Current Project Portfolio – 2015 in Numbers

- **14.4 million** people reached.
- **515,000 mt** of food delivered.
- **USD 19 million** cash-based transfers provided.
- **25,000** partners trained.
- **72,000** hectares of land rehabilitated.
- **8,500 km** roads built.
- **4,000** health centres assisted.
- **20,000** schools reached.

Current Project Portfolio – 2015 in Outcomes

SO1

- 97% of flood-affected households in Nepal reached acceptable food consumption levels.
- MAM recovery rates exceeded 75% (sphere standards) in Bangladesh, Pakistan and Philippines.

SO2

- Diet Diversity Score targets exceeded in Myanmar, Pakistan, Philippines.
- Retention rates approached 100% in Sri Lanka and Philippines schools, against targets of 70%.

Current Project Portfolio – 2015 in Outcomes

S03

- Proportion of communities with increased asset scores: 100% in Bangladesh, 91% in Nepal, 88% in Cambodia.
- National Capacity Index in Philippines was 3.1, against target of 2.7.

S04

- 61% children 6-23 mos received more than 4 food groups in Bangladesh, against target of 45%.
- ART adherence rate for PLHIV in Myanmar was 91%, against target of 80%.
- Net enrolment rate of girls in primary schools in Bhutan was 98%, against target of 98%.
