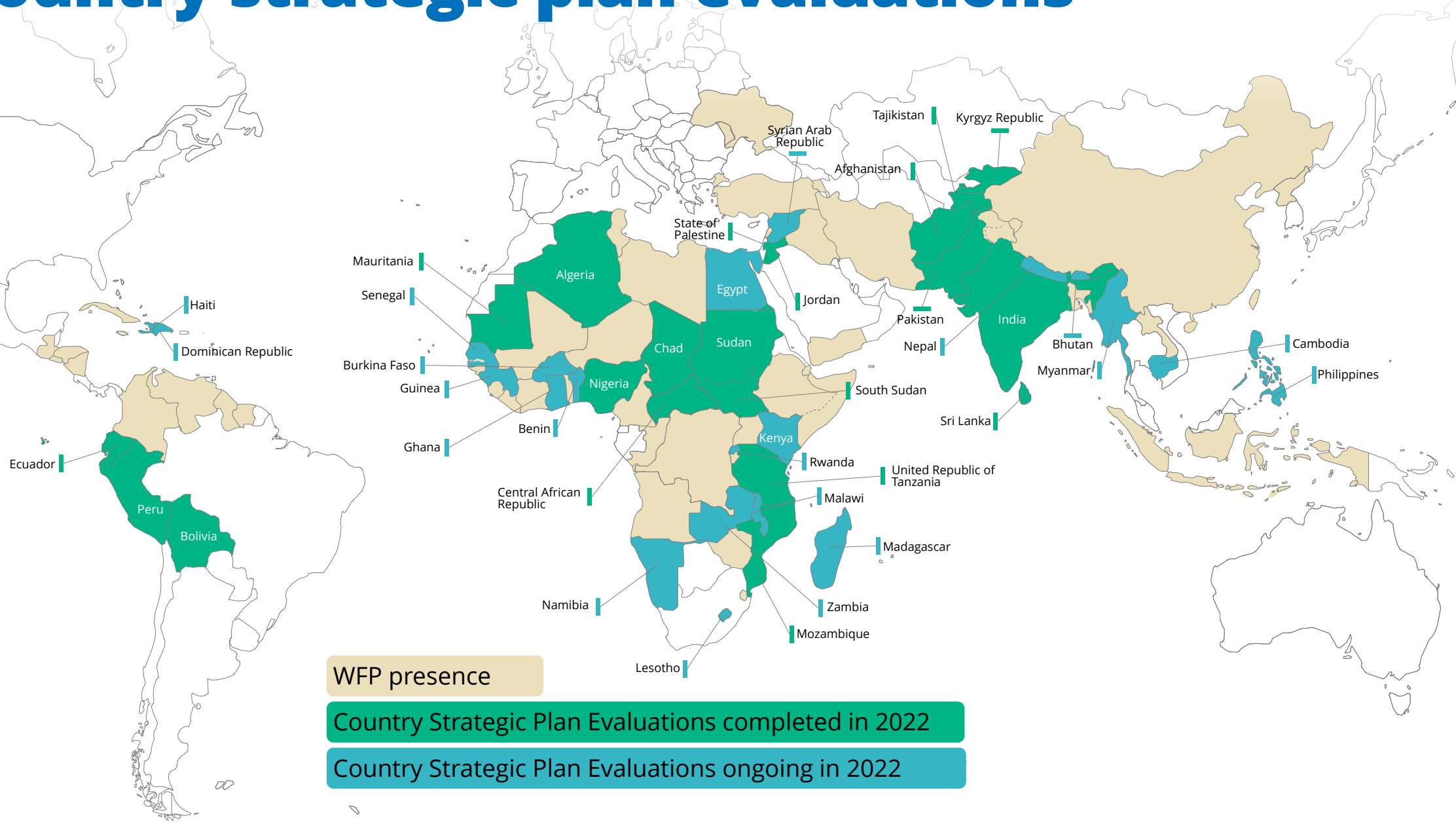

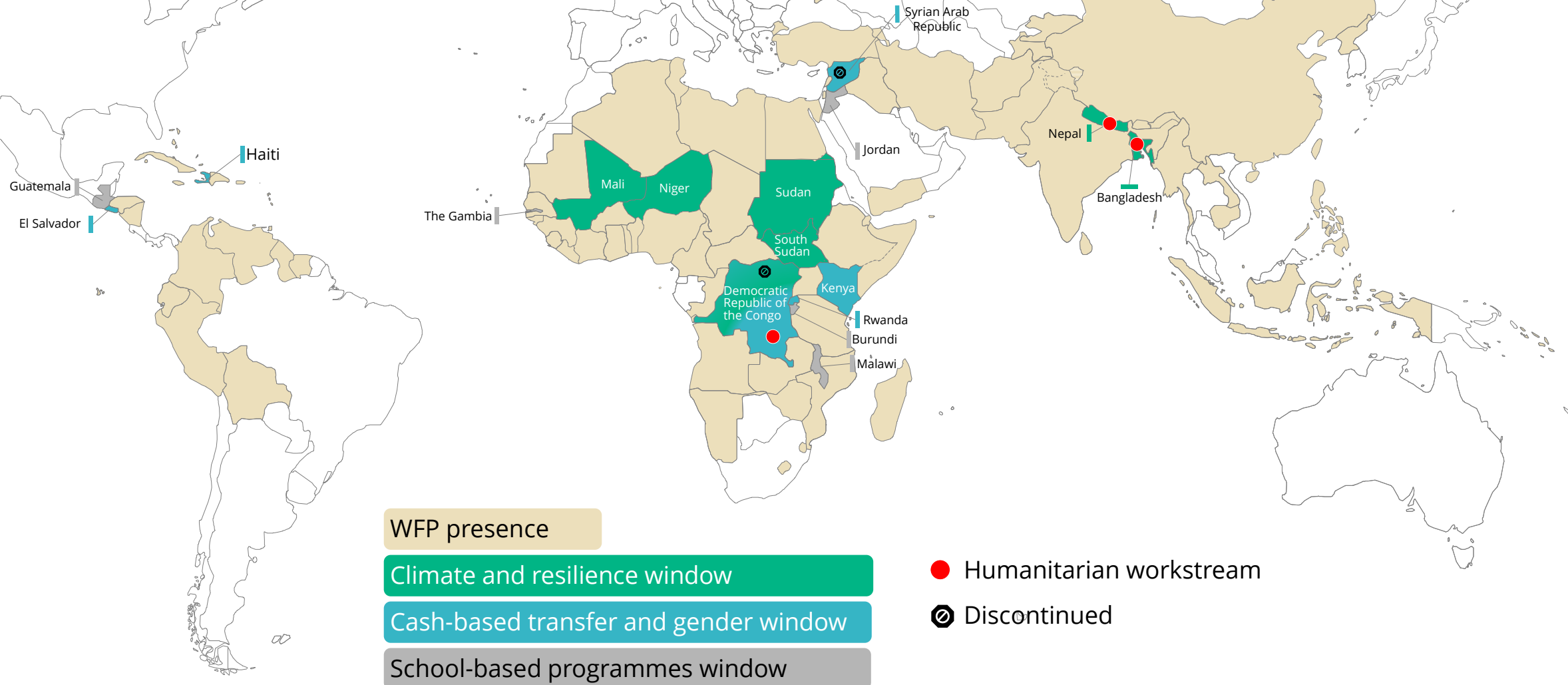

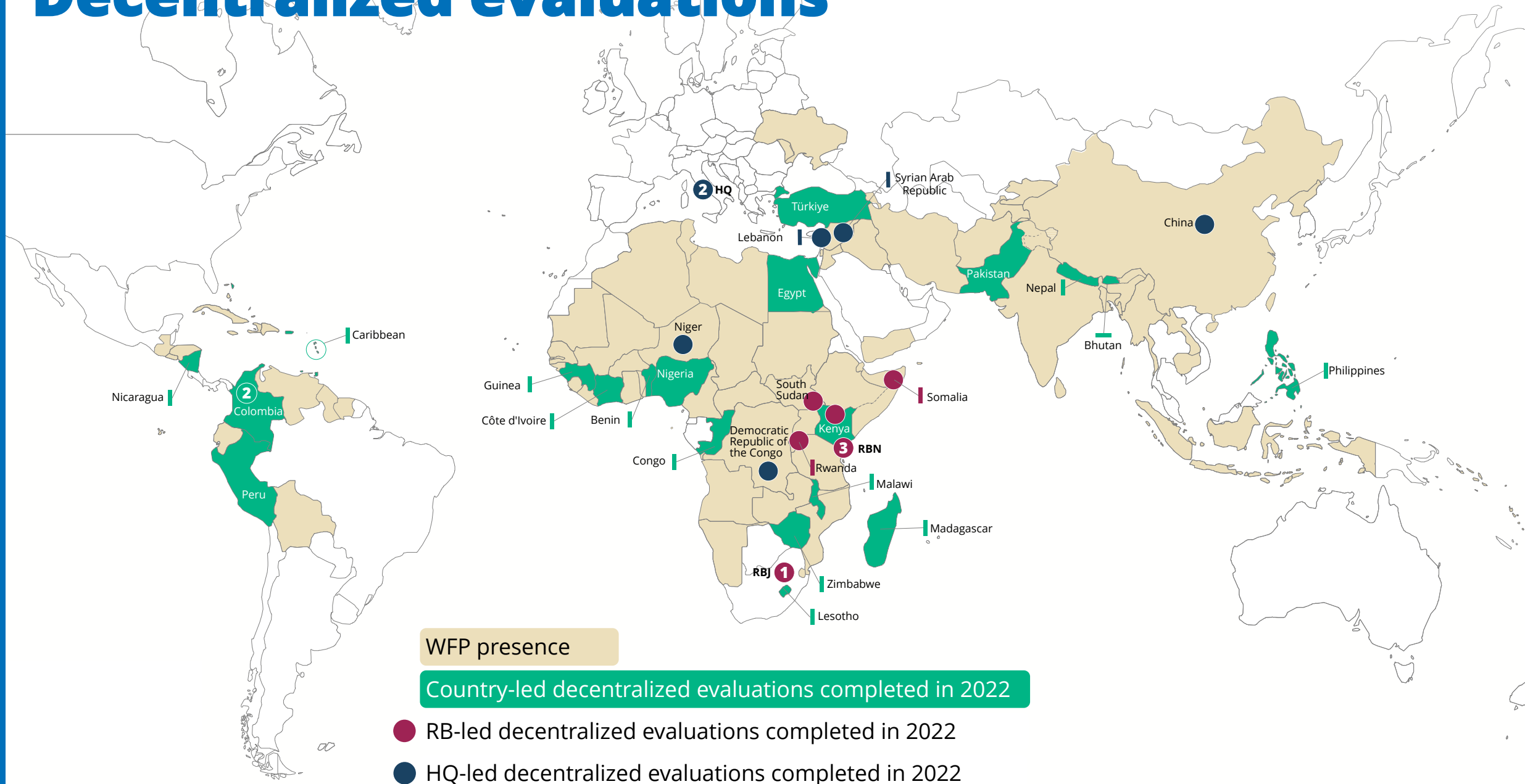

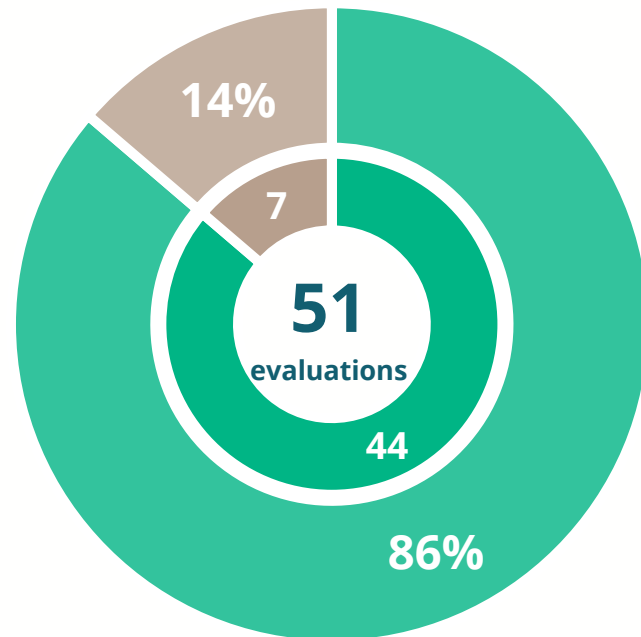

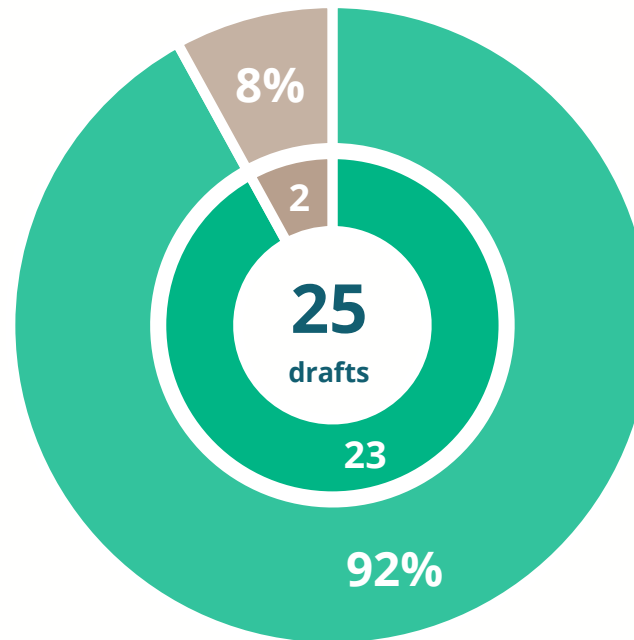

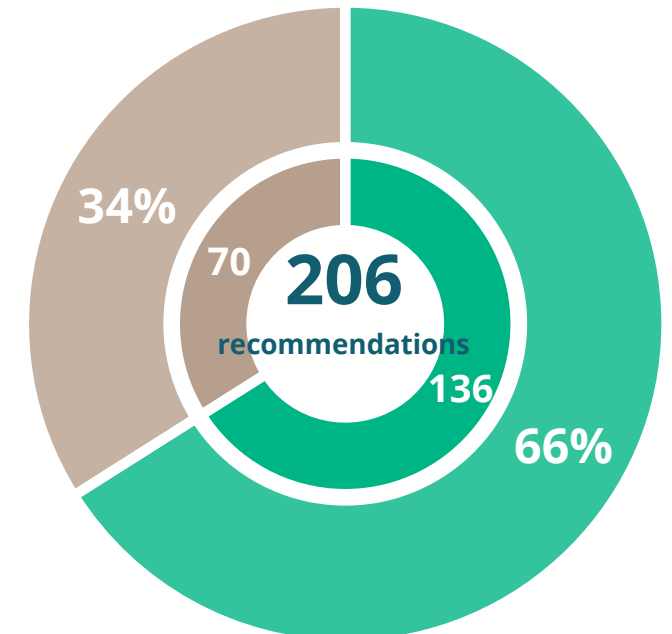

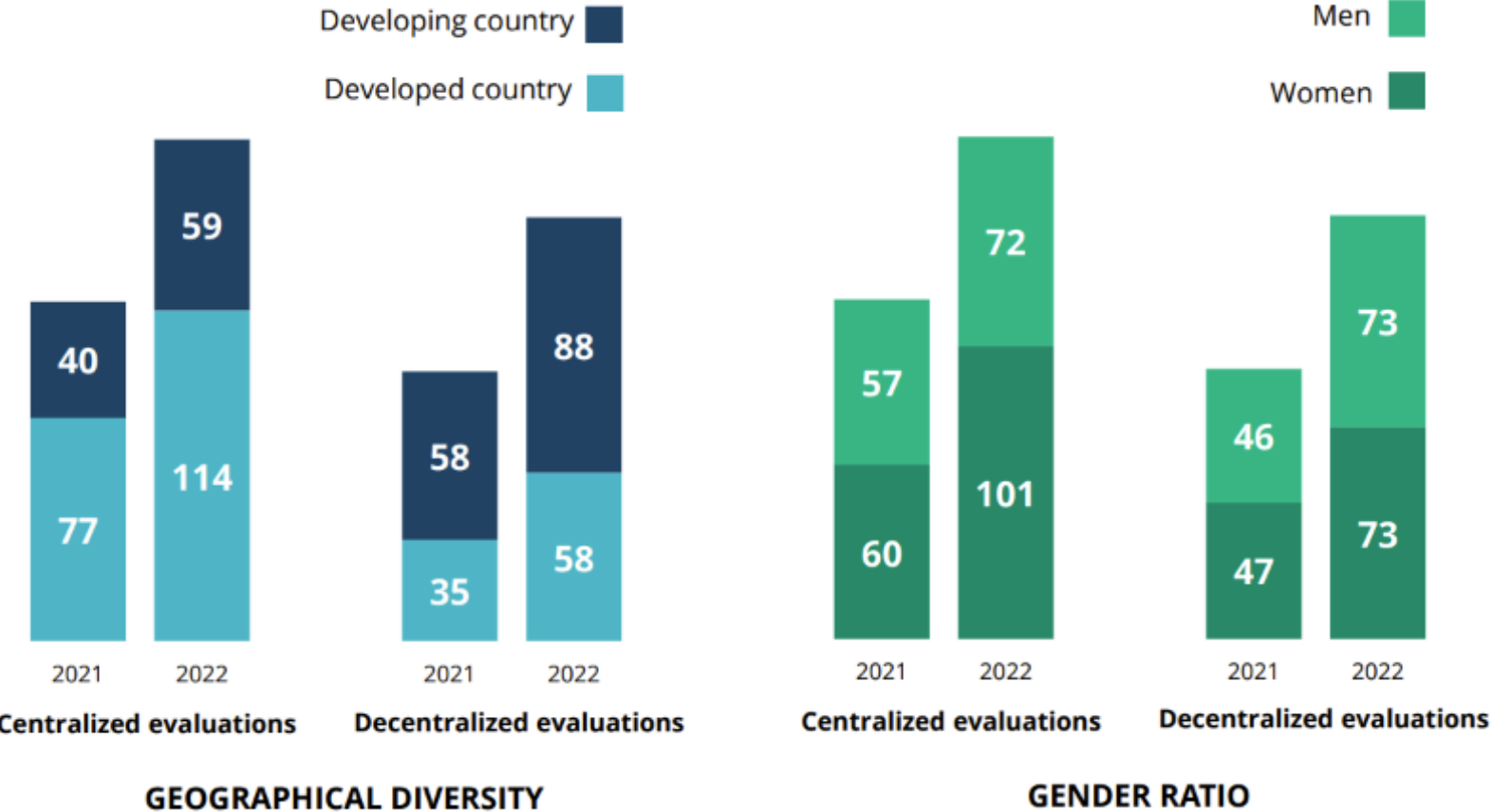

Implementation status of evaluation recommendations due in 2022

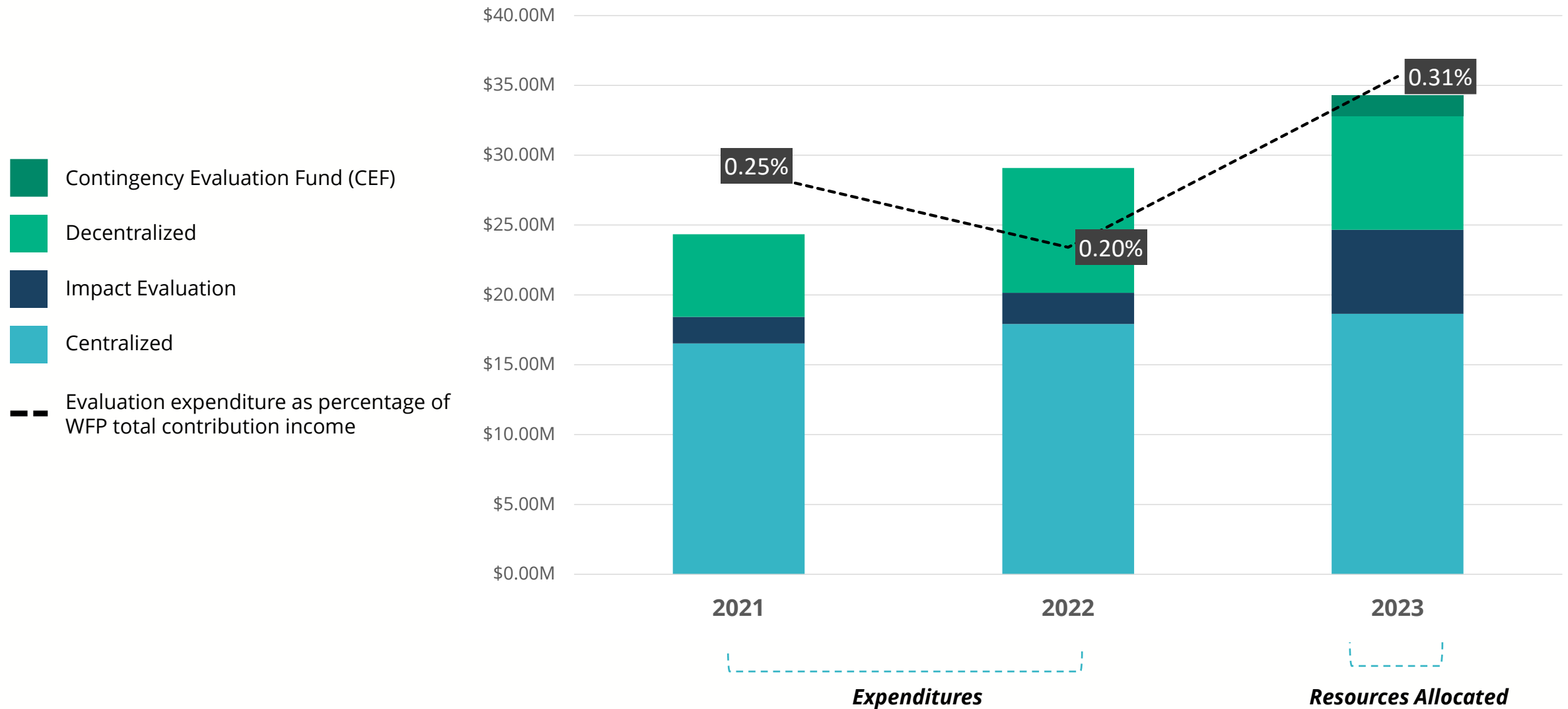
