

Iraq




As a result of the Anbar crisis in Iraq, thousands of families are displaced and the Governorate is classified as code “Black”

Iraq



WFP launched an IR EMOP to respond to the needs of displaced families, there is an immediate need to expand coverage

Syria



WFP started airlifting food to feed from Iraq to reach displaced people in Qamishli in northeast Syria amid growing problems in reaching people, especially in conflict and besieged areas.

Six-year-old Elissa fled from Eastern Ghouta with her family to Sahnaya where she now attends a kindergarten three times a week and is receiving regular nutritional support from WFP.
