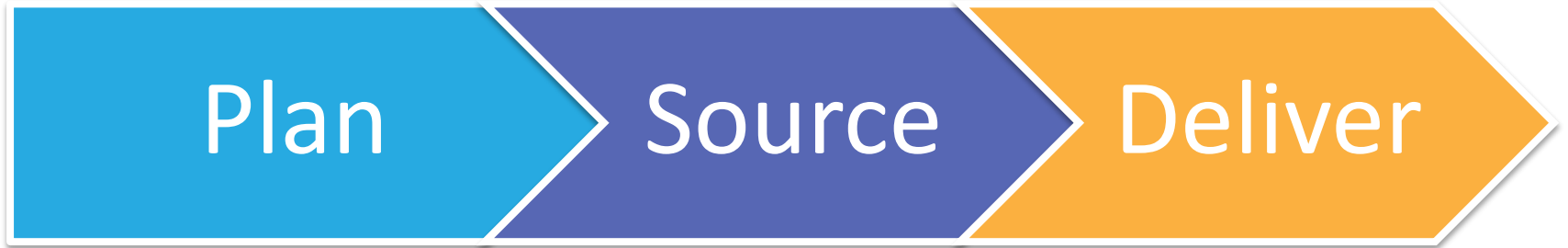

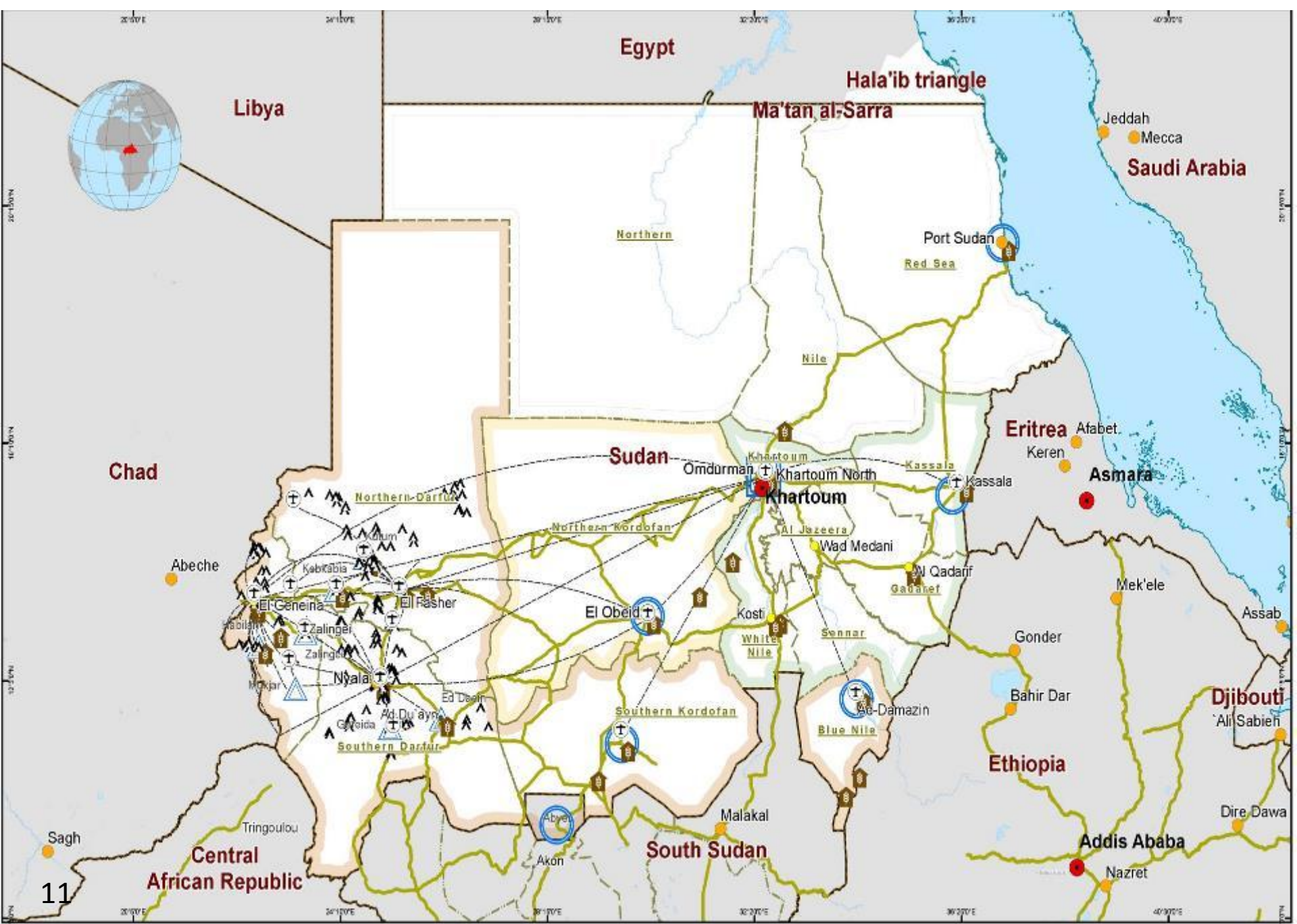

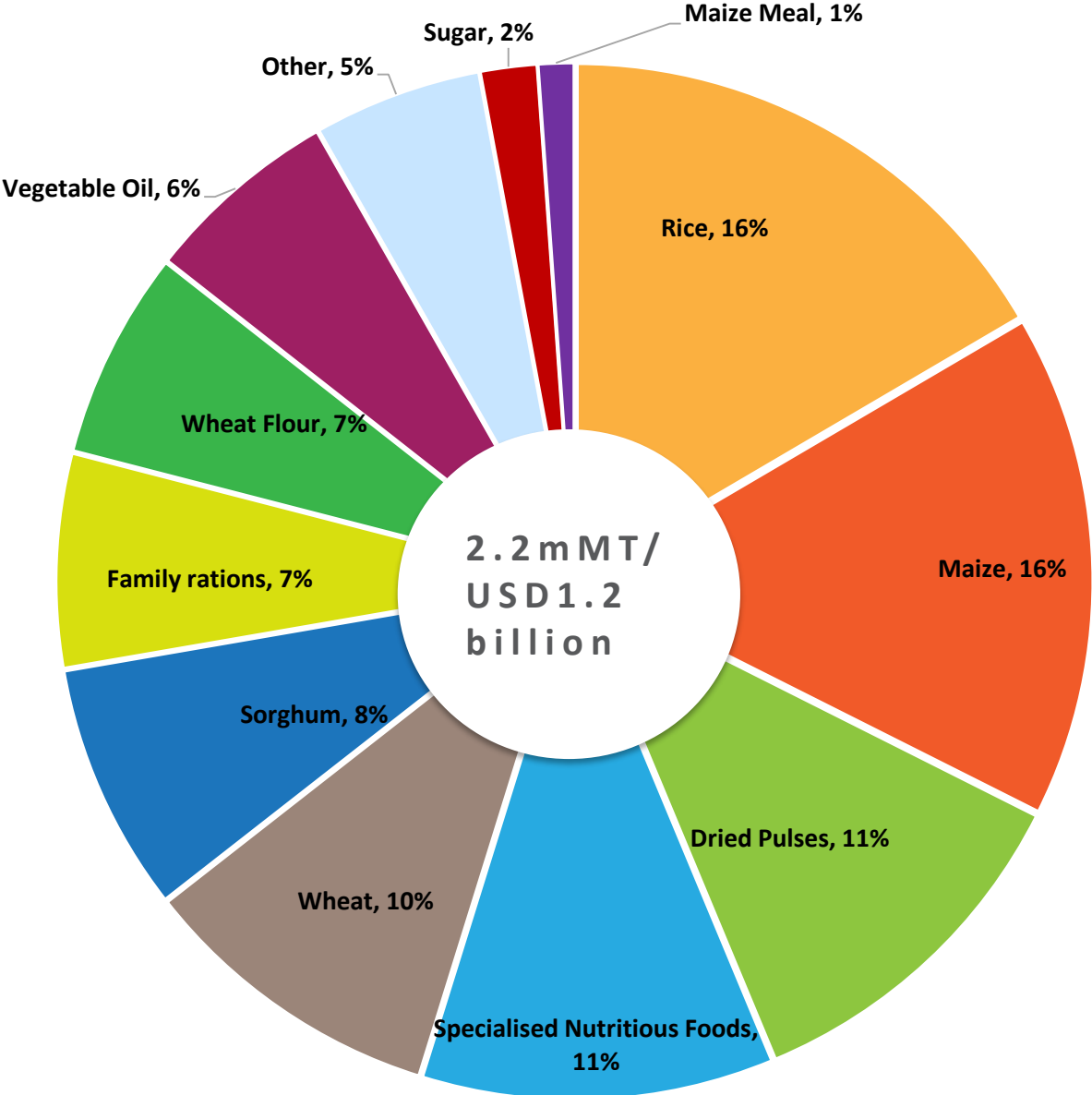

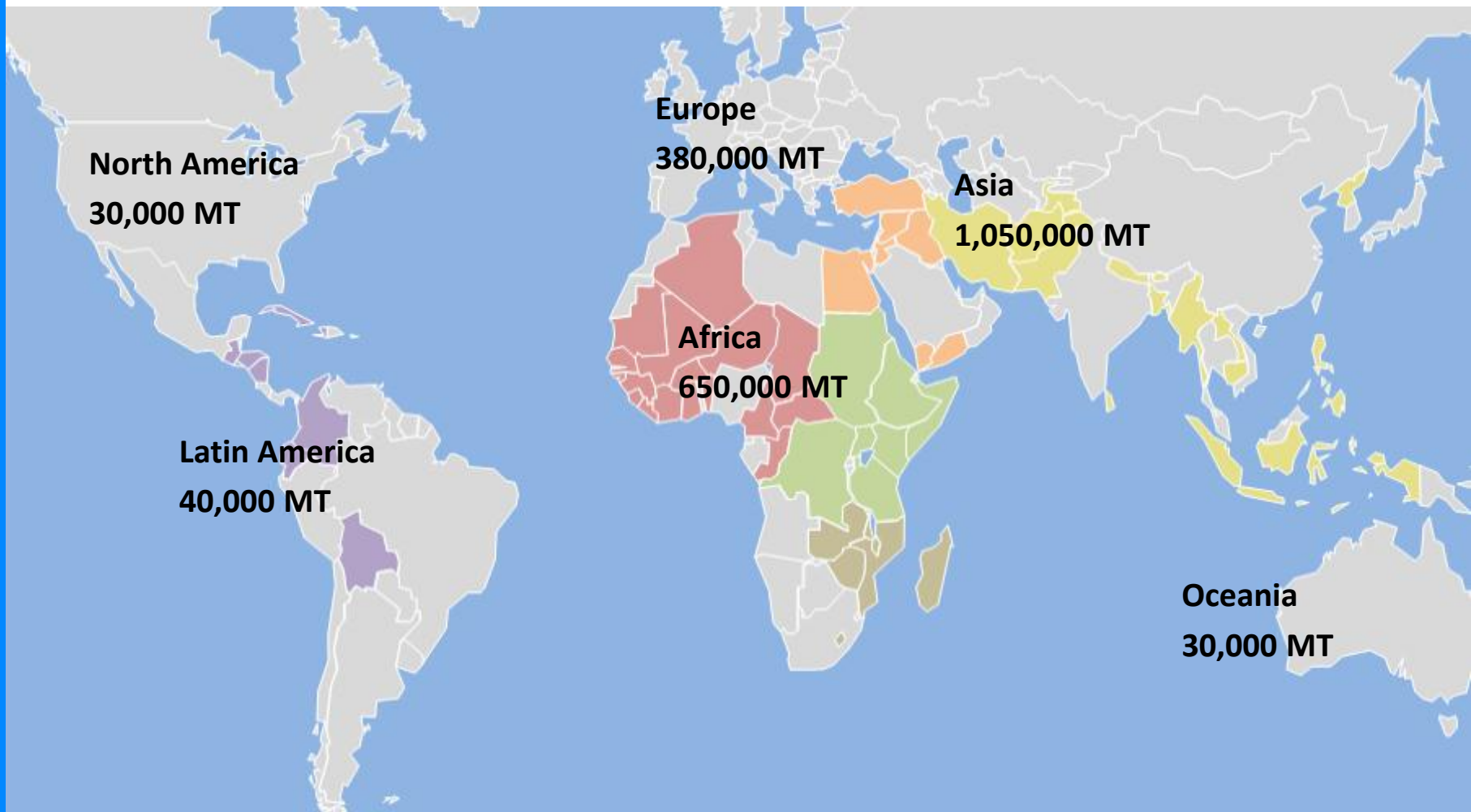

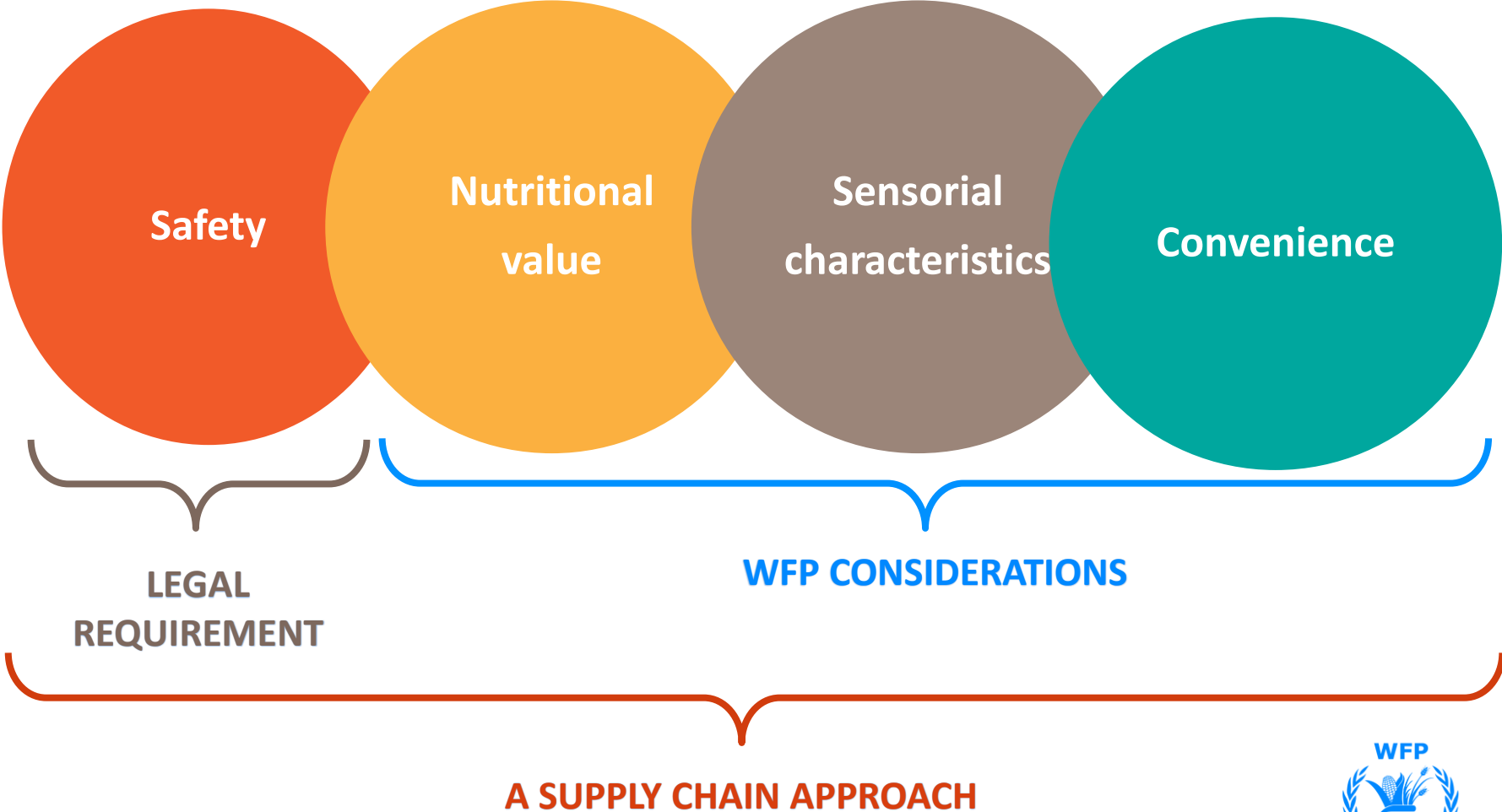
What We Buy: Food Purchases in 2014



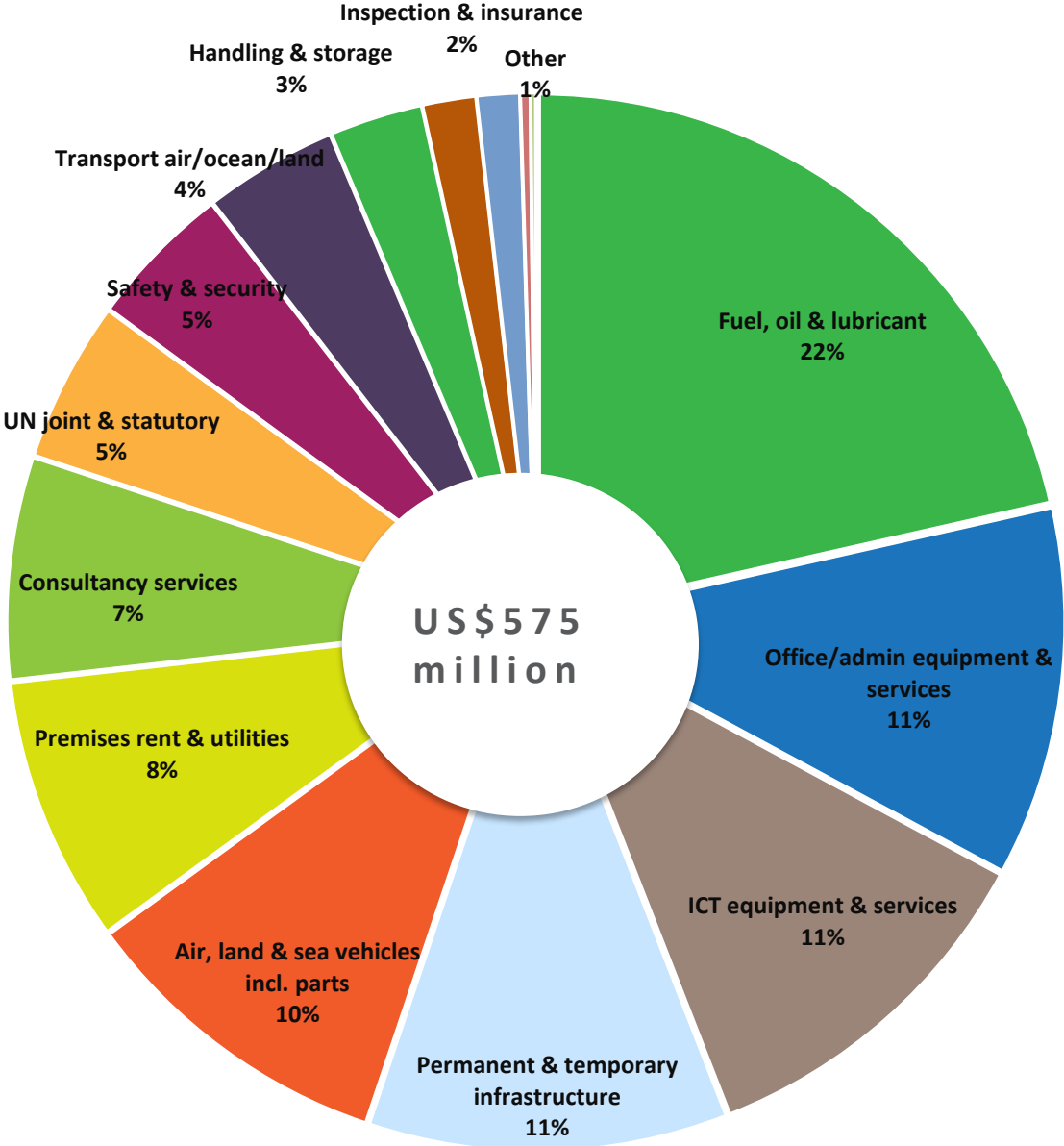
Where We Buy: 90 locations



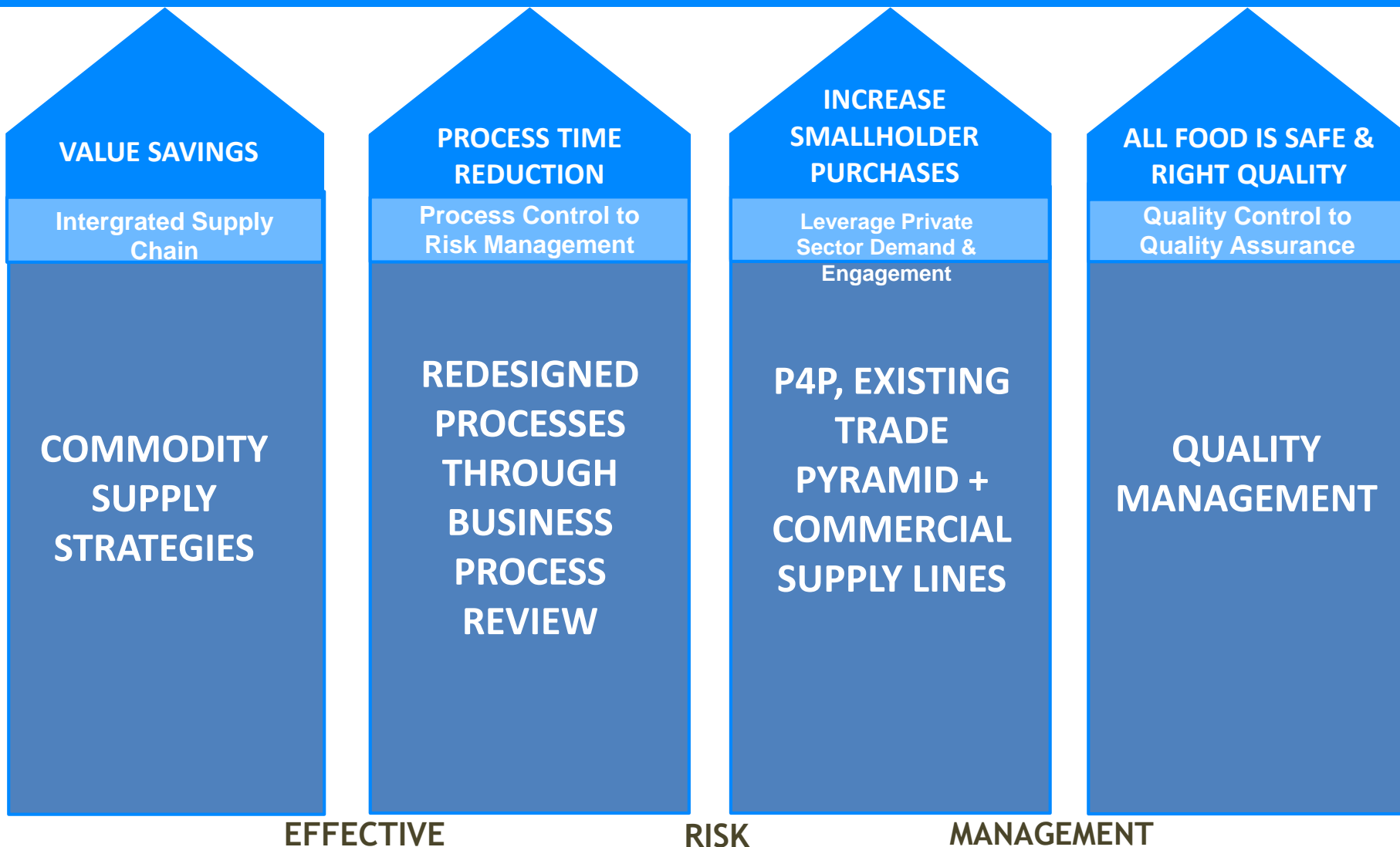
