

HOW GOVERNANCE WORKS AT WFP


Executive Board (36 Members)

- Provides accountability to the Board





Electoral make-up of the Executive Board Membership

List A	Africa	8 members
List B	Asia & Middle East	7 members
List C	Latin America & the Caribbean	5 members
List D	North America, Western Europe, Japan, Australia and New Zealand	12 members
List E	Central and Eastern Europe	3 members

+1 rotational seat from Lists A, B and C (elected via FAO Council)

- Second regular session (November)
