

+200,000 people in Haiti and 25,000 in Cuba affected by floods. **1.5M** additional people in the Dry Corridor will be affected.


> **780,000** people affected by coastal El Niño in Peru, Ecuadorand Bolivia.

39.9 Million people are estimated to be food insecure










