Bhutan

WFP has assisted the Government of Bhutan in achieving its education goals by supporting school feeding since 1974 – that is almost 40 years. Over the years, the Government <u>has</u> increasingly taken over responsibilities for school feeding, with WFP remaining with assistance to 232 schools in mostly remote mountainous areas.

This project in front of you is designed to <u>complete</u> the hand-over of Bhutan's school feeding programme to the Government, over a 5 year period from 2014 to 2018 which corresponds to the Government's new 5 years development plan and that of UNDAF. When I visited Bhutan in 2011, the Prime Minister of Bhutan agreed to engrain the complete nationalization of school feeding into this 5 years national development plan.

We are confident that the Government will be able to fulfill their commitment if WFP can provide the necessary capacity building support over the coming 5 years.

With your permission, Mr. President, I would like to show a 3 minutes video on Bhutan which should demonstrate the level of commitment of our staff and that of the Government to make this a handover success story - and use that as my introductory presentation for this proposed project.
