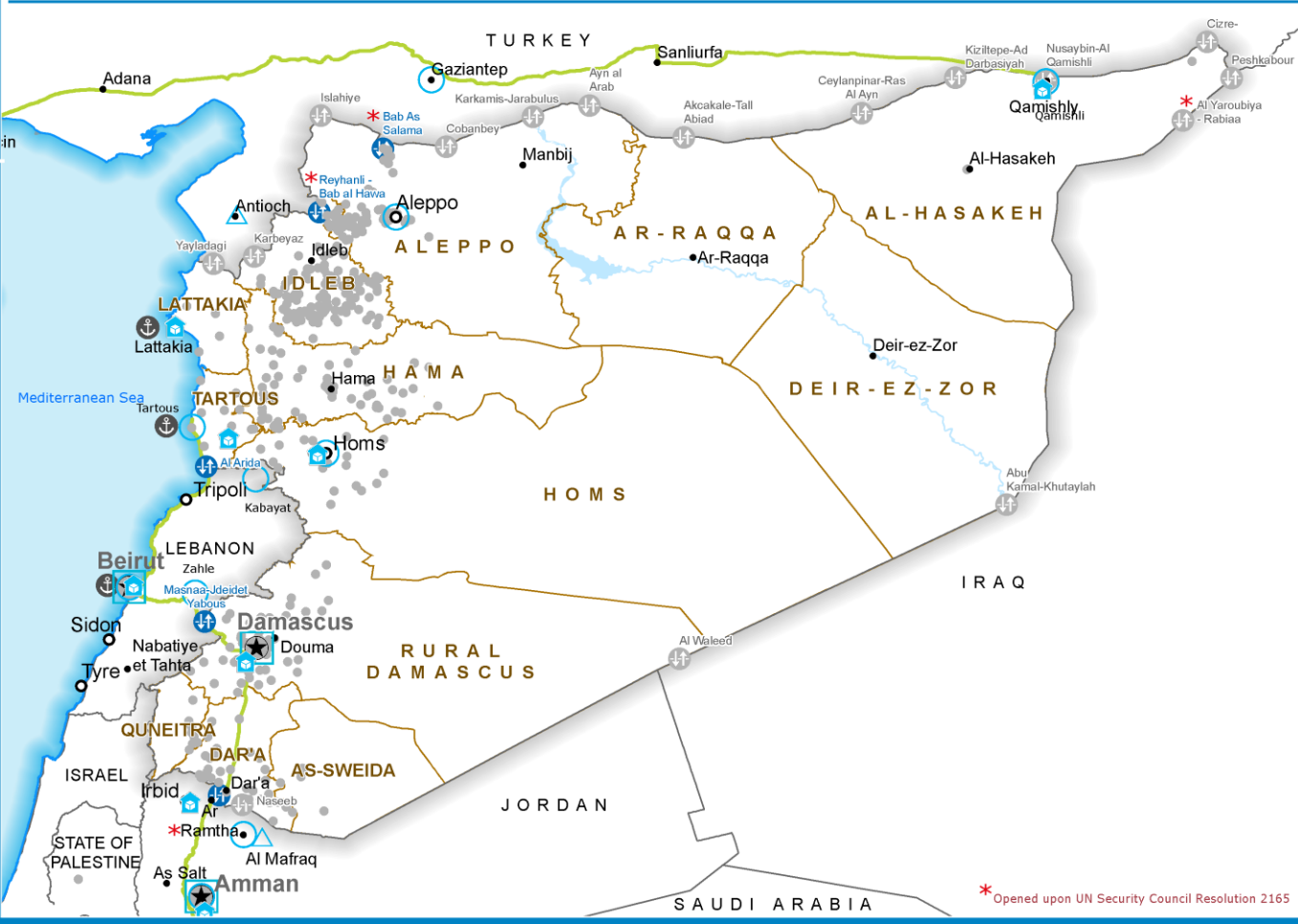

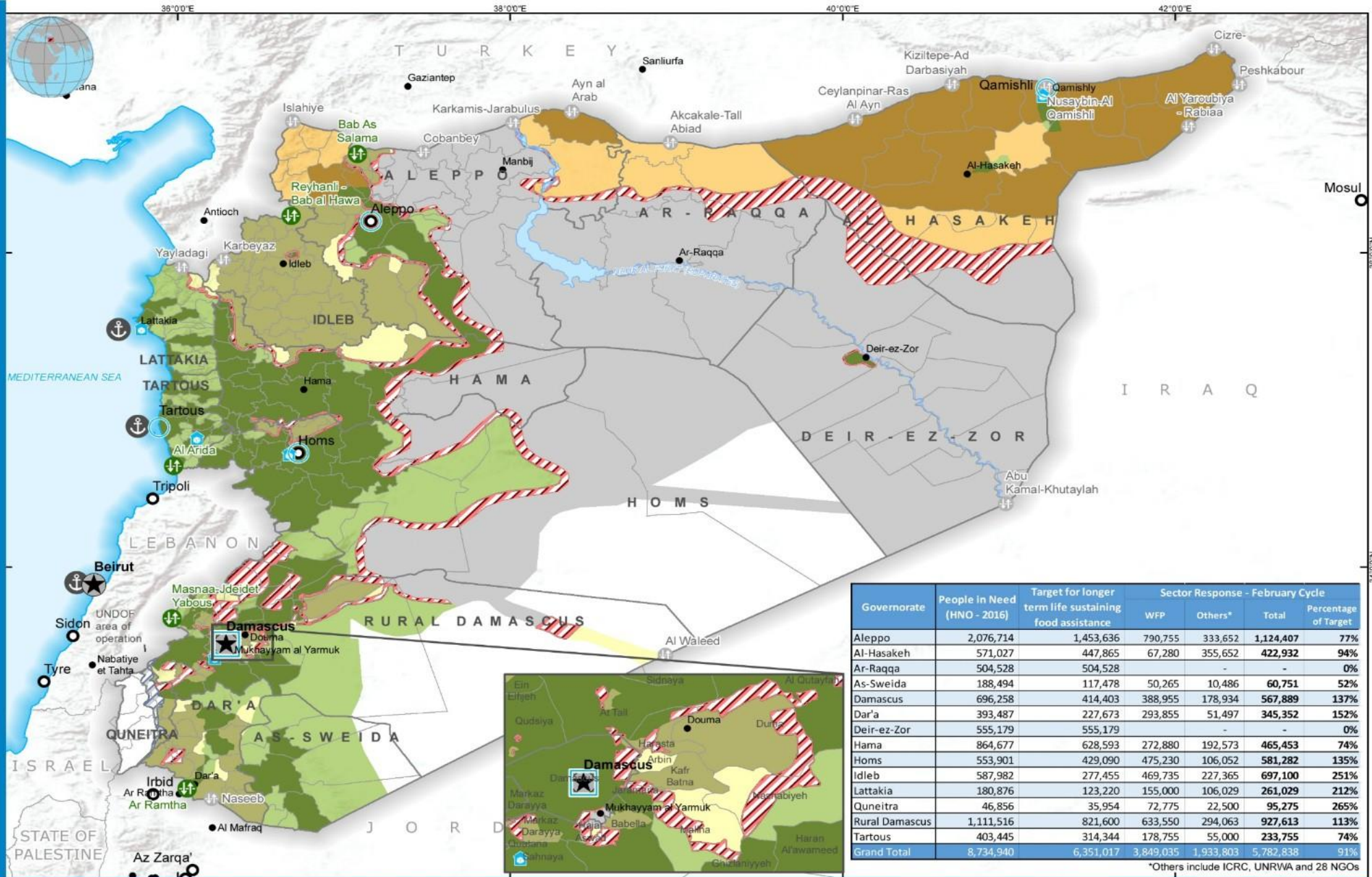

February Cycle - 2016



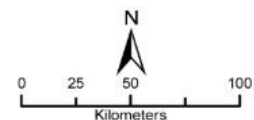

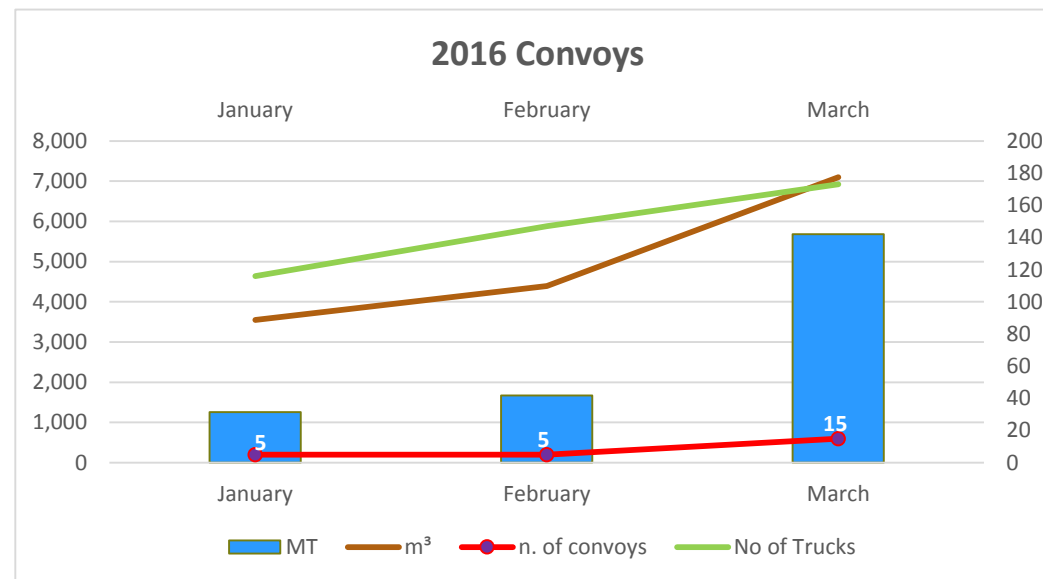
