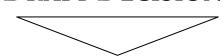

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The Board takes note of "Budget Increases to Protracted Relief and Recovery Operations Approved by the Executive Director (1 July–31 December 2010)" (WFP/EB.A/2011/11-D).

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1. This paper outlines protracted relief and recovery operations (PRROs) and budgetary increases approved by the Executive Director under her delegated authority between 1 July and 31 December 2010.

- 2. In accordance with Board decisions, the Executive Director's delegated authority with regard to the PRRO programme category includes:
  - ➤ approval of PRROs and budget increases for PRROs whose food value does not exceed US\$20 million. Note that the total of increases for a given country in a calendar year may not exceed US\$40 million; any further increase in a calendar year requires approval by the Board.
  - ➤ approval of budget revisions to PRROs incorporating cash or voucher transfers with an overall increase in food value not exceeding US\$20 million.

## **Budget Increases**

- 3. Between 1 July and 31 December 2010, the Executive Director approved 34 budget increases within her delegated authority for PRROs previously approved by the Board. The total food value of these increases was US\$108,049,290; the total cost to WFP was US\$212,637,297. Detailed budget figures and reasons for each increase are given in the tables below.
- 4. Comparing the 2010 increases with those approved during the same period in 2009, the Executive Director approved eight more budget increases between July and December 2010, amounting to US\$72,247,605 more in food value and US\$95,474,699 more in terms of the total cost to WFP.
- 5. Nearly one third of the budget increases were made to allow for inclusion of cash and voucher transfer programmes in existing operations or because the number of beneficiaries increased following a shock. Another reason for increases was to extend the implementation period of existing projects to ensure adequate time for transferring some activities to development programmes as a reflection of changed country contexts and in line with the programme category review considered by the Board at its 2010 Annual Session. Increases in landside transport, storage and handling costs, due to higher local fuel prices or changes to transport routes, were also a reason for increases. The budget increases for the activities in Colombia, Kenya, Mozambique and the Occupied Palestinian Territory represented 50 percent of the total increases for the period.

### **New Operations**

6. Between 1 July and 31 December 2010, the Executive Director approved five new PRROs within her delegated authority, in Bangladesh, Chad, Madagascar, Nepal and Tajikistan. The total food value of these new operations was US\$56,911,298; the total cost to WFP was US\$108,327,649. Summaries of the operations are contained in separate documents.



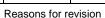
