- Reactive stance on Other – programme evaluations, system-wide and inter-agency evaluations.

## ❑ Strategic Evaluation

- Series approach for enhanced learning and synergy over 2 year period;
- Proposed Strategic Evaluation Theme for 2013 – 2014: **WFP's Emergency Preparedness and Response**;
- CERF evaluation – scope covering all pooled funds.

## ❑ Policy Evaluation

- Proposals for gender, urban, capacity development policies;
- Nutrition Policy – timing and fit with proposed MCHN impact evaluations.

## □ **UNEG-DAC Evaluation Peer Review**

- Review progress since 2007;
- Identify adjustments in OE's and WFP's overall evaluation function, taking account of internal/external changes and increased demand for e.g:
  - International system engagement;
  - Mutual accountability for results, impact evidence;
  - Decentralized evaluations/M+E Strategy support;
  - Operations Evaluations .
