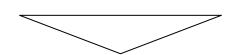

The Board takes note of "Budget Increases to Protracted Relief and Recovery Operations Approved by the Executive Director (1 July–31 December 2009)" (WFP/EB.A/2010/11-C).

* This is a draft decision. For the final decision adopted by the Board, please refer to the Decisions and Recommendations document issued at the end of the session.



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1. In accordance with Board decisions, the Executive Director has the delegated authority to approve protracted relief and recovery operations (PRROs) and budget increases for PRROs whose food value does not exceed US\$20 million, including revisions to incorporate cash or voucher transfers. However, the total of such increases for a given country in a calendar year may not exceed US\$40 million. If such increases do exceed US\$40 million, all subsequent budget revisions for that year require approval by the Board.

Budget Increases

- 2. Between 1 July and 31 December 2009, the Executive Director authorized 26 budget increases within her delegated authority for approved PRROs. The total food value of these increases was US\$35,801,685; the total cost to WFP was US\$117,162,598. Detailed budget figures and reasons for each increase are given in the attached tables.
- 3. Comparing the 2009 increases with those authorized during the same period in 2008, the Executive Director authorized 22 fewer budget increases between July and December 2009, amounting to US\$115,825,975 less in food value and US\$223,716,208 less in terms of the total cost to WFP.
- 4. Nearly one third of the budget increases were made to accommodate landside transport, storage and handling costs, which were higher than expected because of increases in local fuel prices or because the number of beneficiaries increased following a shock. Other reasons include extensions of the implementation period of existing projects, inclusion of in-kind donations, or increases to other direct operational costs or direct support costs to incorporate activities such as cash for work or food for work.

New Operations

5. Between 1 July and 31 December 2009, the Executive Director authorized four new PRROs within her delegated authority, in Djibouti, Namibia, Rwanda and the United Republic of Tanzania. The total food value of these new operations was US\$44,774,638; the total cost to WFP was US\$90,153,682. Summaries of the operations are contained in separate documents.
