## Background

52 WFP projects funded by DEVCO **between 2007 and 2014**

→ **€ 258.5 million**

- *Mainly PRROs linked to food crises in 2008 and 2012*
- *But also included a number of development operations*

➔ Led to the DEVCO-WFP **Framework for Collaboration** 2014-2020

## Indicative collaboration framework

Providing **technical assistance for developing national expertise in:**

1. *Food and Nutrition insecurity Analysis*
2. *National/Regional strategic/emergency reserves, food stocks*
3. *Safety nets*
4. *Stunting reduction, including food fortification*



**To reach National policies' objectives and EU's sector objectives**



## Added value of the DEVCO-WFP partnership

### For WFP

- Shifting to **food assistance**
- **Strengthening national capacities** in line with SDG2
- Multi-year funding and timeframes for increased effectiveness

### For DEVCO and partner countries

- **Support at decentralized level:** districts and communities

### Preparedness and food emergency reserves

*Strengthening national institutional capacities for early response to food crises*

**2016-2017**

#### **Expected results:**

- Technical assistance to the national early warning system





## TANZANIA

### Undernutrition - Stunting

*Supporting food and nutrition safety in Tanzania for stunting reduction in districts of the Dodoma and Singida regions, in the framework of the SUN Initiative*

**2016-2021**

#### **Expected results:**

- Production and consumption of diversified nutritious crops
- Nutrition data management and coordination at district level
