When do we twin?

General Rules on Full Cost Recovery

When Governments of developing countries, countries with economies in transition and other non-traditional donors cannot meet FCR;

2004: ED Directive 2004/002

The Emerging Donor Trust Fund can support emerging donors with a maximum of \$1 million per annum;

2004: "New Partnerships to Meet Rising Needs"

The eligibility for twinning support (EDMF) is set for countries with GNI per capita of \$2,975 or less;

2007: Updated Directive FD2007/002

The eligibility is updated according to the updated OECD/DAC list for countries with GNI per capita of \$3,255 or less.

Why do we twin?

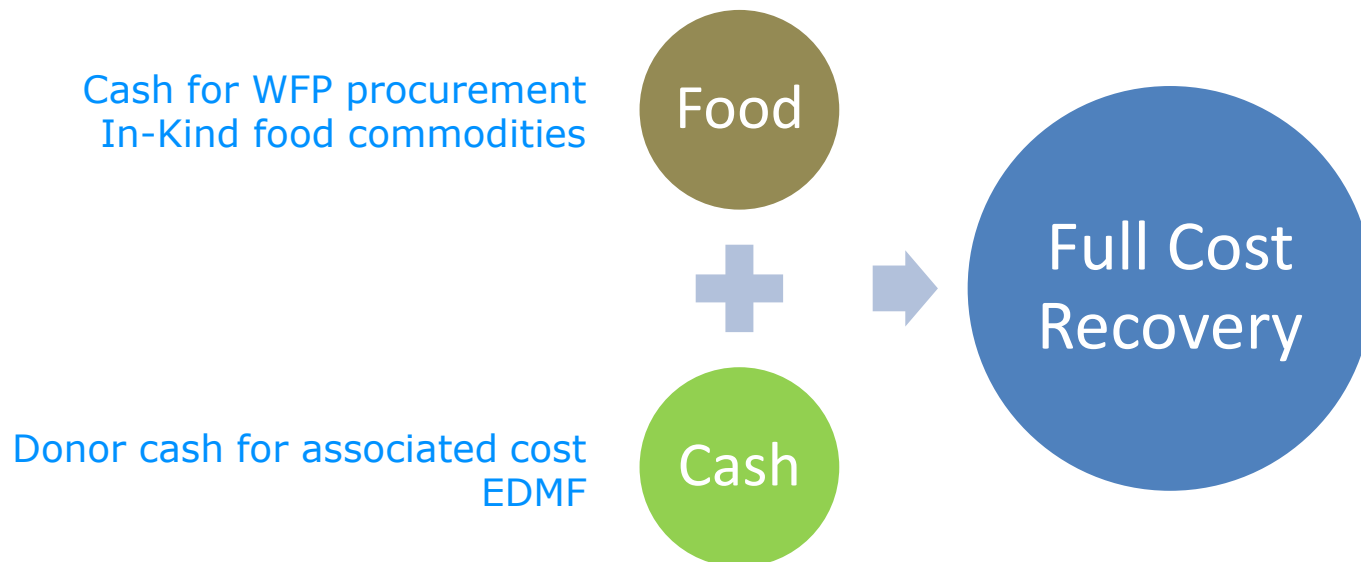


- 1** Increases availability of food and resources to WFP operations
- 2** Leverages more food with less capital cost
- 3** Sources food closer to beneficiaries, cutting costs and lead time
- 4** Effectively broadens WFP's donor base
- 5** Promotes South-South and triangular cooperation

How do we twin?

When a donor is unable to meet Full Cost Recovery:

- 1 Another donor can agree to cover the associated costs
- 2 WFP accesses the EDMF to provide limited/initial funds for twinning



Twinning beneficiaries



Since 2004, **62 recipient countries** received **1.8 million tons** of in-kind food through **\$991 million** in twinning partnerships

In-Kind twinning



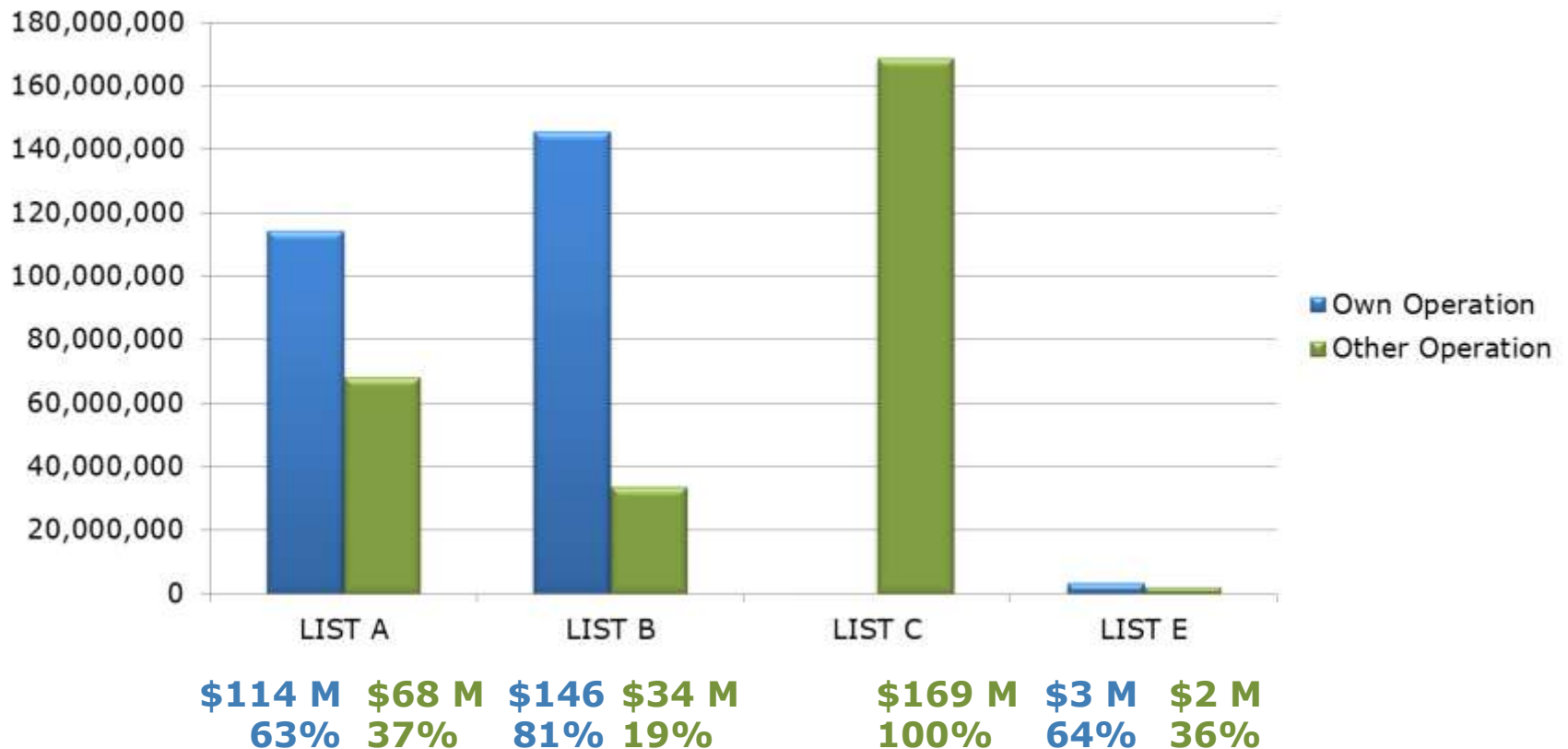
Since 2004, **45 governments** provided WFP with **1.8 million tons** of in-kind food commodities valued at **\$540 million**

Distribution of Twinning In-Kind



More than 98% of in-kind food twinned was donated by member states in List A, B and C

Distribution of Twinning In-Kind



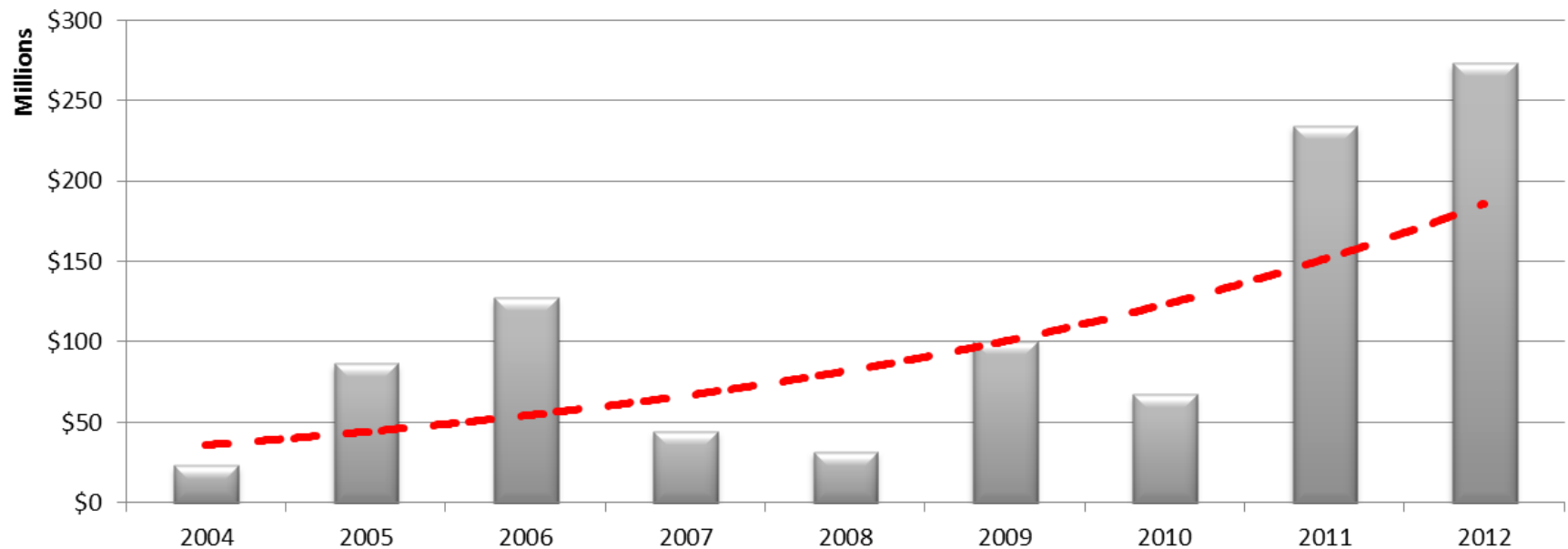
Approximately half of the in-kind food twinned were donated by recipient governments for its hosted operation

Cash twinning



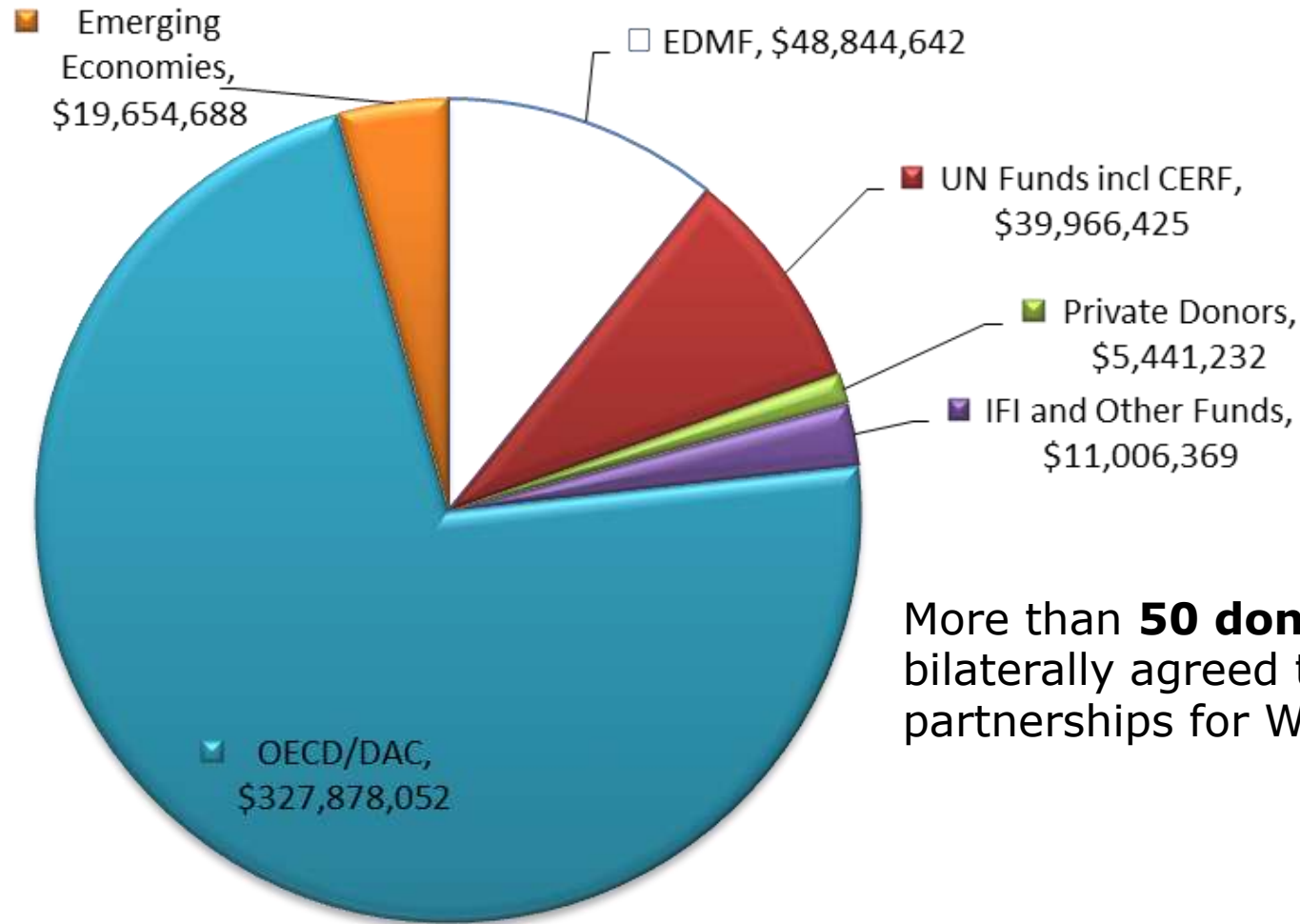
Since 2004, **53 governments and funds** invested **\$450 million** in twinning arrangements through WFP

Total Twinning Value by Year



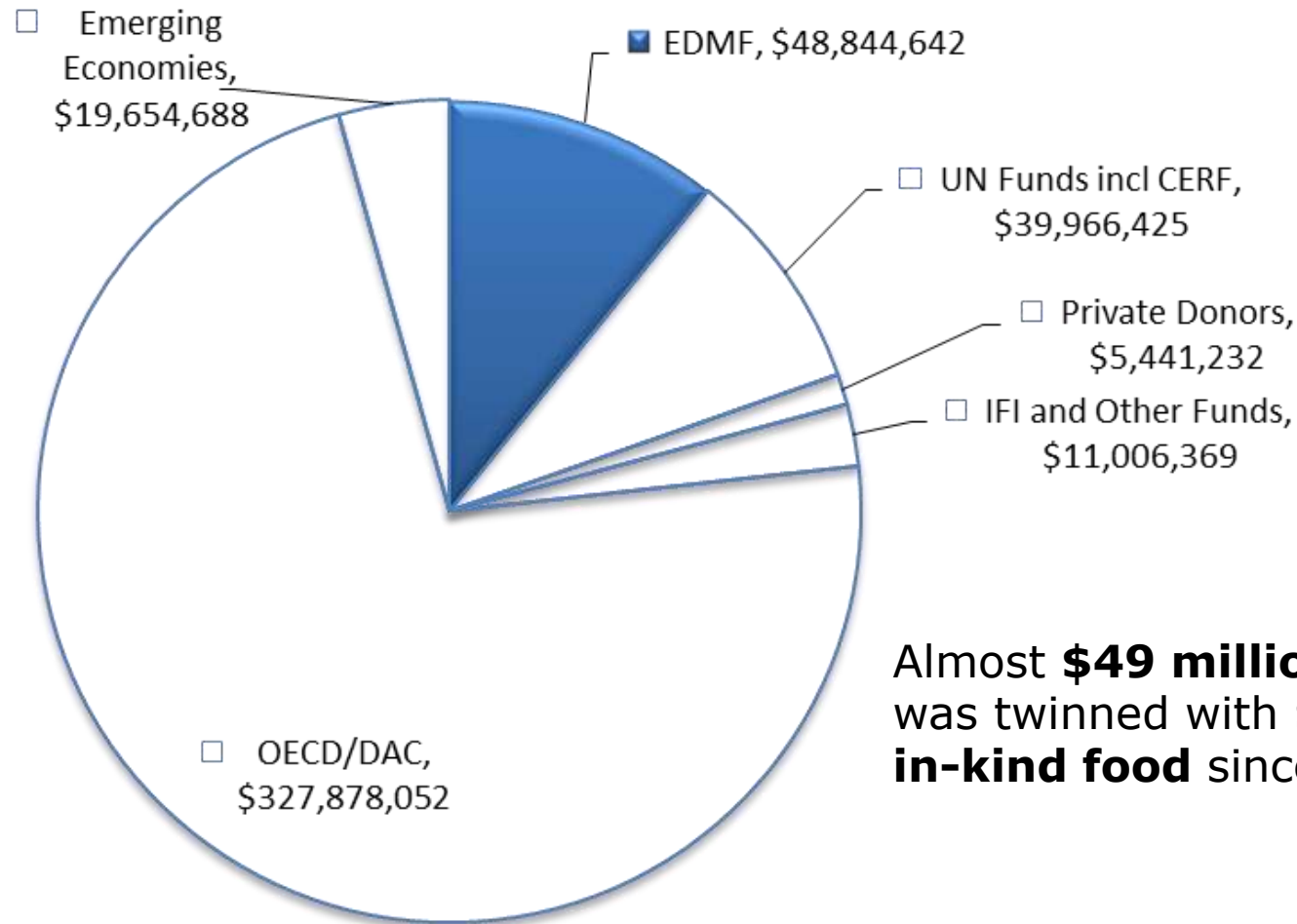
The frequency and volume of twinning partnerships has grown, reaching **historical levels in 2012**.

Bilateral Twinning Arrangements



More than **50 donors/funds** bilaterally agreed to twinning partnerships for WFP operations.

EDMF Twinning Support



Almost **\$49 million** of the EDMF was twinned with **\$70 million of in-kind food** since 2004.
