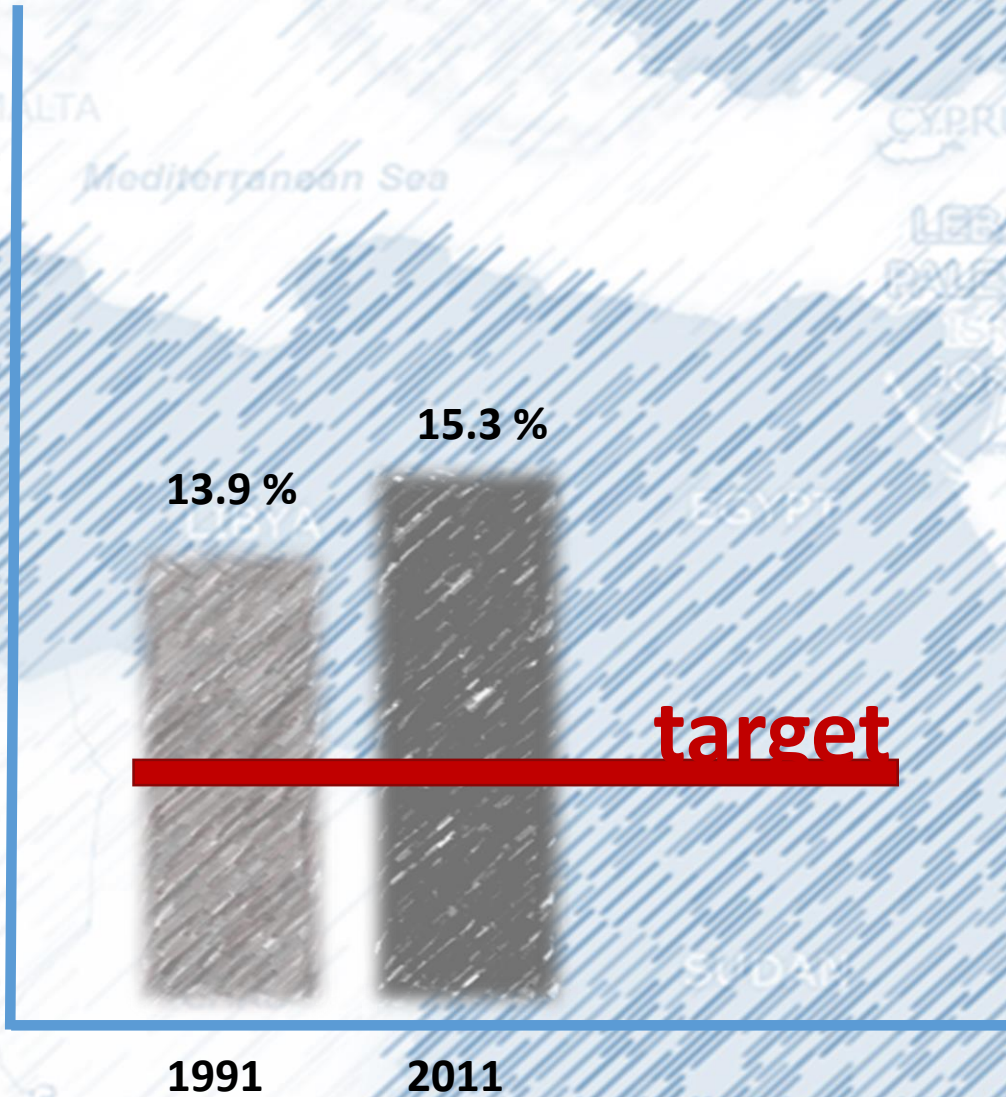

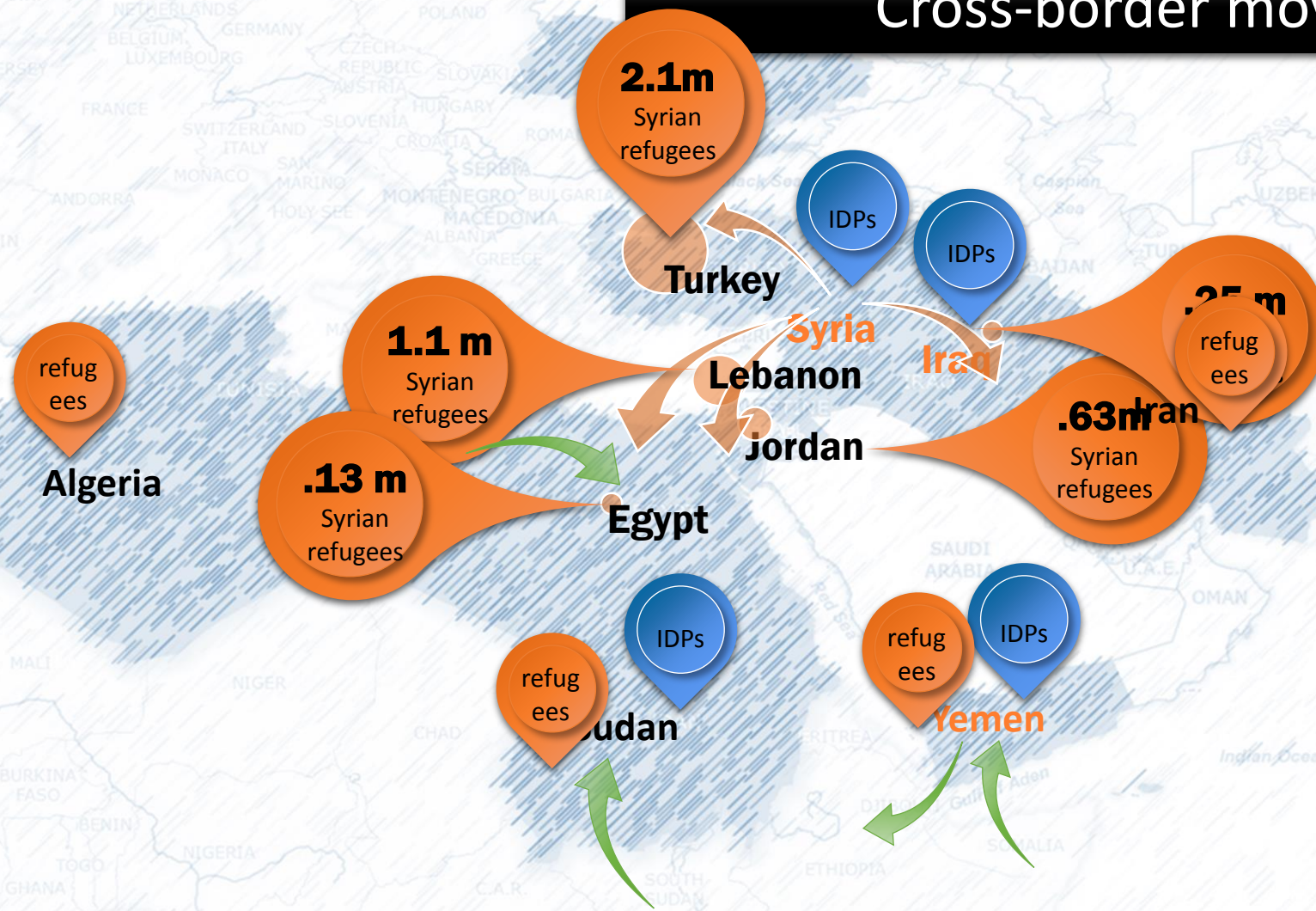

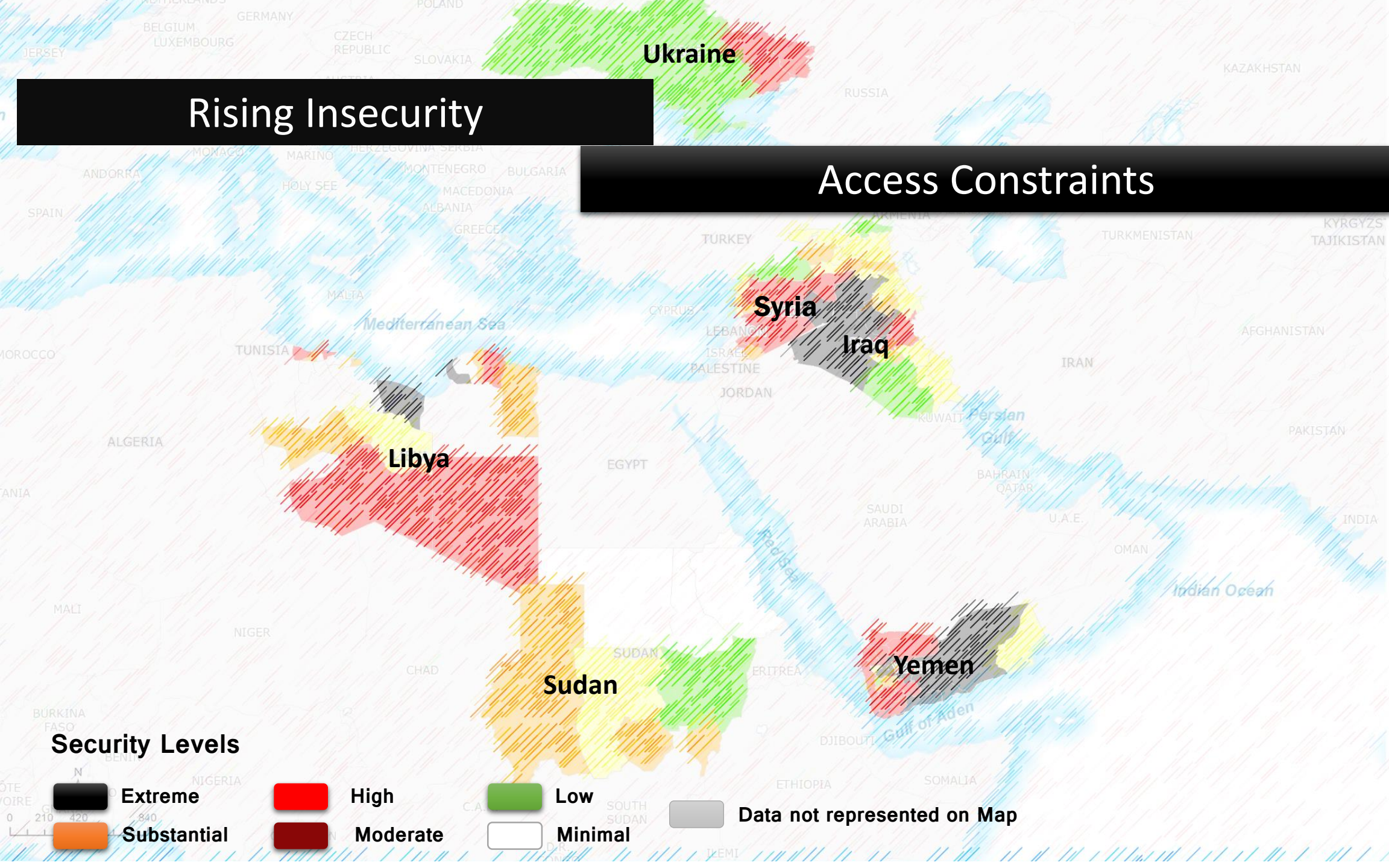

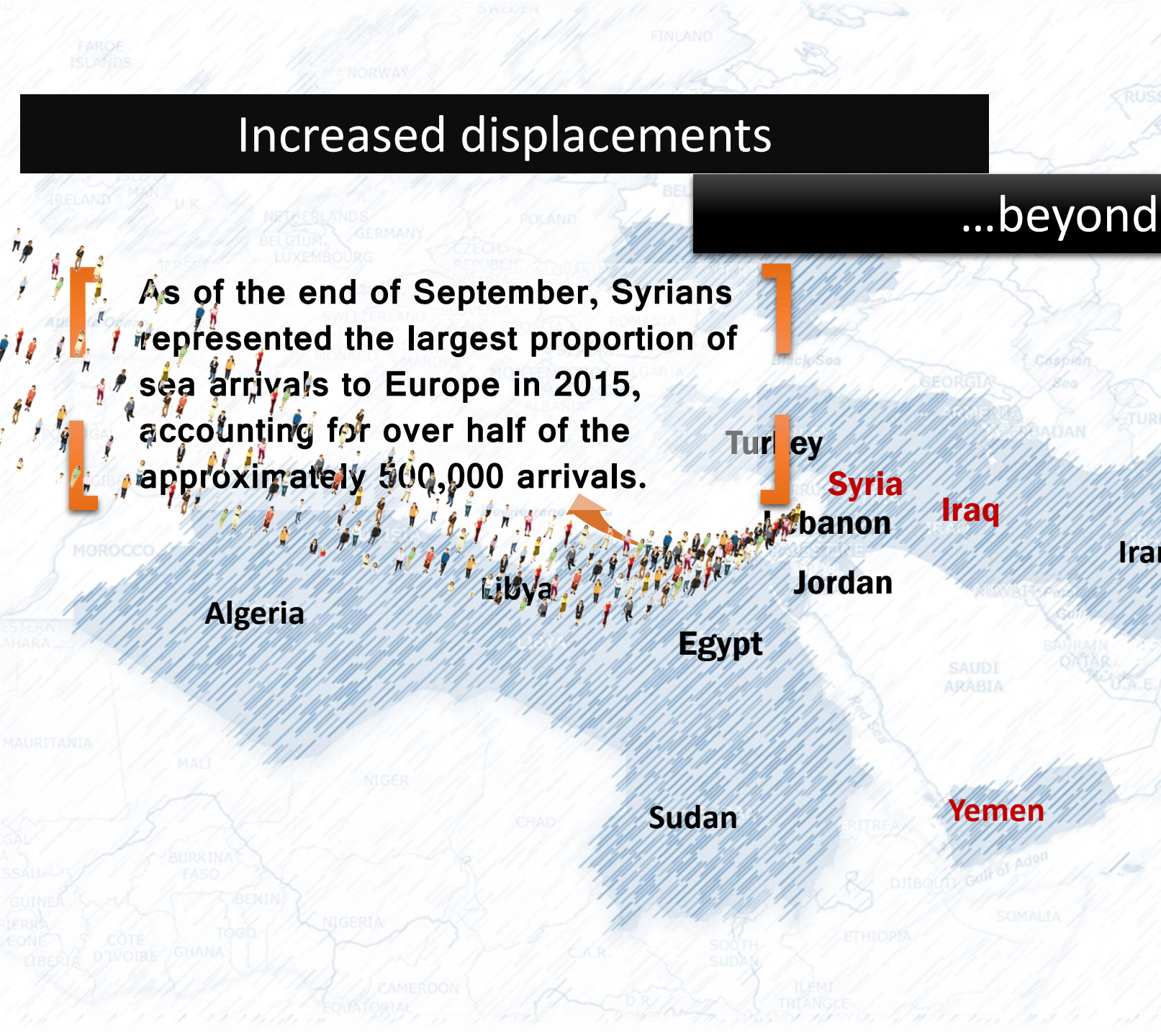

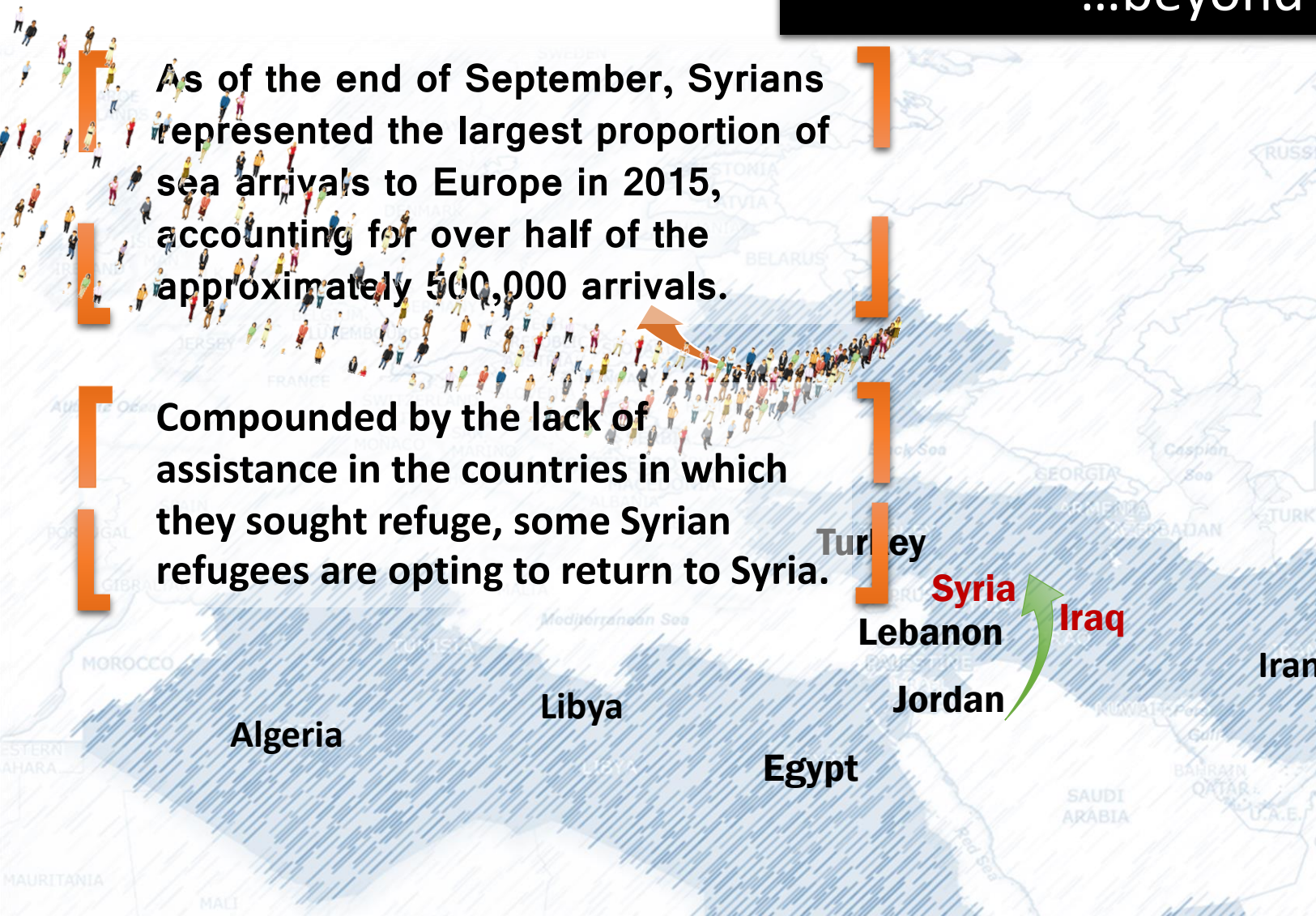

Compounded by the lack of assistance in the countries in which they sought refuge, some Syrian refugees are opting to return to Syria.

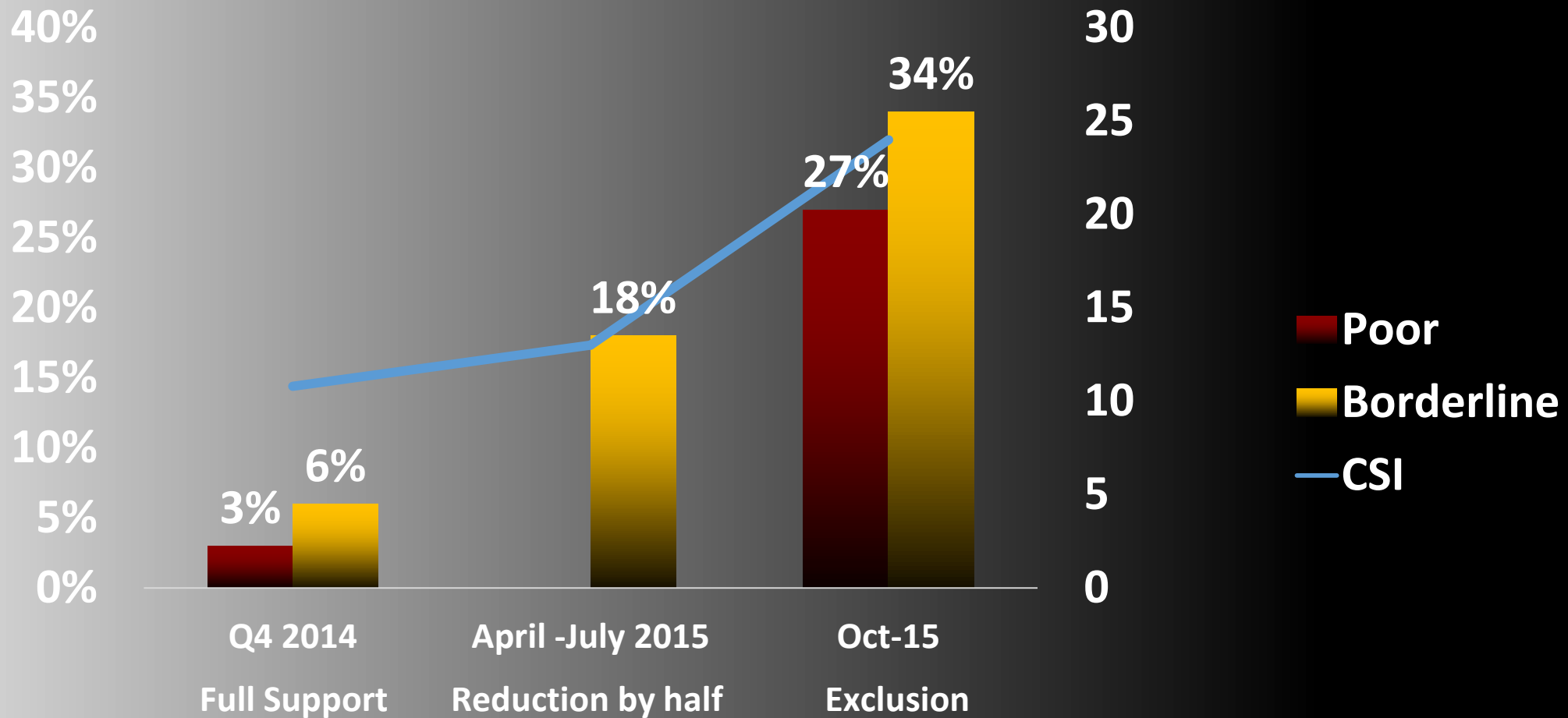


Arrivals to the EU in September 2015 are

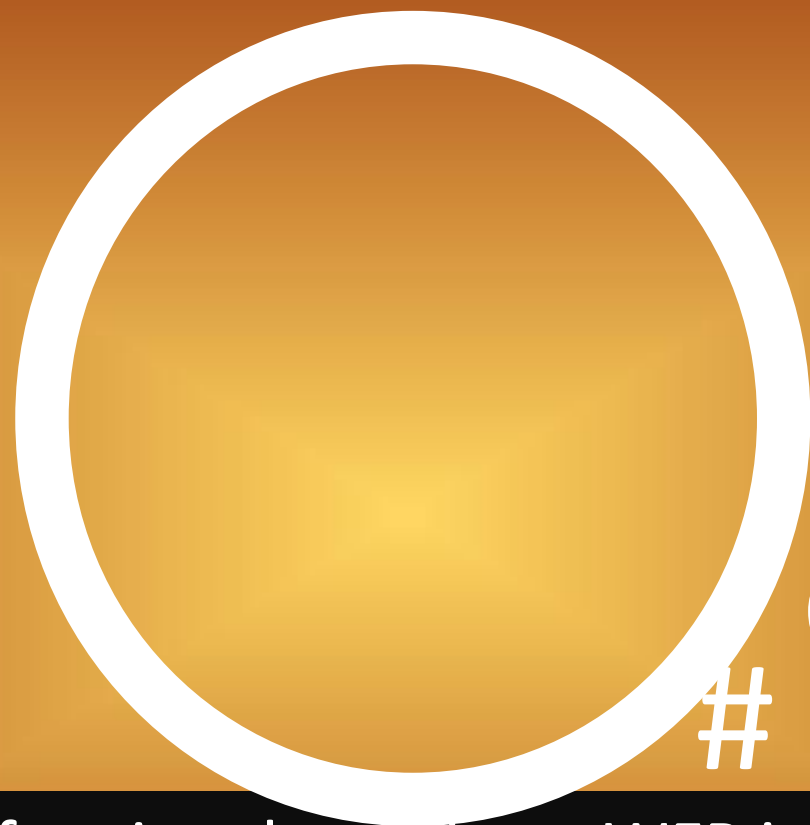

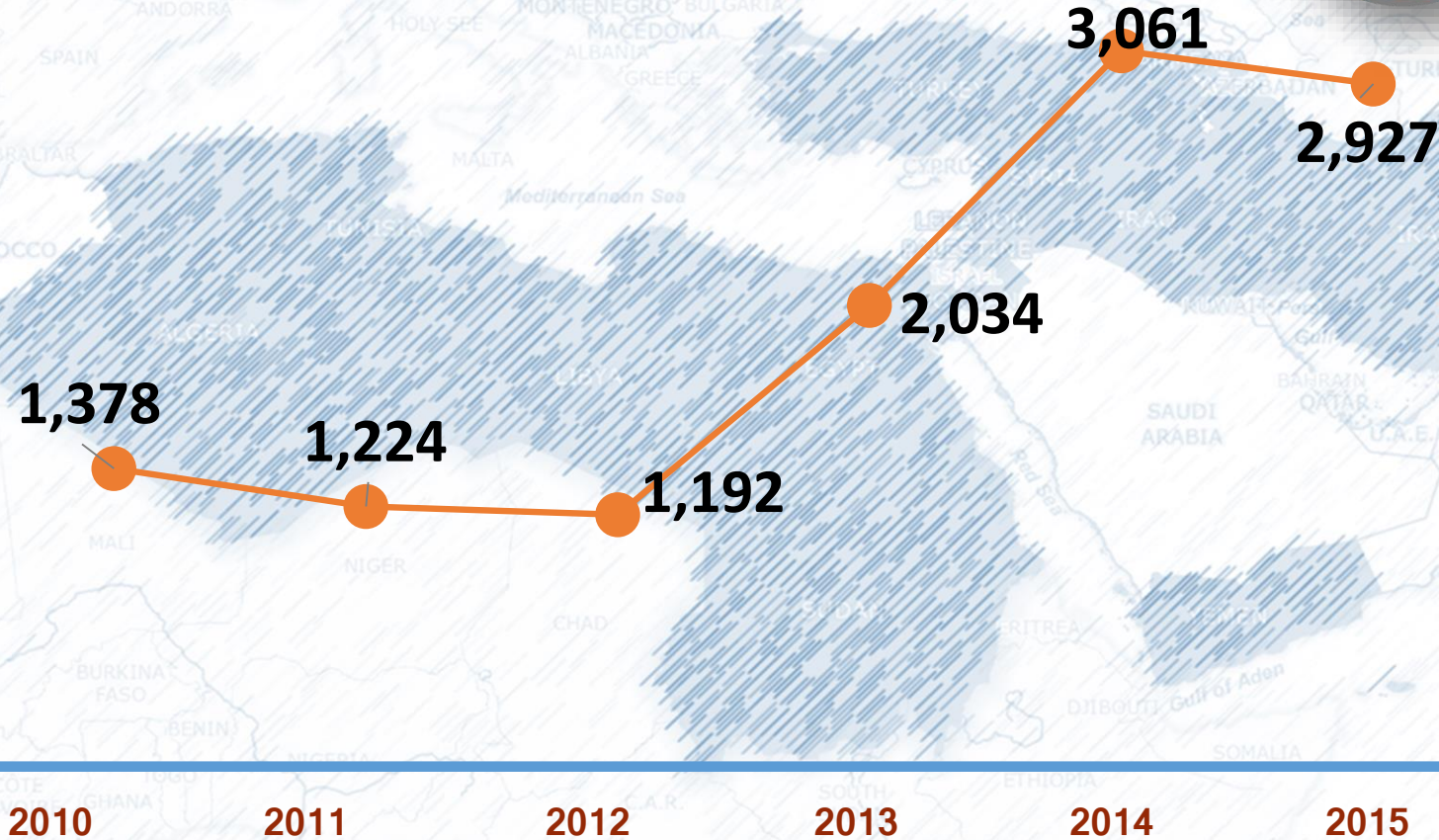

Impact of regional trends on WFP in the RBC Region

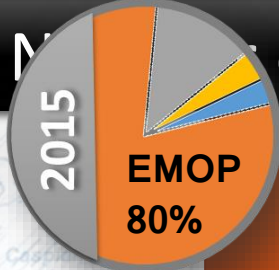

Rising % of Affected Populations

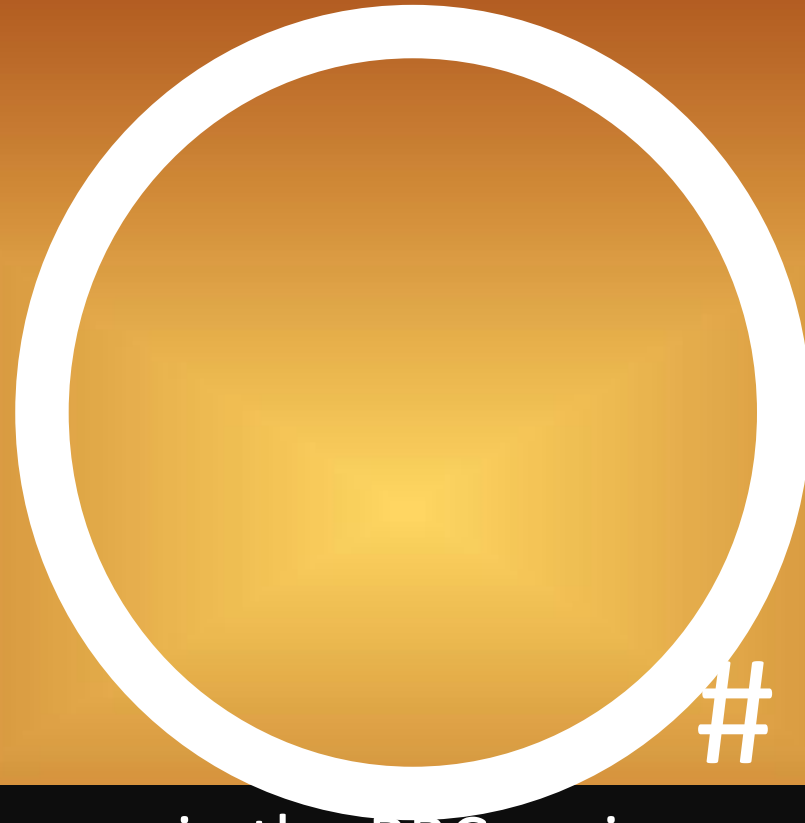

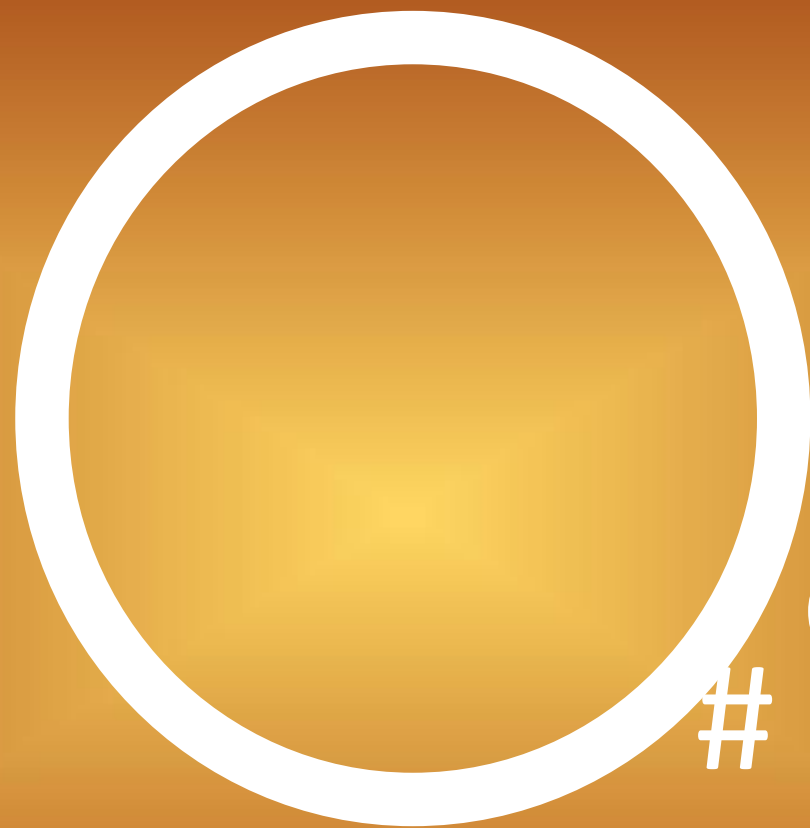
