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#### NOTE TO THE EXECUTIVE BOARD

Between 1 July and 31 December 1997, the Executive Director authorized 18 budgetary increases within her delegated authority for approved projects. The total food value of these increases amounts to 11.2 million dollars<sup>1</sup> and the total cost to WFP to 17.1 million dollars. Detailed budgetary figures and reasons for each increase are given in the Annex.
